DANIEL WILDENSTEIN DIES Daniel Wildenstein, the famous racehorse owner, died in Paris on Tuesday at the age of 84. Better known as a successful art dealer, Wildenstein has remained in the upper reaches of the French racing industry for decades, with his colours of royal blue with a light blue cap being carried to victory by some of France's best. The six-time champion owner in France owned such greats as Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winners, Allez France, All Along (Fr), Peintre Celebre and Sagace (Fr). Sagace followed up a year later, but was controversially disqualified and placed second behind Rainbow Quest. Wildenstein showed his passion following that incident by unsuccessfully contesting the stewards' decision through the courts. Earlier this year Wildenstein took 42 horses away from the stable of Andre Fabre, who had trained Peintre Celebre, to that of Elie Lellouche. Among them was the filly Aquarelliste (Fr), who went on to win the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes (French Oaks) at Chantilly June 10. She returned from a mid-summer break to win the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp Sept. 16 before being aimed at the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe there Oct. 7. Wildenstein openly compared the filly with Allez France before that contest and she rewarded that faith by beating all but Sakhee, finishing six lengths adrift. All Along also took the G1 Canadian International in 1983, while the D. Wayne Lukas-trained Steinlen (GB) won the G1 Breeders' Cup Mile in 1989. The owner tasted success in the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic in 1993 with shock winner Arcangues, trained by Fabre, denying Bertrando in a driving finish to become the only European-trained horse to win that race. Wildenstein was also renowned for his national hunt horses, winning this year's Grand Steeple-Chase de Paris with Kotkijet (Fr) at Auteuil May 27, as well as dominating the trotting circuit. Wildenstein is survived by his two sons, Alec and Guy, and six grandchildren.

BALLYDOYLE RUNNERS SETTLE IN

Trainer Aidan O'Brien decided to give his Breeders' Cup runners an extra day to settle into their new surroundings, so the seven Irish runners remained in Belmont Park's quarantine area yesterday. During a press conference, O'Brien explained, "[The horses] would have gone out if they had told us they wanted to." The Ballydoyle contingent arrived in New York on Tuesday night and includes Classic hopeful and dual Derby winner **Galileo (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells). The colt is looking to rebound from the first loss of his career, a runner-up finish to Turf hopeful **Fantastic Light** (Rahy) in the G1 Irish Champion S. "We were looking forward to meeting Fantastic Light," O'Brien admitted yesterday. "We felt we were beaten tactically last time and didn't feel it was the horse's fault. He wants strong-run races because he has a rhythm action. He likes a fast run race that comes down to a grind rather than a slowly run race where they quicken at the end. We're hoping for a good run if he handles the dirt." O'Brien will also saddle the unbeaten **Johannesburg** (Hennessy) in the Juvenile. "He's won all six of his races, the last three being Group 1s," O'Brien said. "He's raced over five and six furlongs and answered every call. We're not sure about Saturday's [1 1/16-miles] trip, but we're very happy with him."

ALLIED FORCES TO BARTON STUD Allied Forces (USA) (Miswaki {USA}--Mangala {USA}), by Sharpen Up {GB} is set to stand the 2002 breeding season at Barton Stud near Bury St Edmonds in Suffolk, it was announced yesterday. The eight-year-old stallion, who previously stood at Walmac International in Kentucky for a 2001 fee of \$3,500, will command a fee of £4,000 for next year, Oct. 1 terms. A graded-stakes winner on turf and dirt in the U.S. during his three-year-old season, Allied Forces returned to England to annex the G2 Queen Anne S. in 1997. He went on to take the Nad al Sheba Mile the following season and was named the champion older male in the UAE. The chestnut was represented by three yearlings during the recently concluded Tattersalls October Yearling sale, which sold for an average of over 35,000gns. "We are delighted that a sire of the quality and pedigree of Allied Forces is coming to Barton Stud to stand next season and I am confident that he will be of interest to breeders all over Europe," said Barton Stud Manager James Broughton. A son of top worldwide broodmare sire Miswaki, Allied Forces hails from the family of 1998 Kentucky Derby winner Real Quiet (USA).

O'BRIEN CHASES 21st IN TROPHY

Aidan O'Brien accounted for half of the field for Saturday's £175,000 G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster in his attempt to win his 21st Group 1 race of the season. He left in **Castle Gandolfo (USA)** (Gone West {USA}), **Camp David (USA)** (Deputy Minister {Can}) and **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}). Castle Gandolfo beat Camp David by seven lengths last time in the G3 Beresford S. at The Curragh Oct. 14. O'Brien withdrew **Mutinyonthebounty (GB)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) yesterday, who had been quoted at odds of 5-2 second favourite for the mile contest with Cashmans earlier in the week. Doncaster's racecourse manager Malcolm Taylor told *PA Sport* yesterday: "The going is soft at the moment. We need a fair volume of rain for it to go on the heavy side of soft. That's not likely. It definitely won't be heavy on Saturday."

DONCASTER OCTOBER REACHES MIDPOINT

Doncaster Bloodstock Sales' October Yearling Auction moved into its second day of trading yesterday with figures slightly down on last year. Of the 156 offered, 133 were sold, grossing 323,900 guineas. The average was 2,435 guineas, compared to last year's figure of 2,892 guineas. However, last year's figures represented a huge 40 percent increase on 1999. DBS Managing Director Henry Beeby said: "Again we enjoyed a lively trade and although we were down on last year, over a two-year period there is an increase of 18.4 percent which deserves a mention." Lot 492, a Goldford Stud colt by Paris House (GB) out of Darussalam (GB), reached the highest price of the sale, being purchased for 10,500 guineas by J J Crosier. Top-priced filly was lot 485, by Eagle Eyed (USA) out of Quiver Tree (GB). From the consignment

BUCKING THE TREND

Given the current worldwide economy, there would have been no surprise to see the Deauville October Yearling returns check in beneath the levels of 2000. Au contraire. The three-day-sale, which concluded yesterday, posted a 21-percent increase in gross receipts and a 17-percent jump in the average, while 71 percent of the lots were reported as sold by Agence Francaise. The final session was led by a colt by Machiavellian (USA), which brought a final bid of FF600,000 from Chantilly-based trainer Valerie Dissaux. The bay, out of Solitaire (Fr) (Sadler's Wells {USA}) was consigned by Haras de Fresnay-le-Buffard. "We are delighted to see the trend of August maintained," said Philippe Augier, president of Agence Francaise. "Our efforts of selection and of promotion helped to attract a broad range of buyers and it is good to see that the vendors are very satisfied and that not only were French professionals very active but there were several new French buyers."

GAMBLING BILL PASSES IN NY; VLTS AT AQUEDUCT

The New York State Legislature approved a bill Wednesday night to expand gambling in the state; the measure will bring about the addition of video lottery terminals at Aqueduct Racetrack. The measure will now head to Governor George Pataki's office for his approval, which is expected. The proposal would expand the number of Indian-run casinos in the state from two to as many as eight, and New Yorkers would also be able to play the multi-state lottery game Powerball. Aqueduct in Queens and Finger Lakes upstate would be the only two Thoroughbred outlets to get VLTs, which would now also be added to harness tracks, including Yonkers, Monticello and Vernon Downs. The machines would be banned at Belmont Park and Saratoga Racecourse. New York Racing Association President and COO Terry Meyocks said he did not know when the VLTs would be installed at Aqueduct, but Yonkers President Bob Galterio estimated they would arrive at Yonkers sometime next summer, after rules and regulations had been established. By law, lottery revenue is directed toward education, and while Galterio said the percentages were still to be negotiated between the tracks and the lottery, it is believed that the tracks will retain a commission, much like other lottery vendors, with the ensuing revenue being poured into purses and breeders' funds. "We are extremely pleased," said Meyocks. "The thing that we've always wanted to do at NYRA is try to get more money for purses, which this will accomplish. And somehow, someday, maybe we'll also get some people to come back to the race-track. We hope to bring them in with the VLTs and show them a good time and hopefully, they will cross over into racing." Senate Majority Leader Joseph Bruno told the *Associated Press* the package could be worth \$1 billion annually to the state within the next three to four years, revenue which is now critical in the wake of last month's terrorist attacks. "If it wasn't for the catastrophe of Sept. 11, we wouldn't be contemplating what we are doing," Bruno told the *AP*. "We're desperate for cash. Our revenues have fallen off a cliff." Said Galterio, "I think it's going to save harness racing in New York. Yonkers Raceway would have certainly have closed down. There are always things that can happen, and I can't see into the future, but if things go the way we expect them to go, harness racing has a great future in New York, and Thoroughbred racing has a great future in New York."

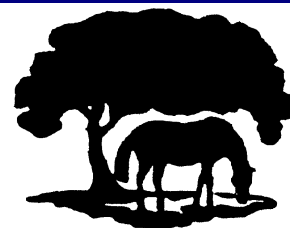
