## DAYS OF WINE AND ROSES

A year ago, Nick Zito had one of the best days of his career when he sent out **Albert the Great** (Go for Gin) and **A P Valentine** (A.P. Indy) to win the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup and the GI Champagne S., respectively. The Brooklyn-born trainer has won just one race at the current Belmont meet, but will send out both colts in the hopes of getting back on track in the Gold Cup today at Belmont. 'Albert' dominated older rivals last year, sailing along on the front end en route to a six-length triumph in 1:59 1/5. The four-year-old continued his love affair with Belmont this year, winning the GI Brooklyn H. and the GI Suburban H. before running second to Lido Palace (Chi) in both the GI Whitney H. and the GI Woodward S. While he is six-for-eight lifetime at Belmont, Albert the Great has won just three of seven this year. "He's had a couple of tough beats," Zito said. "When you run in these races, there are a lot of what-ifs. I know what kind of horse Albert the Great is. As long as he's in his best stride and he's clear, everything's going to work out." Previously ridden by Jorge Chavez, Albert the Great will have Gary Stevens aboard here. A P Valentine's eye-catching score in the Champagne led Coolmore to purchase his stallion rights for a reported \$15 million, but the bay colt has yet to deliver on his promise this season, his only win coming in a Hialeah allowance. Second to Point Given in both the Preakness and Belmont, he has not raced since finishing fourth to that colt in the Travers S. Aug. 25, but tuned up for the Gold Cup with a bullet five-eighths in :59 Monday. Scheduled to begin his stud career next spring, the three-year-old needs a big effort to secure a berth in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Oct. 27. "He needs to be one-two to go on to the Breeders' Cup," Zito said. "I honestly think that if A P Valentine would have been able to run at four or five, he might have been able to show his potential. You will never get a better-looking horse than A P Valentine. He's the equivalent of Tom Cruise." Bobby Frankel sends out the complementary duo of **Aptitude** (A.P. Indy) and **Sumitas (Ger)** (Lomitas {GB}). "The problem is that Frankel has been very hot," Zito said. "The other problem is that Aptitude beat Gander very convincingly and Gander came back to beat Include and Broken Vow in the Meadowlands Cup. No matter who Frankel runs, he's going to be tough."

## SAKHEE LANDS HIGH DRAW

**Sakhee** (Bahri) was handed a draw of 15 in the 17-horse field for Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Lucien Barriere at Longchamp. Currently the 2-1 favorite for the mile-and-a-half contest with William Hill, Sakhee appears unfavourably drawn, as no horse has won the Arc from a double-figure post since Subotica (Fr) in 1992. But jockey Richard Hills, who rode the colt last year, guiding him to a runner-up finish behind Sinnidar (Ire) in the G1 Epsom Derby, commented yesterday, "That will be no problem to him--he's a pretty straightforward horse to ride as in he gets himself into a nice rhythm." Frankie Dettori, who has been aboard the four-year-old in both starts this year--a three-length tally in the Listed Steventon S. at Newbury July 21 and a seven-length romp in the G1 Juddmonte International S. Aug. 21--will have the mount again in the Arc. Sakhee's trainer, Saeed bin Suroor, said yesterday, "I am not worried about the draw. He came back really well from York and we go [to the Arc] with confidence. I love this horse a lot." As for the mile and a half of the race, he said, "I am not really worried about the distance, but a mile and a quarter is his best trip." **Cont. p2**

Mubtaker turned this race into a procession to add another chapter to the recent success story of Marcus Tregoning and Richard Hills. The latter collected the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot and G1 Canadian International at Woodbine last weekend and does not look like stopping after giving Mubtaker a confident ride here. Highly progressive this year, the colt has gone from strength to strength since finishing a short head second to Zindabad (Fr) in the Listed Leicester Mercury S. at Leicester June 17. Taking the Listed Fred Archer S. at this course June 30 in style, he ran a highly creditable 1 1/2-length second to Grandera (Ire) last time in the Listed Dubai Arc Trial at Newbury Sept. 22. Here he was settled in fourth early by Hills as Island Sound (GB) (Turtle Island {Ire}) cut out the running. Moved up effortlessly to join the front-runner with 500 yards remaining, he strode clear soon after to put the result beyond doubt as Frankie Dettori chased at a distance on Hatha Anna. Eased before the line, Mubtaker was a highly convincing winner here. Hills commented, "He's a really improving sort--he's a Silver Hawk and he's getting stronger every time I ride him, so we are just going to slowly keep increasing the standard of racing now. He's just slowly improved and improved and Marcus has done a great job with him. He could be a horse that could go to Hong Kong in the winter."

**TAX-FREE PUNTING STARTS TODAY**

Starting today, British punters will be able to wager tax-free in betting shops, and William Hill bookmakers are expecting an immediate increase in betting turnover of at least 20 percent this weekend. David Hood, Hills' PR Manager, commented, "There is no doubt that punters are sitting up and paying attention to the opportunity before them. Serious punters have been betting at zero deductions via the internet or telephone to off-shore bookmakers for some time and that business is now back in the UK with the repatriation of our international operations. However, there is no doubt that a minimum 9 percent boost to every punter's returns is acting as a catalyst for them and ordinary punters could well be over £500 a year better off. The change means more opportunities are opening up for them. Once, punters would consider backing something like a 1/2 chance as not worthwhile, now many of them won't think twice about earning a 50 percent return on their money, and each way prospects become more attractive as well."

## KEENELAND RESPONDS TO MIDLANTIC, NYC-OTB BLACKOUT

Despite the decision made by the New York City-Off Track Betting Corporation and a consortium of 10 Mid-Atlantic tracks not to offer their fans the Keeneland signal due to the Kentucky track's reduction in takeout, Keeneland President Nick Nicholson said yesterday that, "I think that history will record that what Keeneland is doing here is a giant step forward for the fans and for pricing, and I'm glad we're doing it." Keeneland opened yesterday's Fall Meeting with a reduced takeout of 16 percent, which NYC-OTB and the Mid-Atlantic tracks argued would negatively impact the amount they net from accepting the signal. The Mid-Atlantic tracks asked Keeneland to cut the rate at which they sell the signal (3 percent), while NYC-OTB demanded Keeneland raise the takeout. Nicholson countered that the increase in business due to the heightened appeal of the signal would more than make up for reduction in takeout. "We're doing this because for years, the industry has talked and talked about the fact that we need to look at takeout, but nobody does anything about it," he said, adding that Keeneland wasn't informed of the Mid-Atlantic tracks' decision until Wednesday or Thursday and that, given more warning, the situation could have been resolved. "I'm not saying we won't negotiate," he said. "I'm saying at the very last minute for them to say, 'cut your rates for one special group of people' is not the right way to do it." Asked what this says about the sport as a whole, Nicholson said, "It's so difficult to get anything done in this industry because it's so difficult to get people to work together. But what it says is that the overwhelming majority of people are willing to work together. Other than the Mid-Atlantic tracks, all the other sites are taking Keeneland, even the Atlantic City casinos. I think there's a lot more unity in the industry than this one little incident [indicates]. The fact that it's difficult to do something for the first time in this industry is not surprising, but it's also not a reason to give up." Yesterday, NYC-OTB offered patrons daytime signals from Belmont, Calder and Finger Lakes. Belmont Park was the only New York simulcast outlet offering the signal, handling \$314,451 in bets on the Keeneland card. That compared very favorably with last year, when the Keeneland meet opened on a Saturday and Belmont handled \$318,555 on the program. NYC-OTB officials did not return calls.

**MONARCHOS BACK IN TRAINING** GI Kentucky Derby winner **Monarchos** (Maria's Mon) is back on the track, trainer John T. Ward Jr. reports. The three-year-old, unraced since finishing third in the GI Belmont S., was diagnosed with a hairline fracture in his right knee at the beginning of July and was sidelined for nearly three months. "He's been galloping for a week on the training track [at Keeneland]," Ward said yesterday. "We'll bring him to the main track at the end of next week. He's having a great time right now, but he'll have to get serious pretty soon." Plans call for the three-year-old to return to racing during the Gulfstream meeting.

Third to champion Perfect Sting in the GII Black Helen H. in April, she returned in the summer with a pair of thirds to divisional heavyweight England's Legend (Fr). She missed by 2 1/4 lengths in the GII New York H. before taking the show spot in the GI Beverly D. S. over yielding ground at Arlington Aug. 18. Scratched out of another meeting with that filly in last week's GI Flower Bowl at Belmont, she was sent off as the third choice here. Well back early, she took the overland route on the far turn and reached contention while seven wide. Spook Express leaned in slightly against Solvig, but that filly never lost stride as the South African-bred bay motored down the center of the course. "The firm ground was a big plus for her," winning rider Mike Smith. "She was pulling me today, not like she did at Arlington on the soft ground." The even-money favorite and defending champion, Tout Charmant (Slewvescent) settled into a stalking position, lacked room in the stretch, but finally found it along the rail, just missing second by a head and a neck.

Unbeaten in four starts on the West Coast, **Officer** has shipped to New York in search of his first Grade I score. The \$700,000 Barretts purchase has won back-to-back graded stakes under wraps, most recently the seven-furlong GII Del Mar Futurity Sept. 5. While Officer will be trying a route for the first time, trainer Bob Baffert is unfazed. "I'm looking at it as a small stretchout," he said. "Going the one-turn mile and a sixteenth isn't the same as going two turns. The two turns is like a super stretchout because the second turn confuses them a bit. I'm not worried about the distance, I'm worried about the competition. Most of the horses in there can run. **Saarland** can run." That colt, a son of Unbridled--Versailles Treaty, rallied four wide to break his maiden going a mile over this surface Sept. 8 and should love today's added ground. That was an exceptional race." **GOFFS ARC SALE SET FOR TODAY** The 2001 Arc Weekend, sponsored by the Lucien Barriere Group, includes the running of six Group 1 races and has become the richest race meeting in Europe. With a 2000 average of FF617,000, the Arc Sale of Horses in Training has become the best sale of its kind in Europe and has begun to attract potential buyers not only from Europe, but also from America and Asia. Fillies in- or out-of-training, destined for a career at stud, last year realised an average of FF1,210,000. This year's sale features 70 lots from the some of the top stables in France, Germany and Italy. Lots to watch include the German champion **Belenus (Ger)** (Lomitas {GB}), winner of the G1 Deutsches Derby and G1 Europa-Preis in 1999 and third in the G1 Grosser Kolner Pokal this year; the Niarchos family's proven three-year-old **Domedriver (Ire)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}), a two-time Listed winner who finished third in the G3 Prix Quincey at Deauville Aug. 28; **Aghnoyoh (Ger)** (Local Suitor), a Group winner in France and Germany; and **Lunasalt (Ire)** (Salse), winner of the G3 Prix du Palais Royal at Longchamp in May. The sale also feature well-bred fillies, including a trio from HH Aga Khan by Danehill, Linamix (Fr) and Persian Bold (Ire). The one-day Arc Sale will be held at the Saint-Cloud Goffs sales complex, with bidding beginning at approximately 6:30 p.m., after the running of the last race at nearby Longchamp.

**\$6.8 MILLION YEARLING DEBUTS AT THE CURRAGH** Two-year-old **Tasmanian Tiger** (Storm Cat--Hum Along, by Fappiano), who topped the 2000 Keeneland September Sale in Lexington after drawing a bid of \$6.8 million from Demi O'Byrne, makes his debut in the 3.15 at The Curragh this afternoon. Racing for the connections of Michael Tabor, Aidan O'Brien and Michael Kinane, the chestnut is being held at 2-5 after drawing post five in the 16-horse field of maidens. A half-brother to Eclipse Award winner Storm Song--the champion two-year-old filly in 1996 after taking the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies--Tasmanian Tiger, consigned by Lane's End as agent, is the most expensive yearling sold at auction since Seattle Dancer brought \$13.1 million in 1985.
