ONE HUNDRED REASONS TO CELEBRATE

"You have to bring a star to the Arc" said trainer Saeed bin Suroor, and that's just what Godolphin did. Placing their hopes for yesterday's 80th running of the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Lucien Barriere at Longchamp on 12-5 favourite **Sakhee** (Bahri), connections watched as their colorbearer annihilated his rivals, winning by six lengths over the boggy Longchamp turf. In the process, the colt gave Godolphin its first Arc victory, and provided jockey Frankie Dettori with his 100th Group 1 success. "He's a great horse and a fresh horse, too, so I'm looking forward to riding him next year," Dettori, at his charismatic best, said. "I have to be honest and say that this horse would give Fantastic Light a race--he's a real champion on his own and he won as we expected." Silencing all doubts regarding his wide draw, his stamina and his effectiveness on this loose ground, Sakhee travelled strongly just off the leaders before powering away in the straight, stretching further clear the further he went.

FREEDOM RINGS

While much of the pre-race hype centered on the match-up between reigning Horse of the Year **Tiznow** (Cee's Tizzy) and GI Pacific Classic winner **Skimming** (Nureyev), 39-1 longshot **Freedom Crest** (To Freedom) collared the two favorites in the stretch en route to a one-length victory in yesterday's GII Goodwood Breeders' Cup H. at Santa Anita. Freedom Crest capped a three-race win streak this past winter with a three-length tally in the Jan. 7 GII San Pasqual H. Off five months after an eighth-place finish in the GII San Antonio, the five-year-old gelding returned with a narrow loss in the July 7 GII Bel Air H. and a sixth-place effort behind Skimming in the July 29 GII San Diego H. Yesterday, Freedom Crest stalked the early lead of Skimming, bid between Tiznow and Skimming on the turn and took over at midstretch. He was inching clear at the wire. "He was closer [to the pace] than I expected, but he was pretty fresh," said winning trainer Richard Baltas. "About the quarter pole, I thought he had a shot, because that's how he ran last year here. he was very tough last year. He ran his race today." Asked if Freedom Crest would go on to the Breeders' Cup Classic, Baltas said, "Possibly, yes." Tiznow, sent off the slight favorite, moved up three wide leaving the backstretch, fell back nearing the stretch and was slowly gaining on runner-up Skimming in the final yards. Of the beaten favorite, trainer Jay Robbins commented, "He just couldn't go by those two horses. He didn't put in that big punch and they were slowing down big the last part. The fractions were good early and slowed down late. They should have benefitted him." Robbins added he would have to see how the four-year-old came out of the race before commenting on possible Breeders' Cup plans. Tiznow's jockey Chris McCarron admitted he was puzzled by the champion's performance. "Today, he didn't put in his normal, hard-trying effort. It just wasn't there. He picked it up too little, too late. He passed everybody galloping out past the wire." Skimming set the pace from the start, but couldn't hold off Freedom Crest in the lane. "He ran his race," said Bobby Frankel's assistant trainer Humberto Ascanio. "We have no excuses, although the fractions were pretty fast." **Race Chart p. 7**

Jockey Frankie Dettori cost British bookmakers dearly with his win in yesterday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Lucien Barriere aboard **Sakhee (USA)** (Bahri {USA}). Sakhee was Dettori's fifth Group winner on Arc weekend. David Hood, Hills' spokesman, said, "When Frankie does things, he does them in style, and his win on Sakhee will have won well over a £1million for punters on Sunday. The levels of business were significantly higher than last year, maybe 20 percent higher, boosted by the tax-free situation and the quality of the card. But the sting in the tail was Frankie again, because he was in such hot form--punters followed him blindly in the Arc and Sakhee was a well backed 9-4 favourite."

SAKHEE STORMS TO ARC VICTORY The convincing success of **Sakhee** (Bahri) in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Lucien Barriere did not come without warning. The four-year-old had destroyed the competitive field assembled for the G1 Juddmonte International S. at York Aug. 21, cruising home by seven lengths in a victory which went some way to make up for his one-length defeat by **Sinndar** (Ire) in the 2000 G1 Epsom Derby. Two chips to a bone in his knee sustained in the Classic denied him a chance to atone for that loss. In hindsight, he ran with great credit to be fourth in the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown the following month before the injury was discovered. Given nearly a year to recover, the bay returned to take the Listed Steventon S. at Newbury July 21 before his York triumph. There was intense speculation surrounding his participation in the Arc after that performance, but owner/breeder Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum ended the talk with a late decision to run and the noises from the Godolphin camp subsequently were uncharacteristically bullish. Jockey Frankie Dettori reflected that confidence in the race, easing his mount into fifth early behind the pace-setting **Saddler's Creek** (Sadler's Wells) and **Anzillero** (Ger) (Law Society). Sakhee was almost travelling too well at times, with Dettori having to temper his colt's enthusiasm. As they turned towards the back straight, the Kentucky-bred had moved into second and was being prepared for his finish. Passing **Anzillero** at the top of the straight, he was asked for his effort and responded to pull away from the chasing **Golan** (Ire) (Spectrum {Ire}). Given two smacks with the whip inside the final quarter of a mile, he quickened clear before being pushed out under hands and heels to secure the impressive victory. **Golan** gave way in the closing stages to the game filly **Aquarelliste** (Fr) (Danehill) and **Dominique Boeuf**, with **Yutaka Take** crowning a fine afternoon to get third on **Sagacity** (Fr) (Highest Honor {Fr}). "We knew we had the best horse—we knew everything was right," Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford commented. "Frankie said to me last night, 'This horse cannot get beaten unless I fall off him.' We were very, very confident and he is a champion. We have had some great champions over the years and Sakhee is very much one of those. He is as good as all of them and hopefully he can go on and keep racing." Sakhee now has a choice of targets between the G1 Dubai Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 20 or the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf at Belmont Park Oct. 27.

A dual Group 1 winner in her native Argentina, Miss Linda took a few starts to show that kind of form in the U.S., but she looks to be on top of her game now. The dark bay, who succeeded at the highest level on both turf and dirt in South America, made her stateside debut after a six-month layoff and finished third in a pair of New York allowance races on the main track in May. She was switched to the turf for her next outing and ran fifth, but improved sharply after that effort. The four-year-old took the Aug. 5 Lady's Secret S. at Monmouth Park by 7 1/4 lengths. Although she won her next outing, a Saratoga money allowance Aug. 27, by only a neck, the margin of victory was deceiving as she was wrapped up in the final yards. A rank outsider with the return to elite company, the Latina filly was dogged by Vivid Sunset (Mt. Livermore) as she cut out the early fractions, but opened up her lead at the head of the lane and was never in danger as she raced down the stretch to another Grade I win. "She ran really great," jockey Richie Migliore said. "[Trainer] John Kimmel has done a great job with her. She's shown a ton of ability, but she is quirky. If you do something she doesn't like, she'll pin her ears and quit on you. I think it really helps that I get on her all the time." The slight 3-1 choice Pompeii (Broad Brush), sat just off the early pace, but faded in the final furlong and finished fifth.

Rock of Gibraltar turned on the after-burners for a sensational success in this rain-softened ground and put himself back in the picture for next year's Classics. That position was threatened briefly when he finished a length behind Dubai Destination when carrying a four-pound penalty in the G2 Champagne S. at Doncaster last time out Sept. 14. Previously, he had made a success of shouldering a three-pound extra burden in the G2 Gimcrack S. at York Aug. 22, a penalty picked up in winning the G3 Railway S. by two lengths from Hawk Wing at The Curragh July 1. This result was decided as soon as jockey Michael Kinane allowed the colt to stride on in the straight. Settled in fourth on the rail early as Imtiyaz and Frankie Dettori cut out the running, he was always travelling extremely well and, as he was edged off the rail at the top of the straight, he was on the bridle while his rivals started to struggle. Kinane kicked on with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining and the response was electric. The colt instantly opened five lengths on the field before being eased near the line to an emphatic 18th Group 1 success in 2001 for handler Aidan O'Brien. Part-owner Sir Alex Ferguson, famed as the manager of Manchester United Football Club, was thrilled. "This is a wonderful day for me," he said. "This is my first visit to Longchamp and the first success in a Group 1 race for my colors. Obviously, Rock Of Gibraltar is a top horse. I feared the ground, but he handled it beautifully and we can have high hopes for next year."

Sulk denied Danseuse d'Etoile in a thrilling finish here to provide trainer John Gosden his second renewal of this race. Sulk was a close fifth in a Newmarket maiden Aug. 24, a race won by the Group 1 performer Esloob, and most recently landed a hard-fought maiden win at Salisbury Sept. 6. Stepping up significantly over previous contests, the filly was held back early as Ya Hajar (GB) (Lycius) went to the front. That one set an exacting pace over the slow ground which started to take its toll at the top of the straight. It was Danseuse d'Etoile with jockey Olivier Peslier aboard who attacked from the outside and, with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining, looked the certain winner. But Sulk made steady progress along the rail as Ya Hajar drifted wide and, lengthening well inside the final furlong, she headed Danseuse d'Etoile in the final strides to clinch the victory. "I was lucky the gap opened inside--she's a little bit lazy, but when I started riding I knew she was going to get there," Dettori said. Gosden added, "It was a big jump up, but she handles the ground, being by Selkirk, out of a Darshaan mare. She stays well and they went quick. She has always worked extremely well at home, but she tends to be shy of everything--we put the visor on her and it really makes her concentrate. Frankie said she was a dream ride today. They have also dropped the rail now and we are now on the fresh ground. That made a big difference to this filly. I knew that this race was winnable, and I am lucky enough to have brave owners like James Wigan and Prince Khalid Abdullah, who let me supplement these two fillies. They deserve full credit."

She will be retired to stud at the end of the season, but she is in splendid form presently and might run once more. We have to find a suitable Group 1 for her, maybe abroad, but it is too early to say where."

Winning trainer John Hammond said, "She needs soft ground to give her best and didn't have it all season. She loves Longchamp and, with the help of a good draw, I knew she could perform at her best. I think she is through for the season."

Now, he will probably return at the end of the month in the G1 Prix Royal Oak [French St Leger, Oct. 28]. It is a great day for me, my staff and the jockey. We could not be more happy and proud."

"I was a little worried going a mile today because of all the traffic I thought we'd have to go through, but he was forwardly placed and we had a great trip, so it didn't matter," winning jockey Jerry Bailey said.

The winner of this race last year, Delaware Township was no factor when finishing 10th in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint to end the season. He came back to be fourth in the GIII Mr. Prospector H. at Gulfstream Park Jan. 15, filled the runner-up spot in both the Feb. 19 GII General George H. and Apr. 14 GIII Bold Ruler H., then picked up his first victory of the year in the Apr. 28 Damitrius S. at Delaware Park. The late-running sprinter took a break after that race, returning to finish a rallying second in the Aug. 5 GII Alfred G. Vanderbilt H. at Saratoga. The chestnut earned his first Grade I win, driving past subsequent GI Vosburgh S. hero Left Bank to take the Forego H. at Saratoga Sept. 1. "I just have so much confidence in this horse," jockey Eibar Coa, enjoying a graded-stakes double on the day, said. "He's so sharp right now." As for what's next, trainer Ben Perkins Jr., said, "We'll probably just leave him here [at Belmont]. He'll have some light breezes, and then run in the Breeders' Cup Sprint." Trainer John Kimmel has not yet decided if he will send runner-up Hook and Ladder to the Sprint. "The horse lost about a week of training because of a little problem with his shoeing," Kimmel said. "He really only had two breezes in between races and, conditioning-wise, he might have been at a little bit of a disadvantage, but I thought he gave us a pretty good performance."

Eight lengths off the pace as they raced down the backstretch, the filly was fanned four wide as she rallied around the far turn, but proved to be much the best in the stretch, blowing past her rivals to win by a widening 5 3/4 lengths. "I thought it was a great debut," trainer Neil Drysdale said, adding, "If she runs well in the Astarita, we'll consider the Breeders' Cup."
