GOFFS ORBY SALE GETS UNDERWAY

The Goffs Orby Sale gets underway today at the Kildare Paddocks in Co. Kildare, Ireland and, over the next two days, 400 lots go under the hammer. World-class sires represented include Alzao, Barathea (Ire), Danehill and his promising freshman son Danehill Dancer (Ire), Darshaan (GB), Indian Ridge (Ire), In The Wings (GB), Kingmambo, Kris S., Linamix (Fr), Miswaki, Nashwan, Nureyev, Rainbow Quest, Rahy, Red Ransom, Sadler's Wells, Theatrical (Ire), Unfuwain and Woodman. It's hard to pick just one yearling that will set the auditorium alight, but Kilcarn Stud could steal the headlines with Lot 343, a Kingmambo colt out of Spirit Of Tara (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). He is the second foal from the stakes-placed mare, who is in turn out of champion Flame Of Tara (Ire), dam of Salsabil (Ire) and Marju (Ire). Another expected to tax the auctioneer is Lot 423, a filly by Sadler's Wells out of Canadian champion Alywow (Alysheba); her half-brother by Danzig brought Ir£2,000,000 at this sale last year. Kilcarn is also responsible for lot 397, a colt by Danehill who is a half brother to Second Empire (Ire) and Hemingway (Ire). There are two supplemental entries to the sale which do not appear in the catalogue. Going through the ring as Lots 446 and 447 are two yearlings which sold at the Keeneland July Sale, each bringing \$700,000. The first is a son of Kingmambo out Grapevine (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). The chestnut is from the family of two-time champion Committed, herself the dam of GISW Pharma and MGSW Hap. The second is a son of Gone West out of champion Market Booster (Green Dancer). Both are from the Oak Lodge Stud consignment. Lot 151 is significant in that the filly, sent up by Lynn Lodge, is the only daughter of Nureyev offered in Europe this year. One for the early birds could be Lot 43. Consigned by Lodge Park Stud, the bay is a daughter of Danehill is out G1 Irish 1000 Guineas winner Classic Park (GB) (Robellino), Aidan O'Brien's first Classic winner. Bidding for the two-day sale begins at 11 each morning.

SAKHEE BREEDERS' CUP BOUND?

Sakhee (Bahri), winner of Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp, may join stablemate Fantastic Light at Belmont Park and take his chance in the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf Oct. 27. Although owner/breeder Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum is leaning toward the G1 Dubai Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 20, he has not ruled out the American event for the colt's next start. "We will see how he comes out of the race, but all options are open for him," the Sheikh said. "He could go for the Breeders' Cup or the Dubai Champion S." Coral Eurobet will offer odds of 10-11 for Sakhee if he turns up in the Turf. It was also announced yesterday that the four-year-old will remain in training next year.

FANTASTIC LIGHT TO DALHAM HALL IN 2002

Fantastic Light (Rahy--Jood, by Nijinsky II) will retire at the end of the season and head to owner/breeder Sheikh Mohammed's Dalham Hall Stud in Newmarket, England to stand the 2002 breeding season. The five-year-old is scheduled to make his final racetrack appearance in the Oct. 27 G1 Breeders' Cup Classic at Belmont Park. No stud fee has been set for the globe-trotting horse, who will remain the property of his owner upon the conclusion of his racing career. Fantastic Light has accounted for 11 wins from his 24 career starts, with earnings of \$6,374,157 to date. The winner of the Emirates World Series last year, he achieved a career-best success last time when beating Galileo (Ire) by a head in the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown Sept. 8. Previously, he had taken the G1 Prince Of Wales' S. at Royal Ascot June 20 and the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 27. He also won the G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin last December and the G1 Man O'War S. at Belmont Park last September, as well as twice finishing runner-up in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot. Sam Bullard, head of nominations at Darley, said yesterday, "He's an outstanding international champion, great looking and with an excellent pedigree. The speed and tenacity he showed to win his races was a thrill to see. It will be an honour to stand him at Dalham Hall Stud."

MORSHDI RETIRED

A tendon injury has forced an end to the racing career of this year's G1 Derby Italiano winner **Morshdi (GB)** (Slip Anchor {GB}--Reem Albaraari {GB}, by Sadler's Wells {USA}). The dual Group 1, trained by Michael Jarvis, won the Sept. 2 G1 Grosser Preis von Baden in the final start of his career. He finished second behind Galileo (Ire) in the G1 Budweiser Irish Derby in July. Aziz Merza, racing manager to owner Sheikh Ahmed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, told the *Racing Post*: "We are retiring Morshdi to stud as his injury was serious. It can take years to recover and with any return to the track, there is always the possibility of a recurrence. We haven't decided where he will stand but he should prove popular with German breeders." The colt retires with three wins in eight starts and earnings of \$1,143,713.

ARC AUDIENCE UP 30 PERCENT

Channel Four, returning from a seven-year absence, enjoyed a 30-percent increase in audience figures for its coverage of Sunday's Prix de l' Arc de Triomphe. On average, the meeting attracted a million-strong audience with the big race successfully securing 1.7 million, nearly half a million more than the BBC's 2000 Arc coverage. Andrew Franklin, Executive Producer of Channel Four Racing, commented: "We promised to reinvigorate the public's interest in the great event and we are delighted to have honoured that pledge."

HOUSE BILL BENEFITS HORSEMEN The U.S. House of Representatives passed the 2001 Farm Bill, which includes two provisions which will offer economic relief to owners and breeders who have suffered substantial losses among their breeding stock, during Friday's session. The first clause would provide emergency financial aid to horsemen who have been hit by Mare Reproductive Loss Syndrome, while the second would make federal loans available to owners and breeders under the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act. The bill now goes to the Senate. "That two provisions designed to aid horse breeders should be included in this Farm Bill indicates how far the horse racing and breeding industry has come in educating members of Congress about our \$34 billion agribusiness," Greg Avioli, the National Thoroughbred Racing Association's deputy commissioner and chief operating officer, said. "We are particularly grateful to the American Quarter Horse Association for its help in this important area over the past two years."

LEXICON TO MEADOWBROOK FOR 2002 Lexicon (Conquistador Cielo--Felidia, by Golden Fleece) will retire to Barbara and David LaCroix' Meadowbrook of the Ocala Jockey Club near Ocala, Florida at the end of the year. The six-year-old will stand for \$5,000, with term-established shares selling for \$17,500. The six-year-old, winner of the 1999 GII Ancient Title Breeders' Cup H. as well as consecutive runnings of the GIII Bay Meadows Breeders' Cup Sprint H. (2000-01), has won 11 of 36 starts to date for \$820,965 in earnings.

JOHN'S CALL RETIRED John's Call (Lord at War {Arg}--Calling Guest {Ire}, by Be My Guest) has been retired from racing following his third consecutive loss in Sunday's Sycamore S. at Keeneland, reports the *Thoroughbred Times*. Seventh in his career finale, the 10-year-old began his career as a steeplechaser, but made his way up the ranks to win two Grade I races as a nine-year-old--last year's GI Turf Classic Invitational S. at Belmont and Saratoga's GI Sword Dancer Invitational. Pimlico Stable Area Closes for the Winter:

The Maryland Jockey Club, which owns and operates Pimlico and Laurel Park, has decide to close the Pimlico barn area at the end of October. PEDIGREE INSIGHTS

BY ANDREW CAULFIELD

A GRAND PLAN

When it comes to judging a young stallion, it's essential that breeders take into account the quality--and quantity--of mares the stallion has received.

Take the champion British two-year-old Grand Lodge as an example.

When I reviewed his excellent achievements, including Sinndar's defeat of Sakhee in the Epsom Derby, for *Sires for 2001*, I wrote, "Although Grand Lodge has shown he can sire outstanding performers, some of his statistics fall well below what is expected of a world-class stallion. It is worth pointing out, though, that his racing-age progeny were sired at fees of less than IR10,000gns and that breeders showed declining confidence in him until his first yearlings sold so well in '97.

"There were no problems in his first year, when he attracted over 100 mares, but his book dropped to around the 80 mark in his second and third seasons. His third crop of around 55 foals is small by Coolmore standards, and these two-year-olds of 2000 are by no means all out of daughters of classic sires--Bob Back, Salt Dome, Mac's Imp, Runnett, Nomination, Bonne Noel, River Beauty and Treasure Kay all figure among the broodmare sires. The chances are that his career, as a whole, is going to take an upwards turn from his fourth crop onwards."

That final prediction still looks likely to prove accurate. After Grand Lodge's fee rose from IR9,000gns to IR10,000gns in his fourth year, it was increased to IR12,500gns for 1999 and 2000. Then, thanks to the Group 1 successes of Sinndar and Indian Lodge, his fee soared to IR35,000gns.

Consequently, it wouldn't be fair to expect Grand Lodge to show the consistency of a world-class stallion until his foals of 2002 start to race. Even so, his record suggests that he will continue to come up with one or two top performers from his crops sired at comparatively modest fees.

His first Irish crop, numbering 88 foals, contained the Group winners Indian Lodge, Chelsea Manor, Island House and Raise A Grand, while his second, numbering 74, was headed by Sinndar and this year's Group 2 winner Sandmason. As I warned a year ago, his third crop of around 55 foals, has struggled to match its predecessors, but it is a measure of Grand Lodge's potential that it contains the high-class Grandera, who has twice been beaten only half a length in top-notch contests.

Members of Grand Lodge's next two crops hit the headlines exactly a week ago. The afternoon saw Queen's Logic continue her domination of Britain's sprinting two-year-old fillies with a power-packed seven-length victory in the G1 Cheveley Park S. This unbeaten filly, who had earlier taken the G3 Queen Mary S. in June and the G2 Lowther S. in August, no doubt helped considerably when a Grand Lodge colt with the same broodmare sire--Diesis--came on the market at the Houghton Sales a few hours later. Bought for 155,000gns as a weanling, the colt this time sold for 1,000,000gns, roughly 100 times Grand Lodge's 1999 fee.

Grand Lodge sired Queen's Logic and Raise A Grand from mares which failed to win and he sired Chelsea Manor and Island House from unexceptional mares which gained their wins in the French Provinces. Although Indian Lodge, Sinndar and Grandera are out of mares which performed well at stakes level, Sandmason is the only one of Grand Lodge's major performers with a Group winner as its dam. It's tempting to wonder what he will achieve with the high quality mares he covered this year, which include the dams of Sinndar and Queen's Logic.

Queen's Logic represents a particularly fine achievement because her dam, Lagrion, failed to win any of her 14 races at up to 1 9/16 miles in Ireland. Turform rated her as low as 68 at three and only 54 at four.

The idea of sending Queen's Logic's second dam Wrap It Up to Diesis stemmed from the success that Wrap It Up's half-sister Gift Wrapped had enjoyed with Diesis' brother Kris.

Kris's first mating with Gift Wrapped resulted in Reach, winner of the G2 Royal Lodge S. in 1984, and the second produced Wrapping, who failed by only a head to win the G1 Oaks d'Italia over 1 1/2 miles.

Wrapping has since become the dam of Papering, a filly who, like Queen's Logic, was by a stallion from the Danzig male line. The fact that Papering stayed well enough to finish second in two Group 1 races over 1 1/2 miles in 1996 bodes very well for Queen's Logic's prospects next year. It's not often that fillies of her accomplishments over five and six furlongs prove equally effective over a mile, but Queen's Logic appears to have every chance of getting 1 1/4 miles. Let's hope that both she and the similarly talented Gossamer arrive fit and well at the start of next year's 1000 Guineas. It should make a magnificent contest.

The hero of the G1 Japan Cup a year ago, T.M. Opera O won the G1 Tenno Sho this past April, but was making his first start since a runner-up finish in the G1 Takarazuka Kinen June 24. Stay Gold advanced on the far turn and was taking the lead when she bore to the left in upper stretch, causing Narita Top Road (Jpn) (Soccer Boy {Jpn}) to fall. "We were awarded the win, but actually my horse did not perform well today," said winning rider Ryuji Wada. "If nothing had happened, I doubt we were going to catch Stay Gold. He needs to show more next time." That next start could come in the G1 Tenno Sho Oct. 28.
