A LONGSHOT AT LONGCHAMP

Mount Abu (Ire) (Foxhound) was let go at 16-1, but made a mockery of those odds to account for 9-5 favourite **China Visit** (Red Ransom) in the G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp yesterday. The four-year-old was being eased down near the finish, striding past the game runner-up before powering away to a two-length success. Mount Abu has been a solid performer over a variety of ground and trips, but he is undeniably best over this seven furlongs in testing conditions. Campaigned almost exclusively in sprints this year, he had put in some fine efforts, including a second-place finish behind Nuclear Debate in the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup Sept. 8. The bay was sixth in the Sept. 29 G2 Diadem S., but trainer John Gosden explained, "Last time at Ascot we thought he'd win...but he did not extend his action. We discovered he had a bruise on his foot." Here he raced in third early China Visit led. Always travelling well in the very soft conditions, he took command with quarter of a mile remaining and was pushed out for the decisive success. Mount Abu will be pointed for the G1 Hong Kong Mile Dec. 16.

RECORD SET AT PEARLS OF DUBAI SALE

The 2001 Pearls of Dubai International Sale, held Saturday at the Dubai World Cup Quarantine Centre at Nad Al Sheba, set United Arab Emirates records for both aggregate and average. A total of 53 Northern Hemisphere-bred two-year-olds and Southern Hemisphere-bred three-year-olds brought an aggregate of Dhs15,530,000 for an average of Dhs293,018, compared to the 2000 gross of Dhs10.5 million. The sales topper was the American-bred **Next Knight** (Royal Academy--Zitkala, by Lady Dom Alaric), which, after spirited bidding, was purchased for Dhs2,000,000 by trainer Satish Seemar. The colt, the first foal out of stakes-winning mare, will race in the colours of Sheikh Rashid bin Mohammed Al Maktoum. "He was a good, clean-looking horse, in my opinion the pick of the catalogue," Seemar said. "Though he wasn't asked to do a great deal at the breeze-up, I thought he showed great potential." Seemar also picked up the day's second-highest priced lot, going to Dhs1,400,000 for American-bred **Dr Quackenbush** (Deposit Ticket--Laughing Ruler, by Iron Ruler). The bay filly has started once, beating \$50,000 maiden claimers at Belmont Park July 6. She was purchased on behalf of Sultan Ali Al Subusi. "This year's Pearls of Dubai Sale was an outstanding success, the figures have improved from last year's excellent results and should improve again in seasons to come as racing here in the United Arab Emirates grows from strength to strength," Les Benton, chief executive of the Emirates Racing Association, said. Graduates of the sale are eligible to run in the Pearls of Dubai International Sales Graduate S., to be run at Nad Al Sheba Mar. 2, 2002.

WATERHOUSE BACK ON TRACK?

The New South Wales Thoroughbred Racing Board (TRB) is expected to approve an application by Bill Waterhouse, 79, to have conditions preventing him from applying for a bookmaker's licence removed at its monthly meeting on Monday. Waterhouse, banned in 1984 because of his involvement in a the Fine Cotton (Aus)/ Bold Personality (Aus) ringer scandal, saw the ban lifted in 1998 with conditions imposed. The leviathan bookmaker did not return to the racetrack until his son, Rob, took to the stand again in August, making a highly successful comeback after 17 years away from the ring. Rob Waterhouse said that, if his father returned to the stand, "It would be like old times again and wipe the slate clean."

CLONMEL TO MELBOURNE CUP

Gai Waterhouse has named **Clonmel (Aus)** (Thunder Gulch {USA}), a late scratch from yesterday's G2 Winning Edge Presentation S. at Caulfield, as the horse to give her an elusive Melbourne Cup victory. Clonmel made only six starts as a juvenile and had not been out since his two-year-old season when weights were issued for the Nov. 6 G1 Melbourne Cup. He received just 50.5kg and is currently at 50-1. The Gooree-owned gelding had a year off due to a respiratory problem before returning to win first-up in Sydney Oct. 1. "He was forced to miss a year. but that may prove a blessing in disguise," Waterhouse said. "He's developed in to a tough, strong gelding and he is now sound as a bell."

Shooting Party took up her customary position on the front end as jockey Jose Santos kept Love n' Kiss S. within easy striking distance along the inside. Angled out into the stretch, she responded to poke a head in front at the eighth pole and dug in gamely to hold off a late run from Calista. "This filly has been working great," Santos commented. "We had a great trip off the pace. She's a real nice horse and I think she's got room to improve." Winning trainer Christophe Clement said the filly could make her next start in the GII Mrs. Revere S. at Churchill Downs Nov. 17.

MACHO IN, BULLET OUT

Stronach Stables' reigning two-year-old champion **Macho Uno** (Holy Bull) breezed three furlongs over the Belmont training track yesterday morning in :37 4/5 and is slated to make his next start in the \$4 million Classic. The half brother to 1998 Classic hero Awesome Again was most recently third at 1-5 in the GII Ohio Derby Sept. 29, but trainer Joe Orseno is willing to forgive that effort. "I think (the sub-par effort) was a combination of things," he explained. "I usually like to ship my horses in about three or four days early, let them settle in and get used to the track. I wasn't able to do that." The colt suffered a bout with colic in the week prior to the Ohio Derby and shipped to Thistledown just one day before the race. Orseno also indicated that 2000 GI Preakness S. winner **Red Bullet** (Unbridled) will pass the Classic and instead train up to the GI Cigar Mile at Aqueduct Nov. 24. The latter drilled five furlongs in a bullet :59 at Belmont Saturday morning.

TEAM FRANKEL GEARING UP

Trainer Bobby Frankel will start seven horses in the Breeders' Cup races, two of which were out on the track for workouts yesterday. **Timboroa** (GB) (Salse), the winner of his last two starts, including a mild upset in the GI Turf Classic at Belmont Sept. 29, worked an easy half mile over the inner turf in :50 1/5, while GI King's Bishop S. victor **Squirtle Squirt** (Marquetry) zipped four furlongs over the main track in a best-of-33 :46 4/5. "All my Breeders' Cup horses are doing great," Frankel commented. "If everything falls into place, I have a chance." Frankel is winless in the Breeders' Cup.

BALTO STAR TO MILE

Anstu Stable's GII Arkansas Derby winner **Balto Star** (Glitterman) will make his next start in the Mile, trainer Todd Pletcher said yesterday. The three-year-old gelding, most recently second to Guided Tour (Hansel) in the GII Kentucky Cup Classic Sept. 22, took his only turf start to date at Saratoga Sept. 2. The bay worked five furlongs on the turf yesterday in 1:03.

CLEMENT HAS 1-2 PUNCH FOR F/M TURF

Trainer Christophe Clement, who finished second in the inaugural Filly & Mare Turf with Coretta (Ire), has two bullets for this year's renewal in the form of GI Beverly D. winner **England's Legend (Fr)** (Lure) and GI E.P. Taylor runner-up finisher **Volga (Ire)** (Caerleon). A good second to Lailani (GB) in the Sept. 29 GI Flower Bowl at Belmont, England's Legend breezed a half mile on the turf in :49 3/5. "She worked on the bridle all the way," Clement said. "She has a tendency to overwork, but I think she did great today." Volga will be making her debut for Clement in the Filly & Mare Turf, having previously been managed by trainer Andre Fabre. The winner earlier this year of the G3 Prix de Royaumont at Saint-Cloud, she clocked her four panels in :50 2/5.

MILAN SET FOR TURF?

Milan (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), winner of the G1 St. Leger at Doncaster Sept. 15, could travel to Belmont Park for the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Oct. 27, it was announced yesterday. Aidan O'Brien has unveiled his plans, stating that the colt, who was fifth last time in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 7, would be the seventh member of the team to be flown out from Ballydoyle. Both **Galileo (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and **Black Minnaloushe** (Storm Cat) are set to tackle the Classic, **Mozart (Ire)** (Danehill) will run in the Sprint, **Johannesburg** (Hennessy) goes for the Juvenile, **Sophisticat** (Storm Cat) is pointing for the Juvenile Fillies and **Bach (Ire)** (Caerleon) heads for the Mile. O'Brien said yesterday, "Milan's a possible for the Turf now. Though he's by Sadler's Wells, he needs good ground and he didn't get it in France. He's a big, strong horse and I think he came out of it well. Michael [Kinane] thought he was second-best on the day [in the Arc]. He should have stayed on the inner and not switched wide."

IN OTHER CUP WORKS...

City Zip (Carson City) breezed five furlongs over the Belmont turf course in 1:00 3/5, out seven-eighths in 1:24 4/5 and is reported likely for the Mile, according to trainer Linda Rice, who was very pleased with the work. "He galloped out well and looked more comfortable on the turf than he did going into the Kelso," the conditioner said. "I hope the turf is firmer than it was in the Kelso, but you never know at this time of year." The three-year-old, third in the GI Kelso in what was his turf debut, will be retired at the end of the season, Rice said. "The idea is to get him to the breeding shed while he is still fresh in everyone's mind."

Michael Tabor's **Left Bank** (French Deputy, Sprint), winner in his most recent start of the GI Vosburgh S. Sept. 22, worked five furlongs over the Belmont main track in 1:01 2/5 with jockey John Velazquez in the irons.

TASMANIAN TIGER THIRD IN DEBUT The most expensive yearling of 2000, **Tasmanian Tiger** (Storm Cat), was sent off the 5-4 favorite in his racecourse debut at The Curragh yesterday, but failed to handle the heavy going and finished third, beaten 5 1/2 lengths by winner **Solid Approach (Ire)** (Definite Article {GB}). A \$6.8 million Keeneland September purchase, the two-year-old went to the lead at the break, but was headed before halfway. He made a bid 1 1/2 furlongs from home, but came up empty in the final drive. "We took out Tasmanian Tiger here last week because of the ground and we probably should not have run him today either," trainer Aidan O'Brien told *PA Sport*. "[Jockey Michael Kinane] said he knew he wouldn't win on his way down to the start because the ground was so heavy. So he just nursed the horse and at least we gave him a run this season to educate him."
