## JOHANNESBURG, ZIPPING RENEW RIVALRY

At this juncture **Johannesburg** (Hennessy) looks like the best two-year-old in Europe and connections will bid to cement that claim in this afternoon's G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket. Trainer Aidan O'Brien's colt is bidding to join Hector Protector and Arazi in becoming only the third juvenile to win three European Group 1 events since 1990. Queen's Logic (Ire) showed on Tuesday that it is possible for a two-year-old to improve and remain unbeaten throughout a season spanning May to October and Johannesburg should prove equal to the task here. He has been effective on a fast surface and on easy ground, over the minimum distance, when winning the G3 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot June 21, and over this six furlongs. Having taken the G3 Anglesey S. at The Curragh July 14, he stepped up to Group 1 company with ease, taking the Phoenix S. at Leopardstown Aug. 12 and the Prix Morny at Deauville two weeks later. That day he beat **Ziping (Ire)** (Zafonic) in convincing fashion by 1 1/2 lengths. That colt should be closest again, having improved since his neck defeat of Massarra (GB) in the G2 Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte July 29. The fourth and fifth home at Deauville last time have added significant substance to the form, winning in style on their subsequent starts. David Loder, whose Bahamian Bounty (GB) won here in 1996 before Lujain added to the tally two years later, saddles the unexposed **Farqad** (Danzig) in opposition. He was a workmanlike winner of a Newbury maiden Sept. 21 from a subsequent winner and faces a hard test for such an inexperienced colt. However, his full brother Hayil won this in 1997 and he is certainly bred for the task.

## SHEIKH MAKTOUM CLAIMS DAY TWO PRIZE

The second and longest session of Tattersalls Houghton Yearling Sales in Newmarket, England, was set alight by the 2,300,000 guineas paid by Michael Goodbody, manager of Sheikh Maktoum al Maktoum's Gainsborough Stud Management, for lot 126, the lovely Desert Prince (Ire) colt out of champion Park Express (Ire) (Ahonoora {GB}). The price was a European record for the produce of a first-season sire and the third highest in the history of the sale. The highest price at Tattersalls ever for a yearling came last year with the 3.4 million guineas for the Sadler's Wells colt bought by John Magnier, beating the 3 million guineas for the Nureyev colt purchased by Sheikh Mohammed in 1998. Goodbody was steadfast in his determination to secure the bay colt who is a half-brother to G3 winner Dazzling Park (Ire) (Warning {GB}) and Listed winner Shinko Forest (Ire) (Desert Prince). He only hesitated once, just before making the final bid, while his opponent John Magnier, the Coolmore supremo, consulted Michael Tabor and Demi O'Byrne before going 1.6 million and then Paul Shanahan before what proved to be his final attempt at 2.2 million. Goodbody admitted that he was surprised to have to go to 2.3 million. "He is a lovely horse with the right pedigree and conformation. He has a stallion's pedigree," he said. The Desert Prince (Ire) colt was bred and consigned by Seamus Burns' Lodge Park Stud in Ireland and the fee for the stallion, who stands at the Irish National Stud, was Ir20,000 guineas. Burns declared, "He's a horse who could never be expensive because he is the real thing." John Clarke of the Irish National Stud added, "We bought Desert Prince after he was second to Dr Fong in the 1998 G1 St James's Palace S. and he went on to win the G1 Prix Moulin and G1 Queen Elizabeth II S.. He covered 111 mares this year and we will have no difficulty filling him for next year. We'll decide about his fee after the excitement of the sales, but it could stay at Ir20,000 guineas." ## BERTRANDO COLT TOPS BARRETT'S SALE

A colt by champion older horse Bertrando out of Reason to Be (Aloma's Ruler) brought a final bid of \$120,000 to top Tuesday's Barretts October Preferred Yearling Sale in Pomona, California. Consigned by River Edge Farm, which stands the 12-year-old stallion, the dark bay was taken home by Northern California-based conditioner Jeff Bonde. The California-bred, a May foal, is out of a half sister to California champion older mare and MGSW Bountiful Native (Pirate's Bounty) as well as MSW & GISP True and Blue (Hurry Up Blue). The average of \$10,037 represented a 16.9-percent increase against last year, when the sale was conducted over two days. The median was also ahead by a healthy 61 percent versus 2000.

## FILLIES FRONT AND CENTER AT TIMONIUM

The fairer sex accounted for four of the top five lots during yesterday's third and final session of the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Eastern Fall Yearlings Sale in Timonium, Maryland. The team of Jan, Mace and Samantha Siegel took home two of the top three offerings, including hip 689, a Florida-bred filly by End Sweep. Consigned by White Oak, the bay is the second foal from She's My Choice (El Raggaas), a half sister to the stakes winning Port Arthur and was purchased for a sales-topping \$180,000. Named Sweep's Choice, she was haltered for just \$25,000 at this past January's Keeneland Horses of All Ages Sale. The average for the final session was ahead of 2000 by 11 percent, but the overall average for the three-day event was down by 15 percent. (Midlantic stats, p4)

Following her victory in Saturday's GI Yellow Ribbon S. at Santa Anita, trainer Darrell Vienna expressed doubt that **Janet (GB)** (Emperor Jones) would contest the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf Oct. 27, even intimating that she could be done for the year. "We're recanting," Vienna said yesterday morning. "On further investigation, we've learned that her sire is nominated, so rather than a 20-percent (supplement) for entry, it's nine percent. On that basis, I think that we're giving it some serious consideration." Apart from the drama of the top lot, the sale was very solid below the 500,000-guineas mark. Lot 89, a daughter of Machiavellian was purchased for that exact amount by Sheikh Hamdan al Maktoum's Shadwell Estate Company. She is a half-sister to Chilean St Leger winner Fontanella Borghese (Chi) (Roy), and comes from the family of On The House, winner of the 1,000 Guineas. She was consigned by Shanahan's Ashtown House Stud after being purchased for 215,000gns as a foal. Angus Gold, the Shadwell racing manager, said, "She is a lovely fine big strong filly who should make a two-year-old and train on." Demi O'Byrne, the underbidder for the Machiavellian filly, snapped up a couple of Sadler's Wells for just under half a million guineas. The first, lot 78 consigned by Bugley Stud on behalf of the late Fahd Salman's Newgate Stud Company and costing 460,000 guineas, is a bay colt out of Irish Oaks winner Knight's Baroness (GB) (Rainbow Quest), making him a half-brother to G2 winner Riyadian. Coolmore's agent then went to 450,000 guineas for lot 105, a January 20 foal out of Movie Legend (Affirmed), from David and Diane Nagle's Barronstown Stud. Through two days of the sale, the average has slid below the level of a year ago to the tune of 3.8 percent. The final session starts at 5:30 p.m. today.
