UNBRIDLED DIES

Claiborne Farm's leading sire **Unbridled** (Fappiano--Gana Facil, by *Le Fabuleux), who underwent two abdominal surgeries in late September, was euthanized Thursday evening after suffering a severe attack of colic. The 14-year-old stallion had been taken to Hagyard-Davidson-McGee veterinary clinic on Sept. 21 after exhibiting signs of colic; a tumor-like mass in his abdomen necessitated the removal of over three feet of his large colon. Though the mass was non-malignant, Unbridled was back in the operating room on Sept. 27 after developing peritonitis. He came through that surgery in good order and returned to Claiborne on Oct. 8, but suffered a colic attack Thursday afternoon. Unbridled was taken once again to Hagyard-Davidson-McGee, where he was euthanized after it was determined that his condition was inoperable. "In the second phase, after he got well, we were concerned if adhesions would get him...and they did," Dr. Doug Byars told *The Blood-Horse*. "They were inside his abdomen and had entrapped or strangulated his small intestines. The adhesions are like cobwebs. It's a huge problem in human and veterinary medicine. His was a cluster that was inoperable and that was confirmed at post-mortem." Unbridled will be buried in his entirety at Claiborne Farm's Marchmont Cemetery. "It was a drawn-out ordeal," Byars added. "As I would put it, and it's not just me that felt this way about him, this horse was the most extraordinary, patient horse I've ever been around. "His survival would be to his credit that he lasted this long. He put in more than his share of effort. He was just an amazing horse." Unbridled captured the GI Kentucky Derby, GI Florida Derby and GI Breeders' Cup Classic during his Eclipse Award-winning three-year-old campaign of 1990, and retired with earnings of \$4,489,475. From seven crops of racing age, he has sired 24 stakes winners, including champions Anees and Banshee Breeze, as well as Grade I winners Exogenous, Grindstone, Manistique, Red Bullet, Unbridled's Song and Unshaded. "He was a great stallion and a good horse, the kind you are in this business for," Claiborne spokesperson Dell Hancock told *Thoroughbred Times*. "He will be sorely missed. It's a bad day for the game because he was a horse that could sire a horse that could go a distance and there aren't many of them around right now."

CHAMPION IN THE MAKING?

In a race where proven Group 1 form is almost a must, surprisingly few of the aspirants in today's renewal of the G1 Dubai Champion S. at Newmarket boast such credentials. Instead it appears a wide-open affair, with **Nayef** (Gulch) installed as favourite. That colt has maintained a steady level of form throughout his well-documented career and is arguably in the form of his life. Having destroyed the opposition in last year's Listed October S. at Ascot in October on heavy ground, he was made the short-priced ante-post favourite to emulate his half-brother Nashwan and go on to Classic glory in the 2000 Guineas and the Epsom Derby. He only made the gig in the 2000 Guineas, however, finishing eighth before getting a short vacation. The three-year-old returned to be third to Alexius (Ire) in the G3 Gordon S. at Goodwood July 31, then rattled off three straight successes in the G3 Rose of Lancaster S. Aug. 11, G3 Select S. Sept. 12 and G3 Cumberland Lodge S. Sept. 30. The wheels are certainly back on, but he faces his stiffest task so far and has to answer the questions with this gun at his head. Aidan O'Brien is represented by both **Hawkeye (Ire)** (Danehill) and **Beckett (Ire)** (Fairy King) here. The latter is coming around at the right time. As one of only three Group 1 winners in the field, having taken the G1 National S. at The Curragh last September, he warrants respect and looks as if this step up in trip will suit him. Last time he was the all-the-way winner of the Listed Joel S. here Oct. 4 over a mile.

KARASTA RETIRED Three-year-old filly **Karasta (Ire)** (Lake Coniston {Ire}--Karliyka {Ire}, by Last Tycoon {Ire}), who captured the G3 May Hill S. last season at two, has been retired, the *Racing Post* reports. After winning her first two starts, the HH Aga Khan's homebred finished second in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac to end her juvenile campaign, but she could not duplicate that form this year, running off the board in both the G1 Sagitta 1000 Guineas and G1 Entenmann's Irish 1000 Guineas. The filly made her final start in the G3 Jersey S. at Royal Ascot, finishing 14th. "She was such a huge two-year-old and, at the time, we thought anything else she did would be a bonus. We were really looking forward to running her at three...it was disappointing she didn't go on, as physically she looked the sort to do better in time." Karasta goes to the breeding shed with two wins and a second from her six career starts for earnings of £28,875. Mating plans have not yet been decided.

Danehurst produced an incredible turn of foot to take this competitive sprint. Impressive on soft ground when winning last year's G3 Cornwallis S. at Newbury in October, she returned this year with much expectation on her shoulders. Ninth in the G2 King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot June 19 on her return, she did not build on that when 11th in the Listed Richard H Faught Memorial S. at The Curragh July 1, but showed brilliant acceleration to win the Listed City Wall S. at Chester 13 days later. Given a break before heading to the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp Oct. 7, she disappointed there, failing to finish in the heavy ground. Here she was held up in last place early in the centre of the track by Seb Sanders as **Tamarisk (Ire)** (**Green Desert (USA)**) cut out the running on the far side rail. Sanders looked for the split approaching the final furlong and it arrived between **Sartorial (Ire)** (**Elbio (GB)**) and **Orienter**. Seizing his chance, Sanders asked his mount to quicken and she did so instantly, bursting through the gap to lead with 100 yards remaining and putting the race beyond doubt in a matter of strides. Sir Mark Prescott commented, "It was very disappointing in the Abbaye, and she was badly drawn today and trying six for the first time. We had to do everything the opposite way and hope that it worked--and you won't see a finer ridden race. The plan was to try and follow something like **Sartorial** and he executed it brilliantly. I've always said to the breeders, Mr and Mrs Thompson, that she was the fastest filly I've ever trained. I think Mrs Thompson would like me to train her for the first part of next season at least."

Right Wing wrote another chapter in his ongoing story with another charismatic display. Pat Eddery gets on particularly well with the seven-year-old, understanding his eccentricities and riding him to his maximum capacity as a result. This was a typical display from the old-timer, being covered up behind the pack before pouncing late with a decisive turn of foot. Eddery explained, "He's a great old character and a lovely horse to ride--you've got to cover him up and he's got a real good turn-of-foot at the end. He's actually better if he gets in a bit of trouble." He's also a horse with a touch of class, having twice beaten the smart Albarahin (USA), in the Listed Doncaster Mile Mar. 22 and G3 Earl of Sefton S. at this track Apr. 18. He was held up in last place early this time as Marhoob (USA) (Mr. Prospector {USA}) set the pace. The leader faded quickly when challenged by Lagudin with half a mile remaining, and Eddery switched Right Wing off the rail and crept closer to the lead. Travelling too well approaching the quarter-mile marker, he was reined back before being taken wide to begin his challenge. Quickening impressively to pass Lagudin and Smirk, who had been driven to the front, in the final 150 yards, he was eased near the line for a convincing success. Trainer John Dunlop said, "He's got one or two other engagements this year--he loves this soft ground, so we might well run him again."

As none in this cavalry charge came cheaper at the Tattersalls Autumn Yearling sales last year, whatever Major Laugh did here would be a bonus. By winning, he made his purchase price the only joke. John Sillett, ex-manager of Coventry City Football Club, and wife Jean bought him as a foal and could not sell him the following year, buying him back for only 800 guineas. He has grown into a useful two-year-old, showing a consistent level of form in nurseries, including a win at this course Aug. 10. Here he raced in sixth among the stands' side group early as Elucidate (GB) (Elmaamul {USA}) blazed the trail on the far side. Going clear of his group inside the final quarter of a mile, he had only Protectorate and Paul Doe on the far side to catch, but, despite veering left, he did so in the final 100 yards, staying on to assert as Ayzal flashed home late.

Victor Chandler responded by quoting him at odds of 25-1 for next year's G1 2000 Guineas here in May. Part-owner John Magnier told *PA Sport*, "He has obviously improved a lot, but I wouldn't think he will run again this season. As for the Guineas, you'd have to think he'd stay a mile, his dam stayed, but whether he'd be good enough I don't know." The winner is a 1/2 to Hidden Cat (USA) (Storm Cat {USA}), SW-US, \$102,515. CAPTAIN STEVE SOLD TO JRA This year's G1 Dubai World Cup winner **Captain Steve** (Fly So Free--Sparkling Delite, by Vice Regent) has been purchased by the Japan Racing Association for \$5 million, it was announced yesterday. The four-year-old, who will be shipped to Japan at the end of the month, was donated to the Japan Bloodhorse Breeders' Association by the JRA, and will stand at the JBBA Shizunai Stallion Station on the island of Hokkaido next season. A \$12,000 Keeneland November weanling and \$70,000 Fasig-Tipton July yearling, Captain Steve went on to win four of his eight starts at two, including the GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity and GI Hollywood Futurity. At three, the chestnut captured the GII Kentucky Cup Classic and GI Swaps S. and, in Grade I company, was also second in the Haskell Invitational H. and third in the Santa Anita Derby and Breeders' Cup Classic. He started his 2001 campaign with victories in the GI Donn H. and the Dubai World Cup, but failed to find the winner's circle in four subsequent starts. He made his final appearance for owner Mike Pegram and trainer Bob Baffert in the Aug. 19 GI Pacific Classic and finished fourth. Overall, Captain Steve had nine wins, three seconds and seven thirds from his 25 starts for earnings of \$6,828,356.

BOSTON HARBOR TO JAPAN Freshman sire **Boston Harbor** (Capote--Harbor Springs, by Vice Regent), the champion juvenile of 1996 after winning the Ellis Park Juvenile, GIII Bashford Manor S., GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile, GII Breeders' Futurity and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, has been sold to the Japan Bloodhorse Breeders' Association for an undisclosed price, the *Thoroughbred Times* reports. Bred and raced by Overbrook Farm, the seven-year-old stood his first three seasons at the Lexington stud. From one crop to race, the bay has five winners from 18 starters and one stakes-placed runner. Explaining the decision to sell the stallion, Overbrook's syndicate manager Ric Waldman told *Thoroughbred Times*, "Usually you'll find, when people do sell a stallion overseas, that the interested party is willing to offer more--and sometimes substantially more--than what the usefulness of the stallion is in the United States."

This race seems at the mercy of Aidan O'Brien, who is still seeking his first success in this event. **Rock of Gibraltar** is expected to be the most likely to provide that after the withdrawal of Dubai Destination, who beat him, eased down, by a length in the G2 Champagne S. at Doncaster Sept. 14. The "Rock" has subsequently put on his own show, winning the G1 Grand Criterium at Longchamp Oct. 7 by three lengths from Bernebeau (Fr). He was value for a wider margin there, with Michael Kinane easing him down a full 100 yards from the finish. The two-year-old has taken an unorthodox route of Gimcrack-Champagne-Grand Criterium to get here, but the last three winners had contested at least one of those races before winning this event. He may be given most to think about by stable companion **Landseer**, winner of the intensely competitive G3 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot June 19. He had the "Rock" back in sixth that day, but his stablemate's luckless run there has been well documented. Even so, his beating of Firebreak (GB), Meshaher and Redback (GB) is top-class form, especially as the majority of that field have proved themselves in stakes company since. Last time he was a troubled second, a head behind Sir George Turner (GB), in the Houghton Sales S. over this course Oct. 2 on soft ground. In hindsight, that may have proved too much of a stamina test at this point for this speedy colt and he will be much better suited by these less testing conditions. Sir Michael Stoute has won the Dewhurst only once, with Ajdal in 1986, but bids to double that tally with **Comfy**, winner of the Listed Acomb S. at York Aug. 21. He has to improve on that form to trouble the top two. **Where or When** put up a sound performance when beating the smart Della Francesca by a head in the G3 Somerville Tattersall S. Oct. 5.

Connections of **Tough Speed** decided to sidestep the 10 furlongs of the G1 Dubai Champion S. due to the changing ground conditions. Last time, he made the step up in grade from handicap company to stakes level without turning a hair when beating China Visit by a half length in the G3 Park S. at Doncaster Sept. 13. That was at a mile, but the majority of his form is over this seven furlongs, which he needs in its entirety now. Previously, he left it dramatically late to wear down the smart Smirk (GB) under top weight in a competitive handicap at York Aug. 23. He will need to cope with altogether speedier types here, headed by the in-form and consistent **Nice One Clare**, who has also progressed from handicaps to Group level this term. Having won the Wokingham H. at Royal Ascot June 22, she showed improvement to take the G2 Diadem S. at that track Sept. 29 last time. That was over six furlongs, but she seems equally effective over seven, having won the Listed Sceptre S. at Doncaster Sept. 13. She needs to arrive late, but Johnny Murtagh knows what is required. **Three Points** returns after a 42-day layoff, having finished 10th in the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup Sept. 8 on unsuitable heavy ground. Previously, he was beaten only a neck by King Charlemagne under similar conditions in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville Aug. 12 and, on that level of form, he very much sets the standard.

Marcus Tregoning won this race last year with Sayedah (Ire); this year he saddles **Misterah**. She seems at this point a contrasting individual to that filly, as she is bred for speed and more precocious. That was evident in the way she knuckled down to hold off the solid yardstick Good Girl (Ire) by a head in the Listed Firth of Clyde S. at Ayr Sept. 22. But she races more than a furlong further here in testing conditions which may not suit. If she is to prove vulnerable to a more stoutly bred rival, the most likely seems to be **Echo River**, who ran her best race last time when beaten only 2 1/2 lengths by Half Glance (GB) while conceding three pounds in the G3 May Hill S. at Doncaster Sept. 13. **Red Rioja** is an interesting contender, having followed a smooth Kempton maiden success Sept. 24 with a win in the G3 C.L. Weld Park S. at The Curragh Oct. 6. She carries a three-pound penalty, but seems to be improving and may prove capable of shouldering the burden.
