## UP TO THE CHALLENGE

A field of 10 fillies will take to the track for today's GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland, including two that already have Grade I victories to their credit. **Golden Apples (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}), good enough to finish third in the June 30 G2 Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh in her European finale, was overlooked at 21-1 in her American debut, but she didn't let that stop her. The bay closed to win the Aug. 18 GI Del Mar Oaks, with fellow Challenge candidates **Affluent** (Affirmed) and **Reine de Romance (Ire)** (Vettori {Ire}) behind her in second and third. Back at the Del Mar Oaks distance of a mile and an eighth here, she makes her second stateside appearance. **Voodoo Dancer** (Kingmambo), fourth at Del Mar, became a member of elite equine society with a handy 4 3/4-length score in the nine-furlong GI Garden City Breeders' Cup H. at Belmont Park Sept. 9. The bay has won six of her eight turf starts and draws jockey Corey Nakatani from California for this race. Nakatani was aboard the Christophe Clement-trained three-year-old at Belmont and also when she won the Flawlessly H. at Hollywood Park in May. **Snow Dance** (Forest Wildcat) puts her perfect turf record on the line in her first attempt at the Grade I level. Off at 9-1, the gray took the Aug. 20 GII Lake Placid H. at Saratoga two starts back. She was bet down to 9-10 for her latest effort, the Sept. 15 GIII Pucker Up S. at Arlington, and made it four straight on the grass with a 1 3/4-length tally.

## ALBERT THE GREAT TO THREE CHIMNEYS

**Albert The Great** (Go for Gin--Bright Feather, by Fappiano), a five-time graded-stakes winner of \$2,532,490, will retire to Three Chimneys Farm in Lexington, Kentucky at the end of the season. The four-year-old won the GII Dwyer S. and GI Jockey Club Gold Cup and was second in the GI Travers S. last season. This year, he has accounted for the GII Suburban H., GII Brooklyn H. and GIII Widener H., where he set a Hialeah track record of 1:45 2/5 for the mile and an eighth. "The Breeders' Cup Classic will be his final start of the year before retiring to stud," owner Tracy Farmer said, adding, "We've been blessed by an incredibly sound and game horse. This year alone, in eight starts, he has been first or second in seven graded stakes and set a track record. He's danced every dance on the East Coast since February." Added Three Chimneys owner Robert Clay, "We are so pleased to have Albert the Great 'come home,' as it were. He was bred and raised in Mt. Sterling, Three Chimneys sold him as a yearling and Tracy was great to name him for my father." Farmer will retain 100 percent ownership in his colt. A stud fee will be announced at a later date.

## APTITUDE HEADED TO JUDDMONTE

Prince Khalid Abdullah's homebred **Aptitude** (A.P. Indy--Dokki, by Northern Dancer) will retire to his owner's Juddmonte Farms in Lexington, Kentucky at the conclusion of his racing career. The four-year-old, runner-up in both the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness last year, started 2001 with a sixth-place finish in the G1 Dubai World Cup. He picked up his first stakes win via a stewards' disqualification in the July 1 GI Hollywood Gold Cup, then came back to take the GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup Aug. 19. The dark bay posted his most impressive victory to date with his 10-length romp in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup Oct. 6. In 13 starts, Aptitude has four wins, four seconds and two thirds for earnings of \$1,965,410. He will make his next start in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Belmont Park Oct. 27. A stud fee has not yet been set.

## NUMBERS DOWN AT GOFFS CHALLENGE

**SALE** The Goffs Challenge Sale concluded Thursday evening with figures which were significantly lower than the records achieved last year, but were more in line with the 1999 statistics. In 2001, 227 yearlings grossed Ir£3,614,700, just Ir£300 less than 1999 when 223 yearlings sold, but 30 percent down from the 2000 sale. The median for this year's sale was Ir£10,500, compared to Ir£16,000 last year and Ir£12,000 in 1999. Top-priced lot was a Definite Article colt (GB) purchased by Terry Mills for Ir£130,000. Purchased for Ir£20,000 as a foal last November at Goffs, he made a significant return for consignor Lynn Lodge Stud. Trainer Dermot Weld went to Ir£105,000 to secure a colt by Mukaddamah (USA) who is the first foal out of stakes-placed winner Stop Out (GB) (Rudimentary {USA}). Weld said of his purchase, "He is a lovely sharp colt, ideal for the [sale] race and I have bought him for a client in the stable."

**CHAMPIONS' DAY A WEEK AWAY** Newmarket racecourse yesterday started the countdown to Champions' Day next Saturday. While **Sakhee (USA)** (Bahri {USA}) will miss the G1 Dubai Champion S. and heads to Belmont Park the following weekend, Godolphin may decide to let **Equerry (USA)** (St. Jovite {USA}) take his chance in the feature 10-furlong event. That unbeaten colt was an impressive winner of the G3 Prix du Prince d'Orange at Longchamp Sept. 23 last time. He may have Aidan O'Brien's **Beckett (Ire)** (Fairy King {USA}) and Marcus Tregoning's **Nayef (USA)** (Gulch {USA}) to contend with on Saturday, although a late decision is expected on that colt's participation. David Loder will saddle **Dubai Destination (USA)** (Kingmambo {USA}), the current 5-1 ante-post favourite for next year's G1 2000 Guineas with William Hill, in the G1 Darley Dewhurst S. on the same card. "We have the two Group 1 races plus two Group 2s and a Group 3, not to mention one of the most prestigious handicaps of the season, the Tote Cesarewitch," Lisa Hancock, Newmarket's managing director, said yesterday. "While Sakhee's absence from the Dubai Champion S. will rob us of one superstar, it should make for a much more competitive race and there are still plenty of high-class candidates with the likes of Nayef, Equerry and Beckett likely to run. And there will be plenty of other potential superstars competing elsewhere on the card, notably Dubai Destination taking on one of Aidan O'Brien's big guns in Europe's premier two-year-old race, the Darley Dewhurst S."

**PUT IT BACK TO BRIDLEWOOD FARM** Three-year-old **Put It Back** (Honour and Glory--Miss Shoplifter, by Exuberant) has been retired and will stand the 2002 breeding season at Arthur Appleton's Bridlewood Farm in Ocala, Florida. Undefeated in five starts this season, the Florida-bred colt started the year with a 7 1/4-length win in Aqueduct maiden company and ended it with a neck victory over Flame Thrower in the June 9 GII Riva Ridge S. on the Belmont S. undercard. The dark bay was diagnosed with a stress fracture to his left front cannon bone after a three-furlong workout at Saratoga at the end of July. He goes to stud with a record of five wins, a second and a third from seven starts and earnings of \$232,895. Put It Back will stand for a fee of \$5,000 live foal.

**RICK WILSON INJURED AT PIMLICO** Jockey Rick Wilson broke his left leg and several ribs in a spill during the fourth race at Pimlico yesterday afternoon, according to *The Blood-Horse* on-line. The 48-year-old reinsman was leading the way on 7-5 favorite Home Verse when the filly broke down at the top of the stretch. Wilson was thrown and one of the trailing horses, Rangeley Skier, was unable to avoid the fallen jockey. The Oklahoma native was taken to the University of Maryland Shock Trauma hospital in Baltimore, where it was reported he had broken his left femur and several ribs on his left side. **NUMBERS OFF AT OBS FALL** The Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's 2001 Fall Mixed Sale concluded Thursday with decreases in gross, average and median. The only figure that showed improvement was the buyback rate, which dropped by about 2 percent for this year's sale. During the two consignor-preferred sessions which started the four-day auction, the average dropped to \$11,013, off 36.8 percent from last year's three consignor-preferred sessions, while the median was \$7,000, down 36.3 percent. **BRIT DEFAULTS ON \$3.345 MILLION IN YEARLING PURCHASES**

According to published reports, British businessman Robert Killoran is facing legal action after failing to pay for the \$3.345 million in yearlings he purchased during this year's Keeneland July Sale and Fasig-Tipton Kentucky July Sale. Irish bloodstock agent Paul Collins signed the tickets for the purchases. Keeneland has already filed suit against Killoran, seeking payment for two yearlings, colts by Kingmambo and Gone West, which brought \$700,000 apiece at their July Sale. The two were sent through the ring at last week's Goffs Orby Sale in Ireland, with the Kingmambo bringing Ir£420,000 and the Gone West selling for Ir£150,000 (a total of approximately \$650,000). Killoran also bought eight lots worth a total of \$1.945 million at the Fasig-Tipton sale. The eight were repossessed and several have already been sold privately. The sales company has not yet filed suit, but has retained legal counsel in England and expects to sue in the future.
