A YEAR TO REMEMBER

Has Bobby Frankel made a deal with the Devil? It seems the Hall of Fame trainer can do no wrong this season. He went into yesterday's Breeders' Cup Preview Day at Belmont Park with 11 Grade I wins to his credit this year and promptly added two more to run his total to a lucky 13. After saddling **You** (You and I) to take the GI Frizette S., the native New Yorker sent out **Aptitude** (A.P. Indy) in the \$1 million Jockey Club Gold Cup and watched as the colt swept past **Albert The Great** (Go for Gin) and pacesetter **Generous Rosi (GB)** (Generous {Ire}) at the top of the lane and galloped away to a breathtaking 10-length victory. It was the third straight victory for the four-year-old, who picked up his first stakes win when Futural was disqualified in the July 1 GI Hollywood Gold Cup and got it done on his own last time, taking the Aug. 19 GI Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. in his second start with blinkers added. Frankel hopes he can make it four in a row in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Oct. 27. "Obviously, I feel good going into the Breeders' Cup, but I still have to win one," Frankel, who is 0-for-36 on racing's championship day, said. "Talking about it and getting there are two different things." (*Gold Cup, cont. p2*)

80 YEARS YOUNG

Godolphin's **Sakhee** (Bahri) will put his perfect record this year on the line when he goes postward in the 80th renewal of the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Lucien Barriere this afternoon at Longchamp. The bay colt put up one of his finest performances of last year in defeat when going down by a length to Sinndar (Ire) in the G1 Epsom Derby. Sakhee then ran fourth in the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown the following month and was diagnosed with a chipped knee. While Sinndar rampaged his way through the autumn, ending the campaign with an Arc victory, Sakhee sat it out as connections employed patience. He returned in July to beat Aldwych (GB) by three lengths in the Listed Steventon S. at Newbury, a fine prep race for the G1 Juddmonte International S. at York Aug. 21. That day he annihilated his opponents by seven lengths while eased down. Having peaked at the right time, Sakhee now has at his mercy the race that sealed Sinndar's mighty reputation last year, despite the inauspicious wide draw. He may have most to fear from **Milan (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), who bids to become the first St. Leger winner to take this race since Ballymoss (GB) in 1958. However, that horse captured his Arc as a four-year-old, and while the three-year-old Milan has smart form over this trip, it has been a long drought for Leger winners in this race. French hopes rest mainly with Daniel Wildenstein's **Aquarelliste (Fr)** (Danehill) and Gary Tanaka's **Hightori (Fr)** (Vettori {Ire}). The connections of the former are highly confident that she can emulate All Along (Fr), winner in 1983 and Allez France, the victress in 1973. She has the form to win it, having taken the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes in June before returning to win the G1 Prix Vermeille Sept. 16. However, both were on good ground and she will encounter significantly softer conditions here. Fifth to Sinndar last year, Hightori ran third in the G1 Dubai World Cup at Nad al Sheba Mar. 24, then returned to Europe to finish a short head second in the G1 Prix d'Ispahan in May. Subsequently third behind Fantastic Light in the G1 Prince of Wales' S. at Royal Ascot, he filled the same spot behind Galileo (Ire) in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 28. Last time he was a steady winner of the G2 Prix Foy Sept.

THAT'S ALL FOR AMEERAT Following a seventh-place finish in the G2 Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket yesterday, it was announced that this year's G1 1000 Guineas heroine **Ameerat (GB)** (Mark of Esteem {Ire}--Walimu {Ire}, by Top Ville {Ire}) has been retired. After the race, trainer Michael Jarvis commented, "It was a great day when Ameerat won the 1000 Guineas and it is just a pity things haven't worked out since then." She never recaptured that form in three subsequent starts. After beating Muwakleh (GB) by a neck in the fillies' Classic, Ameerat went on to finish fifth behind Banks Hill (GB) in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot and eighth to Noverre (USA) in the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood Aug. 1. Breeding plans have not been announced.

SANDOWN ABANDONED

Sandown was forced to abandon its scheduled meeting yesterday due to waterlogging. After the first two races on the straight five-furlong chute had been called off at noon, the remainder of the card was lost after an inspection at 1:30 p.m. Clerk of the course Andrew Cooper told *PA Sport*: "We had to abandon on the grounds of safety. We had a shower following the earlier inspection, making a total of 16 millimetres of rain so far today. We had a delegation of trainers and jockeys who looked at the course with us. There are patches on the home straight, mainly between the two- and three-furlong markers, that are deemed not safe enough for racing to go ahead."

HUGHES INJURED

Jockey Richard Hughes will miss his rides at Longchamp today after suffering a suspected broken leg at Newmarket yesterday. The incident occurred at the start of the EBF Allington Maiden S., when his mount, the filly Carmelita (GB) flipped over near the stalls and landed on top of the jockey. He was taken to hospital soon after.

FALLON SUSPENDED

Kieren Fallon was suspended yesterday for five days from Oct. 15 to Oct. 19 for irresponsible riding of a minor nature. The incident occurred when he was weaving his way through on the winner Independence (GB) in the G2 Sun Chariot S., causing interference to two of the unplaced fillies.

Protectress confirmed a lofty home reputation in her racecourse debut to win at stakes level at first asking. Cut by William Hill from 33-1 to 25-1 during the week for next year's G1 1000 Guineas, she was widely to justify that support here. Held up in last place early by a confident Richard Quinn, she tracked the pace set by Ristra (USA) (Kingmambo {USA}) before being asked to gain closer order as Islington made her move past half-way. Quickening past that rival with a furlong remaining, she did not stretch away when in front, allowing Snowfire to threaten on the far side. She was headed by that filly inside the final 50 yards, but rallied under pressure to lead again in the final strides.

☆ **JOCKEY CLUB GOLD CUP** ☆

APTITUDE TEST Sent off the 7-5 second choice in yesterday's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, **Aptitude** (A.P. Indy) roared into the lead at the top of the lane and pulled away to his most impressive victory to date. The runner-up in both the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Belmont S. last year, the colt was off all summer, then ended the year with a disappointing eighth-place finish in the GII Clark H. at Churchill Downs Nov. 24. He made his 2001 debut in the G1 Dubai World Cup and finished sixth, then came back to the U.S. and, after a vacation, finished third in the June 10 GII Californian S. at Hollywood. "Everybody had him down," trainer Bobby Frankel said. "You guys [the press] had him down and out. I don't get mad, but it just motivates me to show you what I've got." The dark bay came back with blinkers on in the July 1 GI Hollywood Gold Cup and finished second, but was awarded the win, his first in stakes company, via a stewards' disqualification. He added a score in the Aug. 19 GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. last time, but really opened eyes with his effort yesterday. "He has always had ankle problems and we gave him the proper time to set them up good," Frankel explained. "This is the soundest I've ever had him, and that's why I've felt so good about him. I think a lot of A. P. Indys are immature, and he was immature. He had really come around in the last three months." While Frankel had every reason to be pleased, it was a down day for trainer Nick Zito. **Albert The Great** (Go for Gin), who has never before finished off the board at Belmont Park, made a run to join pacesetter **Generous Rosi** (GB) (Generous {Ire}) on the far turn, but faded in the drive to finish nearly 20 lengths behind the winner in fourth, while **A P Valentine** (A.P. Indy) was never in the hunt and ended up sixth. "I wish I knew what was going on," Zito said. "I have no explanation. Both horses trained great and looked great. I wish I had something to say, but I have no excuses. I will have to talk to both owners about the Breeders' Cup." As for the future of front-running Generous Rosi, the runner-up at 23-1, trainer Niall O'Callaghan said, "I doubt the Breeders' Cup is in our plans. We're considering the Clark H. [GII, Churchill Downs, Nov. 23] or the Japan Cup Dirt." With the Gold Cup win, jockey Jerry Bailey broke the singles-season earnings mark of \$19,465,376 he set in 1996. Bailey has earned \$19,841,901 (according to the *Daily Racing Form*) so far this year.

Exogenous added blinkers for the first time in the GI Gazelle H. last time out and closed for a decisive 3 1/2-length score. She made it two-for-two with the hood here, but not without controversy. The gray tracked the pace early under regular rider Javier Castellano and was in tight quarters on the turn, then rallied to join 9-10 favorite Flute and Spain in the stretch and there caused her own traffic problems. Lugging in under Castellano's right-handed whip while continuing to race on her left lead, the three-year-old brushed with Spain, was pulled to the outside, then drifted in and bumped her more soundly before drawing clear. The stewards took a look at the videotape, but the order of finish was allowed to stand. "It looked like it could go either way," winning trainer Scotty Schulhofer said. "When I watched it the first time, I knew she kind of squeezed in a little bit, but it didn't look that bad. Then I saw the rerun...I was a little concerned that she might have gone a little too far." Trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who saddled Spain, said, "We took the worst of it. If we didn't carry [Exogenous], we would have beaten [Flute for second]." But he was pleased with his filly's effort, saying, "We would have liked to have won this, but she is going the right way for the Breeders' Cup." Trainer Bobby Frankel is also thinking GI Breeders' Cup Distaff for runner-up Flute. "This should set her up well for the Breeders' Cup," he said. But Schulhofer believes that if his filly beats Flute again Oct. 27, she'll get the Eclipse Award. "If she wins the Breeders' Cup, she's got to be three-year-old filly of the year," he remarked.

Swept Overboard was far back as Freespool sprinted through a half in :43.45, trailing the leader by 8 1/2 lengths at that point, but came flying at the finish to win his first-ever Grade I stakes going away. The gray was coming off a pair of second-place finishes in the Aug. 12 GII Pat O'Brien H. at Del Mar and the Sept. 8 GIII Bay Meadows Breeders' Cup H., where he was three-quarters of a length behind Lexicon (Conquistador Cielo) in a race run in 1:07 4/5. Slow to get started this time, he was settled in last as Freespool cut out the running and champion Kona Gold tracked the pace from fourth. The Eclipse winner drove to the front at the eighth pole, but Swept Overboard was hitting his best stride and dashed past him in the final yards before drawing clear. "He relaxed very well today, exactly like we hoped he would," jockey Eddie Delahoussaye said. "When I called on him, believe me, he gave it to me." Added trainer Craig Dollase, "He needed to run a big race to earn a trip to the Breeders' Cup. I think this stamped him pretty well--he deserves to be in the Breeders' Cup." As for last year's Breeders' Cup Sprint winner, jockey Alex Solis said, "He ran an incredible race. He really impressed me, carrying 127 pounds and giving 11 pounds to the winner. Now it's going to be equal weights and that's going to really help him." The final time of 1:07.64 broke the stakes record of 1:07.84 set by Lexicon in 1999; that one finished last after pressing the pace here.

China Visit recaptured the form that saw him win last year's UAE Derby at Nad al Sheba with a sterling display of front-running over this muddy ground. Sixth in the 2000 GI Kentucky Derby at Churchill Downs, he was unable to land a blow in the G1 St James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot the following month and went to the sidelines. The colt raced three times in Dubai this winter, taking a leg of the Maktoum Challenge and running fourth in the G3 Godolphin Mile, then was given another rest. He returned in the G3 Park S. at Doncaster Sept. 13 and showed signs of a revival of old glories when beaten only a half length by Tough Speed. Here he was taken to the front early and established a clear lead as Thierry Thulliez sat with Jim and Tonic at the back of the field. That gelding was left with nearly 10 lengths to make up as they turned into the back straight and that proved an impossible task as the leader galloped relentlessly towards the line, where he had a comfortable margin over the game runner-up. "After he had run last year in the Kentucky Derby, it knocked him out and he took a long time to recover," said Godolphin's Simon Crisford. "We knew that he was back to his best and that he would appreciate the soft conditions [here]. We will try to find a suitable Group 1 race for him to run in, over soft ground." As for the globetrotting Jim and Tonic, Thulliez said, "He had not run for four years at Longchamp and didn't go downhill too well. We had a lot of ground to make up and, on this ground, he doesn't quicken as well as on

Albarahin got the better of Chancellor in another driving finish to gain his first Group success, having taken the Listed Doonside Cup at Ayr Sept. 22 in his previous start. Second in a Churchill allowance on Derby Day in his 2001 debut, he came back to win the June 30 GIII Aristides H. and Aug. 25 Arlington Sprint H. and was the second choice to make it three in a row. Settled in last as 6-5 **Snow Ridge** (**Tabasco Cat**) zipped through a half in :44, he had only once horse behind him at midstretch, but motored to the front in the final furlong and drew clear. "This horse runs like a three-year-old," jockey Calvin Borel said. "He had a laid-back style, which is my style, and then he gives you a three-year-old's burst of speed. I love this horse."

Banks Hill and **Crystal Music** meet again in an intriguing rematch. They met last over the mile at Royal Ascot in the G1 Coronation S. June 22 and it was Banks Hill who came out on top by 1 1/2 lengths. Crystal Music has not been seen since, but her previous second to Imagine (Ire) in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh May 27 is form of the highest standard. Her connections have always felt that she would be better suited by longer distances and she should make a bold bid as a fresh horse racing over the right trip here. Trainer Andre Fabre must also feel that Banks Hill needs further now, having been beaten three lengths by Slickly (Fr) in the G1 Prix du Moulin Sept. 9 last time. Prior to that she was promoted to second behind Vahorimix (Fr) upon the disqualification of Proud Wings (Ger) in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville Aug. 19. She was entirely unsuited by the slow early pace there and deserves another chance to show her Ascot form, despite running on ground softer than ideal.

Rebelline is an interesting contender, having won the G2 Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh June 30 in style over this trip. Racing over faster ground and two furlongs further in the G1 Irish Oaks at The Curragh July 15, she could manage no better than seventh. Back to her ideal distance and on ground she loves, she is capable of upsetting.
