A SUCCESSOR TO THE THRONE

On a bittersweet afternoon on closing day at Del Mar, **Officer** (Bertrando) eased the pain of the retirement of Point Given with an easy victory in the GII Del Mar Futurity. The victory was the sixth in as many years for trainer Bob Baffert. "Officer has a lot of weight to carry," Baffert said, referring to Point Given. "If he stays together for a long time, we may have something special here." A six-length graduate against state-breds at Hollywood July 6, Officer returned to demolish the Graduation S. field by eight July 25 before adding graded-stakes black type with a seven-length success in the GIII Best Pal S. Aug. 15. Settled beautifully on the outside in fourth, jockey Victor Espinoza sent the dark bay three wide at the quarter pole, assumed command at will and eased clear. "He's so good. He's so professional," the winning rider added. "I have so much confidence in him. I let him run a little bit around the turn. That was it. He's something. That's for sure."

EL CORREDOR TO HILL 'N' DALE

A controlling interest in 2000 GI Cigar Mile winner **El Corredor** (Mr. Greeley--Silver Swan, by Silver Deputy) has been purchased by John Sikura's Hill 'n' Dale Farm, which will stand the colt upon his retirement from racing. The winner of the GII Del Mar Breeders' Cup H. in his stakes debut last September, El Corredor gained national attention when he checked in second, three parts of a length behind Kentucky Derby victor Fusaichi Pegasus in the GII Jerome H. at Belmont Park prior to his win in the Cigar Mile. Sidelined shortly thereafter, he returned to the races with a 1 1/2-length victory in the GII Pat O'Brien H. at Del Mar Aug. 12 before registering his second consecutive win in the Del Mar Breeders' Cup H. last Sunday. "El Corredor is a brilliant miler with the courage of a lion," said his trainer Bob Baffert. Purchased for \$110,000 at the 1998 Keeneland September Sales, he is "the best looking yearling I have bought to date...period," according to bloodstock advisor J.B. McKathan. The four-year-old is being pointed for the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Belmont Oct. 27.

SUPER SATURDAY, TAKE ONE

The first of several Breeders' Cup Preview Days at the Belmont Park fall meeting is set for this coming Saturday, featuring the return of reigning Horse of the Year **Tiznow** (Cee's Tizzy), who is set to contest the GI Woodward S. in March in the GI Woodward S. The four-year-old, who is making his first start since a victory in the GI Santa Anita H. in March, got his first feel for the Belmont surface yesterday morning, but the serious preparations for the race were completed in California. "I never work him out of town when I ship," trainer Jay Robbins commented. "He gallops very strong. He gallops like most horses breeze." He is likely to face GI Whitney H. winner **Lido Palace (Chi)** (Rich Man's Gold) and horse-for-the course **Albert the Great** (Go For Gin) in Saturday's main event. The former, second to Albert the Great in the GII Suburban H. July 1, seems to have turned the corner since the addition of blinkers for that effort. "They [the blinkers] help to get him into the race," trainer Bobby Frankel said. "This way the jock doesn't have to ride him as much in the first part of the race." Jerry Bailey has the return call. Saturday also features the GI Man o' War S. and the GI Gazelle H.

FANTASTIC LIGHT ON COURSE FOR REMATCH

After **Fantastic Light (USA)** (Rahy {USA}) worked five furlongs yesterday, trainer Saeed bin Suroor confirmed that the five-year-old was Godolphin's most likely runner in Saturday's G1 Ireland The Food Island Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown. Fantastic Light will be looking to avenge his two-length defeat to **Galileo (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) in the July 28 G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot. Bin Suroor said, "Fantastic Light worked today [Wednesday] over in a blow-out over five furlongs with Broche (USA) and he looked in good form. Galileo is a great horse but I think we have a better chance this time over a mile and a quarter." Godolphin also reported Fantastic Light a possible for the Oct. 27 Breeders' Cup Classic at Belmont. Racing manager Simon Crisford told the *Irish Times* yesterday: "People seem to be expecting us to run Fantastic Light in the Turf race in New York but he is a possible for the Classic. Although he hasn't raced on sand, he trained well on it during the winter."

EXTRA GROUP ONE ADDED TO ARC CARD

Longchamp will host an extra Group 1 race on the day of the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 7, bringing the total of top-class events to six. France Galop, the ruling body of French racing, yesterday introduced the newly created G1 Grand Criterium Groupe Lucien Barrière. The seven-furlong event for two year olds now sits alongside the G1 Prix du Cadran Casino Barrière de Cannes Croisette, G1 Prix de l'Opera Casino Barrière d'Enghien les Bains, G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp Majestic Barrière, and G1 Prix Marcel Boussac Royal Barrière as well as the main feature, which attracted 169 entries in May.

Momentum made the step up to stakes company last time in the Listed Sovereign S. at Salisbury Aug. 16 and found only the smart Umistim (GB) 3/4 length too good there on fast ground. That is the key to him and he found those conditions in his favour again here to record his first success at this level. Settled in last place early by Michael Hills as Frankie Dettori took Summoner to the front, Momentum travelled well and made steady progress in the straight as most of his rivals struggled to get on terms with the leader, who looked to have the race in safe keeping at the quarter-mile pole. As Dettori failed to find as much as expected soon after, Momentum stayed on to pass him with a furlong to race before being pushed out with hands and heels to score. Trainer John Hills said: "It's a little bit difficult with this horse because he really wants fast ground and Michael said it was only just okay as we had rain this morning and it's a little bit loose on the top. He's in the G3 Park S. at Doncaster next week and that may come too quickly. There are one or two other options but he is probably going to go to America in the autumn--he's in the Oak Tree Breeders' Cup Mile at Santa Anita at the beginning of October. He's improving rapidly. We'll just have to work it out."

DUO TOPS CANADIAN SALE AS NUMBERS DIP

A pair of yearling colts each brought bids of C\$150,000 to top the Canadian Breeders Sales Selected Yearlings sale on Tuesday at Woodbine, but numbers were down across the board from last year's figures. The first youngster to reach the top mark was a son of Sultry Song purchased by Roger Attfield. Offered by Woodlands, the bay colt is out of Filly of the Jag (Gilded Time), a half sister to Canadian champion Colorful Vices. Stubbs Investments Inc. equalled that price for a chestnut colt from the first crop of Tale of the Cat. From the consignment of Huntington Stud Farm, he was produced by the Vice Regent mare Regent n' Flashy, a half sister to Bold n' Flashy and Flashy n' Smart, who both earned over \$300,000. In all, 182 yearlings sold for C\$6,458,000 at an average price of C\$35,484. Last year 173 lots grossed C\$7,527,900 and averaged C\$43,514. (Stats p2)
