## HEADLINE NEWS

### IRISH RIVER PENSIONED

Gainesway stallion **Irish River** (Riverman--Irish Star {Fr}, by \*Klairon), the sire of four champions, has been pensioned. The 25-year-old stallion has sired 83 stakes winners, of which 40 are individual group or graded stakes winners. "Irish River is the best son of the great sire Riverman," said Michael Hernon of Gainesway. "He has always been one of the best-looking horses on the farm and his retirement is based purely on his declining fertility." France's champion two-year-old of 1978, Irish River won the 1979 French 2000 Guineas and was named champion miler. He sired champions Paradise Creek, Hatoof, Brief Truce and Orban, as well as Grade I winners River Bay, Mashkour, Navarone, Leariva, Exit to Nowhere and Irish Prize. Irish River will live out his retirement at Gainesway in Lexington, Kentucky.

### COOLMORE ADDS THREE MORE STALLIONS

In addition to **Galileo (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and **Mozart (Ire)** (Daneshill), Coolmore yesterday announced the addition of three new stallions to their team for 2002. **Golan (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}--Highland Gift {Ire}, by Generous {Ire}), the winner of the G1 English 2000 Guineas this year and second to Galileo (Ire) in the G1 Epsom Derby, is set to take up a position next to his sire next season. He went on to take the G2 Prix Niel at Longchamp prior to running a good fourth in the G1 Arc de Triomphe. **King Charlemagne** (Nureyev--Race the Wild Wind, by Sunny's Halo) has not lost in five starts since finishing second in his career bow last August. He recorded his most important victory to date when annexing the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville Aug. 12. Four-year-old **Mull of Kintyre** (Danzig--Retrospective, by Easy Goer), a \$1 million Keeneland September yearling, had his most successful season as a juvenile when he won two of four starts, including the G2 Gimcrack S. Unraced at three, his best effort this year came when second to King Charlemagne in the G3 Minstrel S. Stud fees will be announced at a later date.

### "A MIND OF HIS OWN"

Reigning horse of the year and defending Breeders' Cup Classic champion **Tiznow** (Cee's Tizzy) recorded a brilliant one-mile workout yesterday morning at Santa Anita in 1:35 3/5, working from the half-mile pole back around to half-mile pole. That's the good news. The "bad" news is that the four-year-old took his time getting down to business, lingering at various points on the racetrack. He initially refused to break into a gallop for jockey Chris McCarron while standing near the five-eighths pole, but began to jog after five minutes. "I thought, 'Beautiful, I'm going to get him to work seven (furlongs) from the seven-eighths pole,'" McCarron explained. "But then he got in front of the stands and it was like, 'I haven't had enough (standing around) yet.'" Part owner Michael Cooper remains at a loss to explain Tiznow's actions. "He's got a mind of his own these days," he said, but nonetheless remains optimistic going into next weekend. "We're right where we wanted to be," Cooper continued. "He's got a solid work under him; now I just hope he ships good." The Cal-bred is scheduled to fly out to New York tomorrow.

### CAME HOME LOOKING GOOD

John Toffan and Trudy McCaffery's **Came Home** (Gone West), the probable second choice in the Juvenile, continues to train strongly on the West Coast, drilling six furlongs in a bullet 1:12 3/5 at Santa Anita Wednesday morning. The winner two back of the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship, he shipped east to add the GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga Sept. 1. The dark bay is unraced since that effort, having suffered a wrenched ankle while training for the GII Norfolk S. Sept. 29.

## EXTRA DAY AT ROYAL ASCOT 2002

Next year's meeting at Royal Ascot will run over five days to mark the Queen's Golden Jubilee, it was announced yesterday. Saturday's extra card will feature the Wokingham H., G2 King Edward VII S. and G2 Cork and Orrery S., which will be renamed the Golden Jubilee S. next year. The extra day ends, as per tradition, with the Queen Alexandra S. Three races previously run on Saturday's "heath" card have been boosted in value and are moved to cards earlier in the week. With total prize money of over £3 million, up from £2.58 million this year, the meeting will receive an unprecedented boost. Ascot's chief executive Douglas Erskine-Crum said yesterday, "We are extremely proud and honoured that The Queen has given her consent to celebrating her Golden Jubilee with a fifth day of the Royal Meeting next year. Extending the meeting to five days into the weekend will give a large number of people who may not normally be able to attend during the week an opportunity to experience this unique Royal race meeting. As the centrepiece of our Golden jubilee celebrations, Royal Ascot Saturday will be particularly special and we hope that the racegoing public and the local community will join us in celebrating the occasion. As none of the 30 races run at Royal Ascot 2002 will be sponsored, Ascot racecourse would like to extend a special thanks to the regular Heath-day sponsors for their understanding and support of this unique Golden Jubilee celebration."

### SPEED SIDESTEPS CHAMPION

**Tough Speed (USA)** (Miswaki {USA}) was yesterday ruled out of tomorrow's G1 Dubai Champion S., leaving a field of 13 to face the starter. Instead of the 10-furlong contest, Sir Michael Stoute's four-year-old will head to the seven-furlong G2 Victor Chandler Challenge S. on the same card. Joe Mercer, racing manager to owner Saeed Suhail, told *PA Sport* yesterday: "We've had a heavy shower in Newmarket this morning and it's just going to be on the easy side. I was with Michael and Saeed Suhail this morning and we thought it was better to go for the Challenge if the ground was on the easy side rather than go against a mile and a quarter in the Champion."

Making a belated reappearance in 2001 when third behind Moselle (GB) in the Listed Virginia S. at Newcastle Aug. 27, she was beaten only four lengths by the smart Albarahin (USA) in the Listed Doonside Cup at Ayr Sept. 22. Disappointing last time when 11th in the one-mile G2 Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket Oct. 6, she bounced back here over the 10 furlongs of the Rowley Mile. She was held up towards the rear early as first Illumination (GB) (Saddler's Hall {Ire}) and then Riberac (GB) (Efisio {GB}) led them along, she was brought wide and late with her challenge as Riberac turned on the pressure from the front. Taking the lead with 100 yards remaining, she drifted left as Riberac and Villa Carlotta and Pat Eddery battled away, asserting in the closing stages to hold the runner-up and fast-finishing Goncharova and Frankie Dettori. Despite the winner drifting off a true line, the result was judged not to be affected. However, winning jockey Jimmy Fortune was handed a two-day ban from Oct. 29-30 for careless riding.

### CAULFIELD GETS UPGRADE

The Victorian Amateur Turf Club unveiled a \$20-million strategy to upgrade Caulfield. The plan involves slashing the number of meetings held at the track from 31 to 20 and focusing only on feature programs. The club's second track, Sandown, will have another course built to handle extra meetings; 43 are scheduled there for next season. "By reducing the number of race meetings at Caulfield we will be able to ensure that nearly 80 percent of meetings are conducted with the rail in the true position," explained VATC chairman Kevin Hayes. The club will also undergo a name change, back to its original Melbourne Racing Club. The club's new strategy has critics who point to the 10-year-old \$50 million glassed-in grandstand which is unpopular with fans.

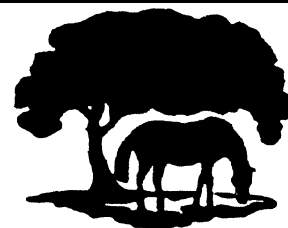

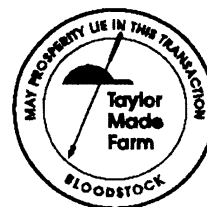

A daughter of super sire Danehill brought a sale-record 475,000gns to top yesterday's flagship middle session of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sales in Newmarket, England. Coolmore supremo John Magnier, using the services of agent Charlie Gordon-Watson, is the bay's new owner while Godolphin agent John Ferguson was the underbidder. The yearling, out of Mythical Creek (Pleasant Tap), was offered by her breeder, Roy and Belinda Strudwick's Ballygallon Stud in Co. Kilkenny. "I buy one or two each year for John Magnier and she was one of them," said Gordon-Watson. "I'd imagine she'll go to Ballydoyle and she looked a very athletic racy filly." A Darshaan (GB) colt who realized 450,000gns on the sale's third day a year ago, held the previous Tattersalls October record. Grand Lodge enjoyed a phenomenal day, headed by the sale of his pinhooked colt out of Wolf Cleugh (Ire) (Last Tycoon {Ire}) for 440,000gns to Ferguson, with Demi O'Byrne underbidder this time. The colt was offered from Eddie O'Leary's Lynn Lodge Stud and cost Ir£65,000 at Goffs as a foal. Sir Stephen Hastings' Milton Park Stud landed a notable touch with an 'in utero' purchase from Tattersalls' 1999 December Mare Sales when the Darshaan (GB) colt bought inside 1995 Lupe S. winner Subya (GB) (Night Shift) for 76,000gns was sold to Sheikh Hamdan Al Maktoum's Shadwell Estates for 270,000gns. The sale, which runs through Saturday, resumes today at 9:15 a.m.

**STALLIONS, MARES BRED DECREASE IN 2001**

The number of stallions and the number of mares bred during 2001 were both down from the previous year, according to statistics released yesterday by The Jockey Club. As of Oct. 12, The Jockey Club reports that 3,457 stallions covered 58,298 mares in 2001, which represented declines of 6.1 and 2.5 percent respectively. The number of mares bred dropped for the first time since 1995. "Although stallion book size continues to increase," said Jockey Club Vice President of Registration Services Matt Iuliano, "the fact that fewer mares were bred coupled with the impact of Mare Reproductive Loss Syndrome in Kentucky will weigh significantly on next year's foal crop, which we cautiously projected at 35,600 back in August." Among sires, Thunder Gulch led with 216 mares bred.
