## CHAMPIONSHIP MATCH

Since its inception in 1984, the G1 Irish Champion S. has staged some intriguing match-ups. Epsom Derby hero Dr Devious (Ire) defeated his arch rival, Irish Derby winner St. Jovite, in 1992, while the 1999 edition witnessed a brilliant display by Daylami (Ire) as he once again handled the talented Royal Anthem. In today's renewal of the epic race at Leopardstown, it will be the rematch of Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's **Galileo (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and Godolphin colorbearer **Fantastic Light** (Rahy). The only other time the two clashed, Galileo triumphed by two lengths in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 28, adding that win to his victories in the G1 Epsom Derby and G1 Irish Derby. It had been fairly easy going for the remarkable athlete until Ascot, and the connections of Fantastic Light will take much from the fact that their horse has been at his best at the 10 furlongs of the Champion S., taking the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup May 27 and the G1 Prince of Wales' S. at Royal Ascot. "[Fantastic Light] looks in great form and I feel that Saturday's race gives him a better chance of beating Galileo," trainer Saeed bin Suroor said. "He is a very good horse over a mile and a half, but most of his big wins have been over a mile and a quarter—that is the perfect trip for our horse." However, the view from Ballydoyle seems to be that Galileo will be better at the shorter distance as well. Trainer Aidan O'Brien may drop the colt all the way back to a mile for the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. Sept. 29, so today's trip should prove no problem. After the Irish Derby, O'Brien said, "He has so much class he can't be a natural mile and a half horse. Certainly a mile or a mile and a quarter is his real trip."

**TIZ THE SEASON**

A year ago, **Tiznow** (Cee's Tizzy) had just one stakes win to his credit, a neck victory in the GIII Affirmed H. at Hollywood in July. But the colt blossomed in the fall, taking the GI Super Derby and GII Goodwood Breeders' Cup H. before running the race of his life to beat Giant's Causeway in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. His autumn campaign earned him Horse of the Year honors, but, battling the image of the retired Point Given, the bay is going to have to work even harder to take that title again this year. He will earn a lot of votes with a win in today's GI Woodward S. at Belmont Park. The four-year-old faces a trio of Grade I winners in **Red Bullet** (Unbridled), **Lido Palace (Chi)** (Rich Man's Gold) and **Albert The Great** (Go for Gin) in his first start since a five-length score in the Mar. 3 GI Santa Anita H. But the back trouble which sidelined him for more than six months seems to be a thing of the past. "He has been training very well," trainer Jay Robbins said. "I think I have him fit enough. My main concern will be how he handles the surface." While Tiznow is untested at Belmont, Albert The Great is a bona fide "horse for the course," with six wins from seven starts at the track. He captured the June 10 GII Brooklyn H. and July 1 GII Suburban H. before running second to four-time Chilean Group 1 winner Lido Palace in the July 28 GI Whitney S. at Saratoga. He gets a nine-pound weight shift in his favor here. Last year's GI Preakness winner Red Bullet returned after more than a year off to win a Saratoga allowance sprint July 28. "Going from seven-eighths to a mile and an eighth against three of the world's best horses is going to be tough," trainer Joe Orseno admitted. "But we've set a goal for this horse and this is another step we need to get to the Breeders' Cup."

Long held by Mick Channon to be one of his best juvenile fillies, Lipstick made the step up to stakes company look easy. Fifth at first asking in the Listed St Hugh's S. at Newbury Aug. 17 on her belated debut, she quickly opened her account next time in a Bath maiden Aug. 24. Stepped up to six furlongs for the first time here, she impressively defeated the colts and more experienced rivals. Slowest away, Lipstick was settled towards the rear on the rail early. Jockey Steven Drowne looked for a gap wide of the fading frontrunner but as that closed one appeared towards the rail past the two-furlong marker. Seizing his chance, Drowne asked Lipstick to quicken through and she did so with the minimum of fuss to lead with 250 yards remaining. Headed soon after by Brett Doyle on Tumbleweed Charm, she showed heart to get back in front with 150 yards to race. Channon commented: "We've had a lot of niggly problems with her but it's good that you get it right. She's got bags of speed and I don't think the trip matters, be it five or six. The owner won the G1 Cheveley Park S. [at Newmarket Oct. 2] a couple of years ago so he's keen to have a go and the G2 Flying Childers S. [at Doncaster on Saturday] is also a possibility for her." Victor Chandler quote Lipstick at odds of 33-1 for next year's 1000 Guineas at Newmarket.

He was coming off a fourth in the Aug. 27 Listed Ripon Champion Two-Yrs-Old Trophy.

**KEENELAND TO LOWER TAKEOUT; ADJUST POST TIMES** The takeout on exotic wagers--such as daily doubles, exactas, trifectas, superfectas and Pick Threes--at the Keeneland meeting which opens Oct. 5 will drop from 19 percent to 16 percent, the track announced yesterday. The takeout on straight wagers will remain at 16 percent. Keeneland follows the lead of the New York Racing Association, which lowered its takeout starting with the Saratoga meet and saw on-track handle grow as a result. "Keeneland's experiment with the reduced takeout is the next step in an industry effort to make the racing product more attractive to the wagering public," Keeneland President Nick Nicholson said. The track is also looking for permission to change its Pick Six wager to a Pick Five, a move which will have to be approved by the Kentucky Racing Commission. In addition, Keeneland will coordinate its post times with Belmont Park during the fall meet, so the two tracks do not run head-to-head. "On most days, the races will be spaced about 15 minutes apart, enabling simulcast patrons a greater opportunity to watch the post parade and wager on their selections," Nicholson said. Post time for the first race at Keeneland will be 1:15 p.m. with the exception of closing day, Oct. 27, when the first race will go off at 11:15 a.m.

**GAVIOLA RETIRED** Grade I winner **Gaviola** (Cozzene--Forest Key, by Green Forest), who has finished off the board in three of her last four starts, has been retired, according to the *Daily Racing Form*. "She hit her peak and it was her time," trainer Billy Turner told *DRF*. "She retired sound and had a good career." The four-year-old filly won six straight races after being switched to the grass last year, including the GIII Herecomesthebride S., GIII Sands Point S., GII Lake Placid H. and GI Garden City Breeders' Cup H., but ended the season with a sixth-place finish as the 4-5 favorite in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland. Second in the GIII Suwanee River H. to start her 2001 campaign, she won the GIII Beaugay H. and was second in the GII New York H., but finished a lackluster eighth in what would be her final start, the GII Diana H. at Saratoga Sept. 3. Overall, she had eight wins, two seconds and two thirds from 17 starts for earnings of \$589,142. Gaviola will be bred next year, but mating plans have not been announced.

**TOBA RECOGNIZES INDUSTRY LEADERS** A large crowd gathered for the annual Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association Awards Dinner, held last night at Adena Springs Farm in Lexington, but the evening belonged to three of the industry's leaders. Harry T. Mangurian, Jr., a Florida horseman who has been North America's top breeder for the last two years, was named TOBA's "Breeder of the Year," Adena Springs own Frank Stronach was named "Owner of the Year," and John Hettinger was honored with the "Industry Service Award" for his work in equine rescue.

**MATTY G TO DARBY DAN FARM** Freshman stallion **Matty G** (Capote--Star Gem, by Pia Star), sire of GI Hopeful S. runner-up Mayakovsky, will move from Pegasus Ranch in California to Darby Dan Farm in Lexington, Kentucky for 2002. The eight-year-old, who will be re-syndicated by Darby Dan, has five winners from his first crop for progeny earnings of \$202,245, good for seventh on the freshman sire list. A graded-stakes winner on turf and dirt, Matty G won the GI Hollywood Futurity and earned \$443,275. "Matty G's precocity as a race horse coupled with a family of consistent class and speed alerted us early on that he had serious potential as a stallion," John Phillips, managing partner of Darby Dan, said. "For years at Darby Dan we have been in need of a sire that produces quick-developing speed without it being just 'cheap' speed. Given his limited opportunity, what Matty G has accomplished is amazing. He is an ideal mate for mares with Northern Dancer and Raise a Native blood."

**The Jockey Club Releases 2000 Breeding Stats:**

The Jockey Club reports that, during 2000, 4,554 stallions covered 64,338 mares in North America. The coverings have resulted in 36,005 foals of 2001, according to Live Foal Reports received as of Aug. 31. It is estimated that approximately 90 percent of the Live Foal Reports have been submitted. The number of stallions decreased 0.9 percent from 1999, while the number of mares bred rose 4.2 percent. In Kentucky, there were 20,998 mares reported bred and 13,693 live foals, as compared to 20,017 mares bred and 13,786 live foals during 1999/2000. The statistics include 157 progeny sired by North American stallions, but foaled abroad; and 57 mares bred to eight North American stallions on Southern Hemisphere time.
