ON TO THE JUVENILE?

Johannesburg (Hennessy) was sent off the 3-10 favourite and inflicted yet another defeat on the game **Ziping (Ire)** (Zafonic) in yesterday's G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket. After winning his third consecutive Group 1 race here, the unbeaten colt now looks likely to head to Belmont Park Oct. 27 to join the exodus of the select Ballydoyle team to the Breeders' Cup. He stretches out to a mile and a sixteenth in the G1 Juvenile, having maintained his perfect record at five and six furlongs in Europe, but he certainly was not stopping over the six furlongs of the Middle Park. He was traveling easily into the lead before striding clear up the rising ground to give trainer Aidan O'Brien his 17th Group 1 winner of 2001. "We were always going to look at the Juvenile after today, so we will see how he comes out of this," O'Brien said. "He has an awful lot of natural pace and Michael [Kinane] said he was going to the line like a tiger today--there was no sign of him giving it all." The winner of the five-furlong G3 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot June 21 after a smooth debut in a Fairyhouse maiden May 30, he collected the G3 Anglesey S. at The Curragh July 14, the G1 Phoenix S. at Leopardstown Aug. 12 and the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville Aug. 26 without exerting himself. He had Ziping 1 1/2 lengths back in second last time out and the Rowley Mile witnessed a replica of that outcome. Held up in fourth early by Kinane, Johannesburg tracked his stable companion **Line Rider** (Danzig), who set off into a five-length lead. Kinane stayed cool, asking his mount for run as his pacesetter began to fade. Given the minimum of encouragement, the winner accelerated into the lead with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining and, ridden out with hands and heels, strode away for an impressive success as Ziping stayed on in his slipstream. Kinane was impressed. "He settles really well and you could probably wait a long time with him if you were travelling a little bit further," he said. "He's a very high-class horse--he keeps getting better and better and he's a great racing professional. There's more stamina there than just six furlongs." Johannesburg is now Ladbrokes's 6-1 favourite for the G1 2000 Guineas back here in May. (*Race chart p. 6*)

BOBBY'S BELMONT BONANZA

Hall of Fame trainer Bobby Frankel has already had a big year, but things could get even bigger when the Brooklyn native saddles runners in four of the five graded races in Belmont Park's super Saturday of Breeders' Cup previews tomorrow in Elmont, New York. So far this year, Frankel has won 34 stakes, 11 of them Grade I events. "I guess I've been blessed this year," the trainer said. "We've been in the right place at the right time." In the day's feature race, the \$1 million G1 Jockey Club Gold Cup, Frankel will send out Grade I winner **Aptitude** (A.P. Indy) and German champion **Sumitas (Ger)** (Lomitas {GB}). Aptitude, second in last year's Kentucky Derby and Belmont S., captured the G1 Hollywood Gold Cup via disqualification before a 4 1/4-length victory in the Aug. 19 GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. last time out. "Until recently, his best race was in the Derby," Frankel said of Aptitude, who added blinkers in his last two starts. "He's developed a lot physically and this is the soundest he's ever been." The Frankel duo will have to contend with Gold Cup defending champion **Albert the Great** (Go for Gin), who is the even-money morning-line favorite for the race. "We should all be as consistent as he is," trainer Nick Zito said of the colt, who is six for eight over the Belmont oval. *Belmont Bonanza cont. p. 3*

THE DEPUTIES STUD FEES ANNOUNCED

Windfields Farm has announced the 2002 stud fees of **Deputy Minister** (Vice Regent--Mint Copy, by Bunty's Flight) and **Silver Deputy** (Deputy Minister--Silver Valley, by Mr. Prospector). Deputy Minister, the country's leading sire by earnings in 1997 and 1998, will again stand for \$150,000 in 2002. Silver Deputy, sire of 40 stakes winners, will stand for \$40,000. The 16-year-old stallion stood for \$75,000 this year. Both stallions stand at Brookdale Farm in Versailles, Kentucky.

Belmont to Offer Keeneland Simulcasts:

Belmont Park will offer full-card simulcasting on Keeneland Race Course's three-week meeting which opens today. The 10 tracks of the Mid-Atlantic cooperative, which includes the Meadowlands, Penn National and Philadelphia Park, have chosen not to simulcast Keeneland's races after the Kentucky track announced that it was reducing its takeout to 16 percent, but still is retaining the three percent charge for its signal. New York OTB has also announced that it will not simulcast Keeneland races. Martin Lieberman, executive director of the Mid-Atlantic cooperative, told the Harness Tracks of America Newsletter that his group, "has and will support all racing industry initiatives that increase fan and public interest in the sport, but the parties will have to share the burden." While Bill Nader, the New York Racing Association senior vice president, said, "We applaud Keeneland for reducing its takeout and are pleased to offer our fans the opportunity to wager on a terrific racing meeting."

She then finished third behind Penny Marie in a tough allowance sprint down the hill at Santa Anita, before coming home eighth after a wide trip in the GIII Mint Julep H. at Churchill Downs May 19. Returning from a 4 1/2-month layoff here, she was sent postward as the 5-2 second choice. TATTERSALLS HOUGHTON CONCLUDES The smallest-ever Tattersalls Houghton Sales ended yesterday in Newmarket with a six-percent decrease in the average, but a 10-percent increase in the median, which hit a record 160,000 guineas. The aggregate for the three-day sale, which saw 190 catalogued and 130 sold, was 28,563,000 guineas, down 13 percent from last year. The story was of continued high demand at the top end of the market, but rockier ground below that level. Edmond Mahony, the Tattersalls chairman, said, "The three weeks leading into this sale have been dominated not only by human tragedy, but also by global financial uncertainty from which none of us are immune. But this week has shown an undiminished appetite for the sport of racing at the highest level and a refusal of people to be deterred from conducting their business, and pleasure, by acts of terrorism. We knew that yet again we had a top-class Houghton catalogue, and we have seen trade very similar to last year's record-breaking Houghton. We have had an average in excess of 200,000 guineas for only the second time, a record median, three seven-figure yearlings, a record for a yearling by a first-season sire and some notable pinhooking triumphs." The final session lacked the drama of the previous two nights, with no seven-figure transactions. The highlight was the purchase of Lot 150, a Sadler's Wells colt out of Russian Ballet (Nijinsky II) who was purchased by Sheikh Hamdan al Maktoum's Shadwell Estate company, with racing manager Angus Gold making the decisive bid of 750,000 guineas. "He is a lovely individual with a tremendous pedigree and that's what you have to pay for a horse like that," Gold said. The underbidder this time was not, unusually, the Coolmore team, which dropped out at 600,000 guineas. Instead it was British agent John Warren who advanced in 25,000 guineas increments while on the phone before declining to go any further. The good-looking colt, from the family of El Gran Senor and half brother to the 1997 Irish Derby second Dr Johnson (Woodman), was consigned by Ireland's Baroda Stud and bred in partnership by retired trainer Vincent O'Brien. Camas Park emerged as the leading vendor of the sale, consigning 13 for 3,830,000 guineas at an average of 294,615 guineas. The top buyer was Sheikh Maktoum al Maktoum's Gainsborough Stud Management, buying seven for 4,985,000 guineas, just beating Demi O'Byrne who signed for 11 on behalf of Coolmore at a cost of 4,610,000 guineas, with Shadwell buying 12 for 4,235,000 guineas.

Frankel will also send out even-money choice **You** (You and I) in the \$500,000 GI Frizette S. The juvenile filly is coming off a neck win in the GI Adirondack S. in August. "I think the Adirondack was one of the best two-year-old races you'll ever see," Frankel said. "I know she's never run this far [1 1/16 miles], but I'm not worried about the distance." Multiple Grade I winner **Flute** (Seattle Slew) will represent Frankel in the GI Beldame S. It will be the three-year-old's first stakes test against older fillies. "Flute is a very special horse," Frankel said of his GI Kentucky Oaks winner. "I think the three-year-olds are better than the older horses and I'm very confident heading into the race. I'm not afraid of anyone in there." **Blu Air Force (Ire)** (Sri Pekan), running in the GI Kelso, rounds out the Frankel brigade. The only stakes race in which Frankel does not have a runner is the GI Champagne S. where the heavy favorite figures to be the unbeaten California invader **Officer** (Bertando). "He's probably the most precocious two-year-old I've ever had," trainer Bob Baffert said of the multiple graded stakes winner. "I've had some nice two-year-olds, but he just does everything so easy. All the races he won, he's come back in good shape. My job is just keeping him sound and happy. He does the rest."

FOUR SUPPLEMENTED TO ARC Four horses have been supplemented to Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at a cost of FF400,000 each. Heading the quartet is Andre Fabre's **Diamilina (Fr)** (Linamix {Fr}), the runner-up in the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp Sept. 16. The filly was joined by Sir Mark Prescott's **Foreign Affairs (GB)** (Hernando {Fr}), Aidan O'Brien's **Saddler's Creek** (Sadler's Wells) and Henri-Alex Pantall's **Idaho Quest (GB)** (Rainbow Quest), runner-up to Hightori (Fr) in the G2 Prix Foy Sept. 16. Saddler's Creek will be employed as a pacemaker for O'Brien's **Milan (GB)** (Sadler's Wells). "I think he is a horse that's maturing and coming right at a very important time," jockey Michael Kinane, who will be aboard in the Arc, said. "He's a colt that's been a bit unlucky in early summer due to a combination of things, so he probably should have a higher profile than he has at the moment. I'm really looking forward to riding him and I think he is going to run a big race in the Arc. He's a horse that will be getting home really well through the last furlong and I'd be very disappointed if he is not in the shake-up." Godolphin withdrew both **Ekraar** (Red Ransom) and **Wareed (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) yesterday, while **Mare Nostrum (GB)** (Caerleon) was taken out by Pascal Bary. A field of 18 looks likely.

This year, stable companion **Della Francesca** has followed the same route. The colt finished third to Official Flame at York Aug. 22 before breaking his maiden at Leopardstown Sept. 8. He faces the smart **Redback**. Four-length winner of the Sept. 1 G3 Solario S. at Sandown last time, Redback picks up a five-pound penalty, but that is unlikely to stop him here.

Racing alone on the stands' rail as Gerald Mosse took Hothaifah into the lead, she raced in fourth and needed encouragement past halfway to make her mark on a race that looked to be unfolding in the centre of the track. The longtime leader shook off a challenge from the short-priced favourite War Zone, but Perrexa emerged as the danger over the far side and closed to take the lead in the final strides.
