SAKHEE TO THE CUP

It's official. **Sakhee** (Bahri) will fly out to New York this morning for the Breeders' Cup meeting, it was announced yesterday. Sunday's impressive G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe-Lucien Barriere winner was expected to head to the G1 Dubai Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 20, but owner/breeder Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum has decided his colt will now race at the Breeders' Cup meeting. The Godolphin four-year-old is entered in both the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf and G1 Breeders' Cup Classic; the Classic is the target of stable companion **Fantastic Light** (Rahy); and Godolphin three-year-old **Noverre** (Rahy) has his sights on the G1 Breeders' Cup Mile. A statement from Godolphin yesterday read, "[Sakhee] will be entered in both the Breeders' Cup Turf and the Breeders' Cup Classic, and a final decision as to which race he will run in will be made later. He is to join Godolphin's other Breeders' Cup contenders, Fantastic Light and Noverre, on a flight departing Stansted to New York [Friday] morning. The trio are to be shipped to Belmont Park after touch-down in New York and will spend 24 hours in quarantine. They will then remain in isolation in the Godolphin barn at Belmont Park."

SECRET STATUS RETIRED

Secret Status (A.P. Indy--Private Status, by Alydar), winner of the 2000 G1 Kentucky Oaks and G1 Mother Goose S., has been retired following a sixth-place finish in Sunday's G1 Overbrook Spinster S. at Keeneland, according to *Daily Racing Form*. "We think that maybe she's kind of tailing off," trainer Neil Howard told the Form. "She didn't quite run as well as we thought she would in her last couple of starts, so we're going to call it a day. She's going to be a broodmare now." In addition to her two Grade I wins, Secret Status was second in the G1 Alabama and third in the G1 Coaching Club American Oaks. On the board in 15 outings, she retires with eight wins in 18 starts and earnings of \$1,053,705.

GOFFS CHALLENGE RETURNS Through Lot 687, it was a colt by Definite Article (GB) out of Mummy's Best (Ire) (Bustino {GB}) who topped yesterday's Goffs Challenge Sale at the Kildare Paddocks in Ireland. The bay, a half brother to Listed stakes winner Rush Brook (Ire), was consigned by Lynn Lodge Stud and purchased for Ir£130,000 by Epsom trainer Terry Mills. There was plenty to like about the colt, whose sire had a Classic winner this season in G1 Irish St Leger hero Vinnie Roe (Ire). "He is a nice colt," Mills said. "I was going to buy him for myself, but Richard Salter came up to me and asked me for a half share." *Complete results of the Goffs Challenge Sale in tomorrow's TDN.*

MARE IN FOAL TO SILVER CHARM TOPS OBS WEDNESDAY Herbs and Spices (Relaunch--Prize Spot, by Little Current), a 19-year-old broodmare in foal to 1997 Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner and 1998 Dubai World Cup hero Silver Charm (Silver Buck), brought a final bid of \$39,000 to top Wednesday's session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's Fall Mixed Sale. The bay, consigned by Glen Hill Farm, agent, and purchased by Gregerson Enterprises, is a daughter of Grade I winner Prize Spot and is herself the dam of stakes winner and multiple graded stakes-placed Effectiveness, a winner of \$504,971. The top-selling weanling at the session was a colt from the first crop of GI Met Mile winner Wild Rush (Wild Again) out of multiple stakes-winner Perfect Night (Taylor's Falls). Consigned by Adena Springs South, the bay was purchased by Ten Stable for \$21,000. The Fall Mixed Sale concluded yesterday with the second of two open sessions.

SPONGES FORCE SANTA ANITA SCRATCHES
Two fillies entered in last Wednesday's second race were scratched after sponges were found in their nasal passages, according to today's *Daily Racing Form*. The Ed Moger, Jr.-trained Spiderette, morning-line favorite in Wednesday's second race, and the Frank Olivares-trained My Sweet Lucy, entered in the same race, were both forced to scratch. Spiderette reportedly was scoped after a sponge was found in another Moger-trained filly who is similar in appearance and who had worked poorly on Tuesday. The California Horse Racing Board is investigating. "Right now we're in the process of investigating the whole issue," CHRB assistant executive director Roy Minami told the *Form*. The board will also send a warning to all trainers, "to increase their vigilance."

Dream Run put in a strong run when fourth to Monarchos in the GI Florida Derby and finished third in the GII Illinois Derby Apr. 7, but was sidelined following a second in the GIII Derby Trial Apr. 28 at Churchill. The bay colt returned Sept. 2 at Arlington to run second in an allowance and rallied nicely for third in Turfway's GII Kentucky Cup Sprint behind Snow Ridge and City Zip Sept. 22. Sent off as the second choice to 3-5 Hero's Tribute (Sea Hero), he broke well and forced the pace from the outside. He took command after a half in :45 2/5 and pulled away down the lane for his first stakes victory. "I went into this race with a lot of confidence, since he came out of that race at Turfway so well," said winning trainer Paul McGee. "He broke so sharp, I think Pat [jockey Day] did the right thing letting him be out there with the frontrunners. He had a good look all the way around there." McGee indicated that the Ack Ack S. at Churchill Oct. 28 was the next step for Dream Run.
