KUTUB WINS JOCKEY CLUB

Kutub (Ire) (In The Wings {GB}), sent off the favorite at 1-4, romped to a 2 1/2-length success over **Monos (Ger)** (Kornado {GB}) in yesterday's G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club in Milan, Italy, on his favored easy ground. Jockey Frankie Dettori was always confident, making virtually all in the heavy conditions before stretching away in the straight. Kutub was winning his third consecutive Group 1 race, adding this win to victories in the Grosse Dallmayr-Preis at Munich Aug. 5 and G1 Deutsche Post Euro Express Preis von Europa at Cologne Sept. 23. His only defeat in Europe so far in 2001 came on a faster surface in the G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica at Rome May 13, where he suffered no disgrace in losing out by 1 1/2 lengths to Paolini (Ger). Sent to the front early by Dettori, he was tracked by **Altieri (GB)** (Selkirk), but established a clear lead in the straight. He had little trouble in sealing the triumph from there as **Monos (Ger)** (Kornado {GB}) and Paul Johnson battled into second place from the game Altieri. Kutub's success was Saeed bin Suroor's 13th Group 1 winner of 2001. Kutub may now head for the Singapore Cup next month.

Deauville's traditional three-day October Yearling Sale begins today at the famous Elie de Brignac sales complex on the Normandy shores, with 524 lots on offer. Agence Francaise is hopeful that last year's average price of FF89,860 can be bettered, given the success of sales graduates **Maille Pistol (Fr)** (Pistolet Bleu {Ire}), **Honorifique (Fr)** (Highest Honor {Fr}) and **Fantastic Filly (Fr)** (Myrakalu {Fr}). Stallions such as Alzao (USA), Anabaa (USA), Grand Lodge (USA), Hernando (Fr), Highest Honor (Fr), Indian Ridge (Ire), Machiavellian (USA), Nashwan (USA), Unfuwain (USA) and Woodman (USA) are represented, as well as the new blood such as Desert King (Ire) and Peintre Célèbre (USA). Choice lots include hip 26, a Poliglote (GB) three-parts sister to Group 2 winner Fabulous Hostess (USA) (Fabulous Dancer {USA}), and hip 35, a half sister to Group 3 winner Aboard (Fr) (Hero's Honor {USA}) by Loup Solitaire (USA). Hip 39, a 3/4 sister to Group 2 winner Bimbola (Fr) (Bikala {GB}) by Apple Tree (Fr) should also attract attention, as should hip 41, a Grand Lodge (USA) colt out of a sister to Group 1 winner Shahtouch (Ire). Horses In Training, Yearlings at Goffs

With the carrot of the €40,000 Autumn Bonus Race for graduates of the Goffs Autumn Bonus Yearling Sale, this year's Goffs Horses in Training and Autumn Bonus Yearling Sale, scheduled for today and tomorrow, should attract a higher level of attention. Today, Goffs open their doors for the selling of 100 Horses In Training, featuring lot 81, the two-year-old filly **Synchronize (Ire)** (Entrepreneur {GB}), from Eddie Lynam's Garretstown Stables, who broke her maiden at Down Royal recently. The Autumn Bonus Sale catalogues 274 yearlings who will bid to follow in the footsteps of this year's bonus race winner **Paris Express (Ire)** (Paris House {GB}). Lot 218, a colt by Grand Lodge from the family of Vintage Crop (Ire), is one to note.

PENNEKAMP TO FRANCE FOR 2002 Treble Group 1 winner and French champion juvenile **Pennekamp (USA)** (Bering {GB}--Coral Dance {Fr}, by Green Dancer {USA}) will stand the 2002 breeding season at Haras du Logis in France for a fee of €8,000 (£5,013). He has stood at Kildangan Stud in Ireland since 1997. From two crops to race, the nine-year-old is the sire of 16 winners, including the group-placed Ceepio (Ire) and Medina (Ire). "Pennekamp has a French pedigree and was a French-trained French champion," said Darley's Joe Osborne. "A very high percentage of his mares travel from France and it makes sense to give more French breeders a chance to use him."

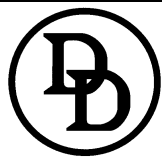
