JUST THE FACTS, 'MAM

Shadwell Stable's **Mutamam (GB)** (Darshaan {GB}) received a perfect pace-pressing trip beneath English jockey Richard Hills and survived a claim of foul from the connections of runner-up **Paolini (Ger)** (Lando {Ger}) to win yesterday's GI Canadian International at Woodbine. The six-year-old was making his second foray into North American racing following his outstanding fourth in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Turf, which saw him finish 3/4 of a length behind eventual Eclipse Award winner Kalanisi (Ire). The dark bay returned from his Breeders' Cup effort to win the G2 Prince of Wales's S. July 10, but could not handle the likes of Galileo (Ire) and Fantastic Light in the G1 King George VI & QE II Diamond S. at Ascot July 28, finishing ninth of 12. He was coming into this off a 1 1/2-length success in Kempton's G3 September S. on Sept. 8. (cont. p2)

IT'S SENURE, TO BE SURE

Senure (Nureyev) atoned for a disappointing eighth-place finish in the GI Arlington Million Aug. 18 with a gritty come-from-behind success in yesterday's GI Clement L. Hirsch Turf Championship S. at Santa Anita. Competitive in the handicap ranks overseas in 1999, the five-year-old impressed during his brief in the U.S. a year ago with three wins from four starts, including a win in the GIII Fastness H. at Hollywood Park last April. Second to Bienamado in this year's GI Whittingham H. June 10, Senure crossed the line second in the GI United Nations H. at Monmouth Park July 1, but was rightfully awarded the race after being interfered with by With Anticipation. Taken back off the early pace, the Juddmonte homebred was a bit rank saving ground from fifth through the opening mile as **Penamacor (Chi)** (Hussonet) was loose on the lead. Shifted out for the stretch drive, the dark bay responded when asked and ran down a game **White Heart (GB)** (Green Dancer) in the waning strides for the win. "I had to keep him relaxed," winning rider Alex Solis commented. "I finally got him to relax around the seven-eighths pole and after that I just had to be patient. I got (him) out at the three-sixteenths and he finished strong."

Both horse and jockey were uninjured, but the decision was taken to abandon the remainder of the meeting.

GOSSAMER HOT

Gossamer (GB) (Sadler's Wells {USA}), winner of Saturday's G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot, was cut down to 3-1 favouritism for next year's G1 1000 Guineas by William Hill. Luca Cumani said after the race: "Gossamer is definitely a Guineas filly--she has got all the speed in the world and she is a miler like her brother [Barathea] was. She has got fantastic acceleration and there isn't a race in the book that is better suited to her than the Guineas." David Hood, spokesman for the bookmakers, said yesterday: "Gossamer maintained her unbeaten credentials at Ascot on Saturday and is now 3-1 favourite [from 6-1] with William Hill for the 1000 Guineas and 8-1 [from 12-1] for the Oaks."

MUTAMAM MAKES THE GRADE Beneath jockey Richard Hills, who guided Summoner (GB) to an upset victory in Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot, **Mutamam (GB)** (Darshaan {GB}) broke alertly and secured his preferred position pressing the early pace of 80-1 longshot **Dawson's Legacy** (Roanoke) into the first turn as **Paolini (Ger)** (Lando {Ger}), off four or five lengths slowly, settled just off the rail towards the back of the pack. Hills gave Mutamam his head with fully four furlongs to run and edged away to lead by a length at the eighth pole. Joined down the center of the track by the German-bred, the two raced as a team to the wire, with Mutamam proving narrowly best. A claim of foul was lodged by the connections of Paolini, alleging that the horse had been struck by the whip of the winner, but that objection was disallowed and the top two finishers remained unchanged. The stewards subsequently disqualified third-place finisher **Zindabad (Fr)** (Shirley Heights {GB}) for interfering with **Falcon Flight (Fr)** (Persian Bold {Ire}) in the stretch and placed him sixth. **Daliapour (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) finished fourth, but was placed seventh for bumping with **Strut the Stage** (Theatrical {Ire}) on the first turn.

E.P. Taylor S. cont.

Choc Ice had only one win to her credit this term, taking a Deauville conditions race at the E.P. Taylor distance Aug. 14. She had shown ability in Group 1 company in the past, finishing third in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac at two and in the G1 Prix Saint Alary this season, but had been off the board in her last two starts, most recently running fifth in a Longchamp conditions race Sept. 13. Taking on older fillies for the first time as the third-longest shot in this 13-horse field, Choc Ice was rated well of the pace as Canadian champion Free Vacation (Fly So Free) set a slow pace, moved up on the far turn while saving ground and angled out for running room in the stretch. She drove between horses at the eighth pole to take the lead and held off fellow French-based three-year-old Volga for the victory. "We got a bad draw [post 13], so I decided to jump out and get over to the rail, save a little ground," winning jockey Johnny Murtagh, who rode Kalanisi (Ire) to victory in last year's G1 Breeders' Cup Turf, said. "I got a great run in between horses and when I asked her, she went very well. She showed a good turn of foot and battled on well right up to the line." Trainer Robert Collet, who captured the 1994 E.P. Taylor with Truly A Dream, added, "I was very confident." The 3-1 favorite, Keemoon (Goldneyev), pressed the pace, but tired badly to finish 11th.

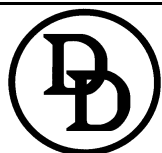

After an eighth in that Classic, he was given some time off and he won his second race back, the G3 Rose of Lancaster S. at Haydock Aug. 11. Last time, he defeated the smart Askham by six lengths in the G3 Select S. at Goodwood Sept. 12. Here, he settled in third early as Sagittarius cut out the running, took over with half a mile remaining and held a clear advantage approaching the straight. Boreas and the game Sagittarius moved up to threaten the leader in deep stretch, but Nayef stayed on well in the desperate conditions and had enough to hold off his pursuers. Trainer Marcus Tregoning said, "Luckily its all coming together with him now and whether he runs again or not this year I don't know. He will stay in training, so we'll just have to wait and see how he takes this. He is in the [G1] Champion S. [Oct. 20], but I think we will leave it until quite late on to decide whether he goes again or not. He's a fresh horse who had a big break and came back really well, so he hasn't had any hard racing. AGNES WORLD TO DALHAM HALL STUD

Agnes World (Danzig--Mysteries, by Seattle Slew), a world-class sprinter who won Group races in Britain, France and Japan, is fast becoming an international sire as well. The six-year-old, who retired to stud at Japan's Shadai Stallion Station this year and is currently standing the Southern Hemisphere season at Australia's Widden Stud, will move to Darley's Dalham Hall Stud in Newmarket for 2002. A \$1,050,000 Keeneland July yearling, Agnes World started his career in Japan and was two-for-three as a juvenile. He made only one start at three, finishing second, but came back the following year to win the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp in France and the C.B.C. Sho in Japan, then added to his reputation in 2000 by becoming the first and, to date, only Japanese-trained horse ever to win in Britain, taking the G1 Darley July Cup. Bred by Calumet Farm, the dark bay set a Japanese record of 1:06.50 for six furlongs and ended his racing career with earnings of \$3,365,680. "Agnes World was a world-class racehorse and is a world-class stallion prospect," Sam Bullard, head of nominations at Darley, said. "He has the ability, the looks and the pedigree to make a great impact and we're thrilled to be standing him." His 2002 stud fee will be £15,000, special live foal.
