The bay returned to action with a seventh in an off-the-turf contest at the Meadowlands Sept. 25, but was favored beneath visiting rider Eddie Delahoussaye. Rated along the inside early, he shifted out four deep for the backstretch, but angled back towards the rail on the turn. The homebred was shifted back out five wide at the sixteenth pole and outfinished Silver Spear and Wudantunoit for the win. Morning-line favorite Baptize (Dynaformer) was an early scratch.

She stalked Bold World (Fortunate Prospect) early, challenged at the top of the stretch and drew off down the lane for a clear victory. "We thought she might have something bothering her after she didn't run that well in her last two races, particularly the last," said winning trainer Bill White. "We decided to take some tests and found she had a significant lung infection."
