**OFFICER AND A FUTURITY WINNER?**

The talented two-year-old **Officer** (Bertrando) could help lift spirits at the Bob Baffert barn in the wake of Point Given's retirement with a win in today's GI Del Mar Futurity. "It's like Point Given will be passing the baton to him," Baffert told *Daily Racing Form*. "Here kid, don't mess it up." An open-length winner of all three career starts, the colt opened his campaign with two wins against California-breds before a seven-length victory in the GIII Best Pal S. at Del Mar Aug. 15. That impressive effort earned him a 106 Beyer Speed Figure, the third fastest by a juvenile so far this year. Officer will bid to extend Baffert's unprecedented record of five straight Del Mar Futurity winners: Silver Charm (96), Souvenir Copy (97), Wordly Manner (98), Forest Camp (99) and Flame Thrower (00). Also unbeaten in three starts, **Expected Program** (Valid Expectations) was a front-running winner of the June 17 Haggin S. at Hollywood in his last start. The Florida-bred bay prepped for his return with a five-eighths breeze in :59 4/5 last Friday over this surface. Since winning his debut at Bay Meadows in May, **Metatron** (Silver Ghost) has been runner-up to two of California's top juveniles. He was second behind subsequent GI Hopeful S. winner Came Home in the July 15 GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship before a runner-up finish behind Officer in the Best Pal. Making his stakes debut is **Historic Speech** (Pulpit), a \$700,000 yearling who finished third to **Ecstatic** (Rahy) in his July 18 bow. He returned to break his maiden over course and distance in 1:22 3/5 Aug. 11.

**POINT' STUD PLANS SOON TO BE DECDED**

The Thoroughbred Corporation's **Point Given** (Thunder Gulch) will be paraded today at Del Mar, but no decision has yet been made on where the charismatic chestnut will enter stud next year, according to racing manager Richard Mullah. "The horse is in great shape, and there's been lots of interest from lots of farms," said Mullah. "We're going to meet next week with some farms in Kentucky [during the Keeneland September Yearling Sale]. There have been some rumors that the deal is done, but there's no deal yet." Winner of six of seven starts this year, including five Grade I events, the big colt was retired on Friday after suffering a tendon tear. The Thoroughbred Corporation homebred is the leading candidate for Horse of the Year.

**OXALAGU EUTHANIZED** Gestut Rietberg's **Oxalagu (Ger)** (Lagunas {GB}), 1997 Highweight Older Horse in Germany at 9.5-11f, was euthanized Aug. 31 following a fatal fracture to his off hindleg. The nine-year-old won seven Pattern races in his native land, including the 1997 G1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis Bayerisches Zuchtrennen at Munich. While racing abroad, he placed in the 1995 Magna Austrian Derby and the 1997 G1 Premio Roma. Oxalagu has yet to have runners on the track, but his first crop of yearlings are due to start training in the coming weeks.

## ENTIRE TAMARISK CROP TO SELL AT TATTERSALLS

All three yearlings from the only crop of 1998 European Champion Sprinter **Tamarisk (Ire)** (Green Desert {USA}) are to be sold at Tattersalls this autumn. The trio, including two colts and one filly, all belong to Valentine and Joy Feerick. Tamarisk, a 78,000 guineas purchase at the 1996 Tattersalls Houghton Yearling Sale, won the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup as well as the £300,000 Tattersalls Houghton Sales Stakes. He returned to training last year for a brief stint in the United States after a stud career blighted by infertility. The horse is now back with original trainer Roger Charlton. Valentine Feerick said, "We bought all three as foals last year. We have one colt in the Houghton Sale and the other colt and filly in the October Yearling Sale. I don't know for a fact, but I would say it is unique to be selling the entire crop of a horse who is himself currently in training. Apart from the curiosity factor, sons of Green Desert have already done extremely well at stud and Tamarisk was one of the very best, so we are very much looking forward to the Sales."

## ★ BRITAIN ★

### SINGAPORE CHAMPION TO RACE IN BRITAIN

Singapore champion **Bocelli (NZ)** (Lord Ballina {Aus}), set to embark on an autumn campaign in Britain, will make his European debut in the Listed Dubai Duty Free Cup at Newbury Sept. 21. That race is intended as a stepping stone to the G1 £300,000 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot Sept. 29. The four-year-old, trained by Patrick Busuttin, has won eight of his last nine races, including the G1 Emirates Singapore Derby. He is due to arrive at the Abington Place stables of Geoff Wragg in Newmarket tomorrow. The winner of all three legs of the Singapore Challenge will be accompanied on the trip by stable companion Triumphant Return who will aim for the Listed Dubai Airport World Trophy at Newbury Sept. 22.

### DILSHAAN OUT FOR THE SEASON

Last season's G1 Racing Post Trophy winner **Dilshaan (GB)** (Darshaan {GB}) will not run again this term, but will return next year. Trained by Sir Michael Stoute, Dilshaan began his sophomore campaign with a victory in the G2 Dante S. at York May 16 and then finished seventh in the G1 Vodafone Derby at Epsom June 9. That proved to be his last start of the year after a scan revealed joint damage. The three-year-old was being readied for the G2 Princess Of Wales's S. at Newmarket July 10. Joe Mercer, racing manager to owner Saheed Suhail, told *The Racing Post*, "It is not fair on the horse to bring him back at this time of the year. He's only walking at the moment, but seems to have got over his injury. He'll stay in training next year and should make a nice four-year-old."

**DOLLAR BILL DONE FOR THE YEAR** The latest casualty of the three-year-old ranks is **Dollar Bill** (Peaks and Valleys), who came out of his third-place finish in the GI Travers S. with an injured ankle, according to *Daily Racing Form*. "We discovered some filling in his left ankle after the Travers," trainer Dallas Stewart told the *Form*. "It's really nothing major, a minor flake, and we could have gotten a couple of more races out of him this year, but decided it wasn't worth risking any major damage to the cartilage. The vets have assured me he should come back perfect next year." Stewart indicated that colt would be out of training for the next 45-60 days. Winner of the Risen Star S. to start things off this year, the bay colt endured a series of rough trips and was given some time off following a fourth in the GI Belmont S. June 9 before returning with his big effort against Point Given in the Travers Aug. 25.

A California-trained son of Gone West, Cam e Hom e came East for the GI Hopeful S. The journey proved to be a worthwhile one, as Cam e Hom e scored by two lengths while breaking the stakes record.

This was the third win in as many starts for Cam e Hom e, who had been through auctions as a weanling, yearling and two-year-old without finding a buyer. His previous outings have resulted in an eight-length win in a maiden race at Hollywood Park, and a four-length triumph in the GII Hollywood Juvenile Championship.

Cam e Hom e is the 58th stakes winner and eighth Grade I winner to emerge from the first 11 crops of his sire, the Mr. Prospector stallion Gone West. Previous juvenile Grade I winners for Gone West are Zafonic, the champion European two-year-old of 1992; and Grand Slam, who took the GI Moet Champagne S.-- a possible next target for Cam e Hom e-- and GI Futurity S. in 1997.

Cam e Hom e's dam, Nice Assay, campaigned in the colors of the colt's owners, John Toffan and Trudy McCaffery and won seven of 24 starts. These included the GIII Linda Vista Breeders' Cup H. and four other stakes events, and she also earned places in two other graded stakes, including a third in the GI Las Vigenas S. Starting her stud career with a visit to A.P. Indy, Nice Assay threw another good runner for Toffan and McCaffery in the shape of the filly A.P. Assay, who not only won the GII A Glean H.,

but also equaled the track record for seven furlongs at Hollywood Park. After producing Cam e Hom e--her fifth foal--Nice Assay was consigned to the 1999 Keeneland November Sales carrying a brother to A.P. Assay and realized \$1,700,000.

Nice Assay was the only foal produced by her dam, the stakes-winning Full Out mare In Full View, before that mare's exportation to Japan. In Full View was half sister to two other stakes winners, including graded scorer Overturned, and also to the granddam of Stephanotis, the winner of the 1996 edition of the Canadian classic Prince of Wales's S. The family hadn't otherwise been a particularly distinguished one for several generations, but it does go back to a notable tap-root mare called Cbnasbee, who also appears in the tail-female line of the lightning fast sprinter Decathlon, and champion two-year-old filly My Dear Girl, dam of, among others, In Reality.

Clever Trick, the broodmare sire of Cam e Hom e, has been a very successful sire of speedy and precocious runners, and is now turning into a rather promising broodmare sire. His daughters seem to be working well with Mr. Prospector-line stallions, and in addition to Cam e Hom e, the Mr. Prospector/Clever Trick cross has produced a previous juvenile Grade I winner in Traitor, and also the Grade I-winning filly Roam in Rachel. This affinity might be explained by the fact that Clever Trick's sire Ibecapade is bred on a Nearco/Native Dancer cross, the reverse of which produced Mr. Prospector, and that Clever Trick is out of a mare by Better Bee, a horse bred on the same cross as Count Fleet, the sire of the second dam of Mr. Prospector.

Cam e Hom e's pedigree also has a duplication of the Nasrullah/Princequillo cross. This comes in through Secretariat, the broodmare sire of Gone West, and through Full Out, the sire of Cam e Hom e's second dam. Cam e Hom e's third dam, Turn n' See, is by Best Turn. Best Turn's granddam, Miz Clementine, was an outstanding race mare, and is a sister to another top-class runner in Two Lea. Two Lea appears in the pedigree of Gone West as dam of Tim Tam, sire of the second dam of Gone West. The same combination appears in the pedigree of Gone West's Grade I-winning son, West By West.
