FANTASTIC FINISH

Galileo (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) is mortal after all. Bet down to odds of 4-11 for the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown yesterday afternoon, the three-year-old gave it everything he had, but was unable to get past a gallant **Fantastic Light** (Rahy) and suffered the first defeat of his career, losing by a head. The result, however, was far from a shock. Fantastic Light, sent off the 9-4 second favourite, avenged his defeat in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 28 while getting both a five-pound weight shift and a decrease in distance in his favour. Those factors proved decisive as the five-year-old got first run at the top of the straight before turning back all efforts by Galileo and jockey Michael Kinane. "That was great," said a breathless Frankie Dettori after winning the exhausting tussle. "For a full furlong we were head-to-head and neither horse wanted to give up. Full credit to Galileo. He's a champion, too, and it's one of those races I will savor all my life." Fantastic Light and Galileo are now tied atop the Emirates World Series standings with 18 points each.

LIDO OF THE PACK

Lido Palace (Chi) (Rich Man's Gold), a winner of four Group 1 races in his native country, left South America at the end of 2000 looking for new worlds to conquer. He has found them in New York. Sent off the third choice in yesterday's G1 Woodward S. at Belmont Park, the Southern Hemisphere four-year-old tracked the early pace of **Albert the Great** (Go for Gin) and **Tiznow** (Cee's Tizzy), then drove past the two favorites at the eighth pole and edged away to a one-length victory. With the win, the chestnut could be argued as the best older horse in the country. "Like a lot of South American horses, he is improving as he gets older," trainer Bobby Frankel said. "Every race I've run him, he's gotten better and better." In his first start under Frankel's management, Lido Palace was third in the G3 UAE Derby at Nad Al Sheba in March, then shipped to the U.S. and finished second in the May 19 GII Hawthorne Gold Cup. Frankel decided to add a set of blinkers after that start and, after running second to Albert The Great in the July 1 GII Brooklyn H., the Chilean colt put it together to turn the tables in the July 28 G1 Whitney H. "He's not the kind of horse that is going to jump into the bridle and pull you around the track," Frankel said. "You have to ride him along a little bit. The blinkers have made a big difference--he's a lot more aggressive now." The Hall of Fame horseman indicated that his Woodward winner is unlikely to come back in the Oct. 6 G1 Jockey Club Gold Cup, and a tilt at the Breeders' Cup Classic is up in the air. "The owners [John and Jerome Amerman] would have to put up \$800,000 [to run in the Breeders' Cup], and that's a lot of money," Frankel said. He added that the colt could be back on the road again this fall. "We're thinking about the Japan Cup [Nov. 25] with him," he said. "It makes sense financially. You go for \$2.5 million and you don't put up a quarter--and he'd probably be a lot shorter odds in Japan than he would in the Breeders' Cup."

MOZART ON COURSE FOR BELMONT

Mozart (Ire) (Danehill {USA}), impressive winner of the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 12 and G1 Nunthorpe S. at York Aug. 23, was yesterday reported on course for the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Belmont Park Oct. 27. Trainer Aidan O'Brien commented, "Mozart is well and he will go to the Breeders' Cup. He will go to Southwell around three weeks or a month earlier for a spin, as we did with Giant's Causeway last year."

Muakaad defied a seven-pound penalty here with an authoritative display for a repeat success in this event. Always regarded as a colt of the highest order, he disappointed only in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 27, when sixth behind **Fantastic Light (USA)**. Last time, he ran sixth in the GI Arlington Million Aug. 18 behind **Silvano (Ger)** in rain-softened conditions, but bounced back here in style. Held up in fifth place early by jockey Pat Smullen as **Northern Rock (Jpn)** (**Northern Taste {Can}**) set the pace for stable companion **Exaltation (Ire)** (**Rainbow Quest {USA}**), he travelled easily on the bridle before being asked to quicken at the top of the straight. Stretching out instantly, he was chased by the game **Chiming**, who was receiving 17 pounds. The result was never in doubt, however, as Smullen keeping him up to his work to win

comfortably.

SEEING THE LIGHT As the winner of last year's Emirates World Series, **Fantastic Light** (Rahy) attracted skepticism as he pocketed that championship on points earned through many hard fights, but some of which he did not win. This year, however, he returned with a new dynamism, sweeping away with the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 27 before showing fine acceleration to win the G1 Prince of Wales' S. at Royal Ascot June 20. In yesterday's G1 Irish Champion S., he settled in third behind early leader **Ice Dancer (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) while a length in front of **Galileo (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and clear of **Give The Slip (GB)** (Slip Anchor {GB}). Galileo moved around the latter on the turn into the straight as Dettori aboard **Fantastic Light** got the perfect run up the rail. Joined in battle for the final

1 1/2 furlongs, it was **Fantastic Light** who was stronger, using all his reserves to press home his narrow advantage in the final strides. Godolphin's Racing Manager Simon Crisford commented, "I think it was just the most tremendous race--visually it was really special to watch for everybody. In the build-up to the race, everybody said you've got to sit behind Galileo and use that fifth-gear acceleration to pounce as late as possible, but last night Sheikh Maktoum and Sheikh Mohammed said we're not going to do that, we're going to follow our pacemaker and hopefully set Galileo the task. He's the all-round superstar." It looks like **Fantastic Light**, a troubled fifth in last year's Breeders' Cup Turf, will try the dirt this time. "Sheikh Mohammed was just saying the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic, so it looks like that's where we are going," Crisford said. The bay will find Galileo waiting for him at Belmont Park Oct. 27, according to trainer Aidan O'Brien. "The plan was always to go for the Breeders' Cup after this and I can't see any reason why not, but we'll have to go home and talk about it." Commenting on the race, O'Brien added, "I thought Galileo ran a great race. We probably didn't get our tactics 100 percent right on the day and we just got left in the second part of the race, but there you go. Mick [Kinane] didn't say much and I didn't question him much. He's a horse that loves rhythm in his races and maybe the rhythm wasn't quite as fast as you'd like it to be. He got into his rhythm and kept going, but Frankie [Dettori] had a little bit up his sleeve when he went and joined him at the end."

WOODWARD WRAP-UP Albert The Great (Go for Gin), suffering only his second defeat in eight starts at Belmont Park, finished a solid second in the Woodward and could go next in the Oct. 6 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup. "He ran his race," jockey Jorge Chavez said. "Maybe [Lido Palace] is just better." Added trainer Nick Zito, "I'm happy with Albert, he ran great. We have no excuses." But jockey Chris McCarron said there is room for improvement in reigning Horse of the Year **Tiznow** (Cee's Tizzy), who was making his first start since taking the Mar. 3 GI Santa Anita H. "I don't think we saw the best of him today," McCarron said. "Maybe he was a little rusty. He needed a race to knock the cobwebs off him. When Albert quickened the pace, I shook my stick at him and he gave me a good response. He stuck with it for awhile, but when we straightened for home, he ran out of gas." Last year's GI Preakness winner **Red Bullet** (Unbridled), making his second start after a year layoff, was never in the hunt and finished fifth. "He slipped when he left the gate," jockey Gary Stevens said. "He felt fine going down the backstretch, but he started laboring when he got to the top of the stretch. He was blowing harder than he should have been." Trainer Joe Orseno remarked, "He just wasn't grabbing the track. It's puzzling because I worked him over this track and he went in 1:11 [Sept. 2]. But the only other bad race he had was in the Dwyer [finishing third as the 3-5 favorite last July], and that was also over this track. If he doesn't like this track, I don't know what I'm going to do. I'm still going to stick with my guns and look at the Meadowlands Cup [Sept. 28]."

Trainer Andreas Wohler said of the runner-up, "He got off a step slow and the pace was slow for him. When he finally got clear for the stretch run, he just had too much to make up." As for what's next, he said, "We're going to take him back to Germany and keep him there. The Breeders' Cup Turf is

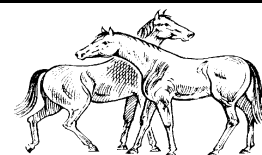
