ANOTHER CHAMPION IN THE FAMILY

In one of the biggest British stories of the 2001 racing year, **Nayef** (Gulch) finally fulfilled his enormous potential, beating **Tobougg (Ire)** (Barathea {Ire}) by 3/4 of a length in the G1 Dubai Champion S. at Newmarket yesterday. The winter-book favorite to double up on half-brother Nashwan's success in the 2000 Guineas, the last foal of star broodmare Height of Fashion (Fr) provided Marcus Tregoning with his first Group 1 success, after which a relieved trainer breathed, "Thank goodness, it's come off." That relief was borne of the stress of the constant media attention which followed Nayef from his juvenile days, when his pedigree and performances hinted at great things, to his eighth-place finish in the Guineas, to the build-up to this race, seen by many as his real test. *More on Champion S., p2*

TEAM FRANKEL OUT IN FORCE

Trainer Bobby Frankel, looking to break an 0-for-36 streak in the Breeders' Cup with at least one of his seven starters this year, sent out three of his top contenders to work on the Belmont Park main track yesterday morning. **Aptitude** (A.P. Indy), one of the favorites for the Classic, went five furlongs in 1:00 4/5 in company with Group winner Sumitas (Ger). **Flute** (Seattle Slew), heading to the Distaff, zipped five-eighths in :59 1/5. But Frankel seemed most impressed with the two-year-old filly **You** (You and I), who got her five furlongs in :59 4/5 and went out three-quarters in 1:12 3/5. "She was real sharp," Frankel said. "She might be a superstar."

FINAL PREP FOR MACHO UNO

Last year's champion juvenile **Macho Uno** (Holy Bull) had his final pre-Breeders' Cup breeze yesterday morning with jockey Gary Stevens in the irons, going six furlongs in 1:15 3/5 over the Belmont main strip. "I've been real happy with him," trainer Joe Orseno said. The colt comes off a third-place finish as the 1-5 favorite in the GII Ohio Derby, but Orseno said he battled a slight bout of colic before the race and added, "I haven't lost any faith in him. Gary was all smiles when he left the barn this morning. He told me that, if Macho Uno stays the way he is now, he is going to have a big say in the outcome [of the Classic]."

UNBRIDLED ELAINE ON THE MOVE

Unbridled Elaine (Unbridled's Song), second to Macho Uno in the GIII Pennsylvania Derby and fourth behind Miss Linga (Arg) in the GI Overbrook Spinster S. last time out, will make her next start in the Distaff, but not for the trainer who dropped her name in the Breeders' Cup hat. The three-year-old filly was moved from the barn of David Vance back to Dallas Stewart's stable after training hours at Churchill Saturday. Stewart had handled the filly at two and through the first half of this season before owner Roger Devenport handed her over to Vance. "She's a super nice filly and you wouldn't think twice about taking her back," Stewart said. "I was hurt when she left and I'm glad to have her back."

He also benefited from a perfectly judged ride from Martin Dwyer to overcome stable companion Palua for a one-two finish for Ian Balding and son Andrew. He had put up some creditable efforts on an unfavoured faster surface so far this year, most notably when fifth in the Nothumberland Plate at Newcastle June 30. Held up in mid-division early as Litzinsky (GB) (Muhtarram {USA}) led, he was kept to the rail and as the gaps opened he was able to travel through with ease. Lengthening well inside the final half-mile, he closed on Palua to gain the upper hand in the final strides. "He travelled so well and I stuck to the inside," Dwyer remarked. "It's a tough race, but when you have a horse that travels like that it makes it a lot easier--he travelled like a demon."

Godolphin yesterday supplemented **Mount Joy (GB)** (Mtoto {GB}) for next Saturday's G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster. Added to the mile contest at a cost of £15,000, the two-year-old colt will be making his first appearance for Godolphin, having finished third for previous trainer Barry Hills in a Doncaster maiden on his debut Aug. 4.

HANCOCK DELIGHTED WITH CHAMPION CROWD

Lisa Hancock, Managing Director of Newmarket Racecourses Trust, was delighted with the crowd assembled to witness yesterday's Champions' Day. The figure of 15,508 was slightly down on the total of 15,619 for 2000, but Hancock commented, "We are very pleased with the crowd figure, which is almost identical to last year despite today's very moderate weather forecast. There were those who said we lacked a champion today after Sakhee was re-routed to Belmont Park. It is certainly true that having the Breeders' Cup only a week away has done us no favours this year. But we have had an outstanding day's racing and I think that Nayef has gone a long way to proving himself a champion this afternoon."

SHOGUN BACK TO WORK

Australian Associated Press has reported that MG1SW **Shogun Lodge (Aus)** (Grand Lodge {USA}) is back in work and on track to go to Hong Kong in December following an injury scare which ended his Melbourne spring campaign. After he ran second to Northery in the G1 Yalumba S. last Saturday, Shogun Lodge was found to be lame and trainer Bob Thomsen feared he had a hairline fracture of his sesamoid. But Shogun Lodge returned to Sydney this week and extensive tests at the Randwick Equine Centre could detect no such problem. "The vets did every conceivable test, but could find nothing wrong," Thomsen told *AAP*. "He trotted and cantered at Randwick this morning and, all going well, we'll put him back into work and prepare him for Hong Kong. The next week or 10 days will tell us whether there is any problem, but everything seems to be fine."

Damon Thayer, the vice president of Breeders' Cup and event marketing for the National Thoroughbred Racing Association, was out at the Meadowlands Friday night, inspecting the track as a potential site for the Breeders' Cup. "The New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority has tons of experience running world-class events, and I think the Meadowlands sets up well as a potential Breeders' Cup host site," Thayer said. "We would have to put up 30-35,000 temporary seats, like we have done at Gulfstream Park three times successfully. But it is a wonderful facility--the dining facilities are world-class, the track surfaces are great. I'm duly impressed." What about a first night-time Breeders' Cup? "That's a legitimate question," Thayer said. "Could we get the network time to run the Breeders' Cup at night during prime time? I don't have the answer right now, but, clearly, that's an intriguing idea." The Breeders' Cup schedule is set through 2005. Thayer said, if the Meadowlands or its sister track, Monmouth Park, was approved as a Breeders' Cup site, it would



not get racing's main event until the end of the decade.

NAYEF'S TIME TO SHINE Drawn in stall one, **Nayef** (Gulch) did not get pole position as **Beckett (Ire)** (Fairy King) was taken to the front and shared the lead with **Albarahin** (Silver Hawk). Tracking the leader on the rail to halfway, he was edged off as **Tobougg (Ire)** (Barathea {Ire}) arrived at the front to challenge at the quarter-mile marker, but got the opening as Tobougg drifted left onto the rail and swooped to join the battle with a furlong to race. Hitting the front with 175 yards remaining, Nayef stayed on well up the rising ground, always holding the game runner-up as they pulled clear of the shock third **Indian Creek (GB)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}). "In the spring, there was a lot of pressure on all of us and nature was working its course," jockey Richard Hills said of the growthy colt. "Now he's not only picking up and galloping, he's also getting a turn of foot." Nayef, rested after running eighth in the 2000 Guineas, came back in the 1 1/2-mile G3 Gordon S. at Goodwood July 31, finishing third to **Alexius (Ire)**. Unstoppable since, he was winning his fourth Group race in succession after taking the G3 Rose of Lancaster S. at Haydock Aug. 11, G3 Select S. at Goodwood Sept. 12 and G3 Cumberland Lodge S. at Ascot Sept. 30. "It's a very special day for us," Tregoning said. "We were very encouraged by what he achieved at two but, quite often with big horses, they are just growing and all the food is just going into their growing stage, which happened in the spring. We saw with the last three runs that he was on an upward curve and he reached the top of that curve today. Thank goodness for the patience of his owner and all the help I had from Richard [Hills] here."

"The combination of putting the blinkers back on and the added distance has made all the difference for this horse," Karen Johnson, who is not only the daughter of the winning trainer, Hall of Famer Phil Johnson, but also Volponi's co-owner, said. "My father is very high on him and thinks he'll be even better at four." Burning Roma became the eighth straight favorite to be beaten in this

SECOND BEST EVER TATTERSALLS OCTOBER SALES

Europe's largest yearling auction, the Tattersalls October Yearling Sales, concluded yesterday afternoon with figures that had been bettered only once before--at last year's record-shattering renewal. The upper end of the market held up well, but further down the scale many vendors had sorrier tales to tell. The 34,787gns average was down 16 percent on last year, the 21,000gns median dropped by 19 percent, and the aggregate of 26,055,700gns was also off 19 percent. But all three figures were well up on the numbers achieved in 1999. "With seven consecutive record October Yearling Sales behind us, we knew that, despite another top-class catalogue, we would have a hard task trying to match the extraordinary figures of last year's sale," said Edmond Mahony, Tattersalls' chairman. "The average price at this sale last year was up 62 percent, more than any other major yearling sale in the Northern Hemisphere, and this week we have seen it at a level still well in advance of the then-record year of 1999. In the course of the week we have had a new record high price for the October Yearling Sale of 475,000 guineas and an average price that has broken the 30,000-guineas barrier for only the second time." Saturday's final session featured one standout lot, a French-bred chestnut Selkirk colt offered by Lord Vestey from his Stowell Park Stud in Gloucestershire. Hong Kong trainer Tony Millard was one of those interested, but it was Anthony Stroud who eventually outstayed underbidder John Warren at 210,000gns. "He will go into training for an American owner with Richard Gibson in France," said Stroud. "He was a really nice horse by an extremely good stallion and it was very flattering that John Warren was underbidder."
