THEN AND NOW

It was deja vu all over again at Breeders' Cup 18. Last year, **Tiznow** (Cee's Tizzy) took on Europe's "Iron Horse," Giant's Causeway, in the \$4 million GI Breeders' Cup Classic and, after battling the length of the Churchill Downs stretch, he triumphed by a neck. This year, the Europeans triple-teamed the Classic champ, sending a trio headed by Arc hero **Sakhee** (Bahri) to Belmont Park. Once again, Tiznow raced down the lane at the throat of an overseas challenger. Once again, he prevailed, becoming the first horse ever to successfully defend his Classic title with a nose victory over Sakhee. "His name ought to be 'Tiz-Awesome,'" jockey Chris McCarron, picking up an unprecedented fifth win in the event, said. "He's an incredible horse." (*More on the Classic, p2*)

DISASTER BEFORE THE DISTAFF

Breeders' Cup Day ended in brilliance, but it began with a near tragedy. **Exogenous** (Unbridled), the second choice in the GI Distaff, reared up and flipped over as she entered the track from the tunnel under the Belmont Park grandstand. The three-year-old filly caught her leg in the fence and suffered a head injury when she fell. She had to be sedated to get her onto the horse ambulance. "When we were going to the track from the paddock, she was walking nice and calm with the pony," jockey Javier Castellano said. "But getting to the track...she bumped into the rail and got her foot caught. I tried to balance her, but it was impossible. She flipped back completely." Dr. C. Wayne McIlwraith, the on-call veterinarian, described her injuries. "She sustained an injury to the base of her skull," he said. "She did have some [negative] neurological signs and couldn't get up. She also caught her right hind leg in the rail and that had to be [extricated]." The gray was treated with a steroid used in spinal injuries and brought back to the barn, where she was able to get back on her feet. "Obviously, radiographs will have to be taken to make sure there's no fracture, but, based on the response to therapy, it looks really good," McIlwraith said. Regardless of the outcome, trainer Scotty Schulhofer said the filly would be retired.

TEAM EURO LIVES UP TO ITS BILLING

It was billed as the strongest team Europe has ever fielded for the Breeders' Cup, and the results bore out that reputation. Team Euro ended the day with three wins (including one for Godolphin, who will donate their total of \$2.5 million in earnings to the NTRA Charities-New York Heroes Fund), two seconds and two thirds. The contingent from across the pond took the F/M Turf with **Banks Hill (GB)** (Danehill), the Juvenile with **Johannesburg** (Hennessy) and the Turf with the only favorite to win on the card, **Fantastic Light** (Rahy) before missing out on the Classic by the narrowest of margins. "We were one inch away from the ultimate day," Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford told *Daily Racing Form*. "Today was a marvelous day for all Europeans."

Started with a flip start due to the deep ground, this six-furlong contest was decided when jockey Kevin Darley chose the best stretch of ground on the far side with Falcon Hill. The pair grabbed the lead and ran clear past the halfway mark to win unchallenged. Leading up to his first stakes success, Falcon Hill had run with great credit in tough nurseries and conditions events, showing his best form on good to firm going and ran sixth behind Major Laugh (GB) in the Tattersalls Autumn Auction S. at Newmarket eight days ago. The colt is due to sell at the Tattersalls Autumn Horses in Training Sale in Newmarket Oct. 29-Nov. 1. David Redvers, representing the victors owners Tweenhills Racing, said, "Obviously his reserve may have to be reviewed slightly now, but he goes to the sales this week at Newmarket. He's won on fast ground as well, and he's now proven that he is a stakes horse. He's been the absolute dream horse for us--he's like an old friend now. He's run so many times and he's kept improving--Mark [Johnston] has done a fabulous job with him and to say goodbye to him will be a bit of a shame, but that's the way the game works unfortunately."

TIZNOW TAKES ANOTHER CLASSIC

Powering his way to the 2000 Horse of the Year title, **Tiznow** (Cee's Tizzy) finished first or second in eight of his nine starts and ended the season with three straight graded-stakes wins, including his gallant score in last year's Classic. But it has not been such smooth sailing this year. Second as the 3-10 favorite in the Jan. 13 GII Strub S. in his second start of the campaign, the mahogany colt came back with an impressive five-length tally in the Mar. 3 GI Santa Anita H., then disappeared for six months. Tiznow was sent to the sidelines by a bad back which nearly ended his career, but finally made it back to the races in time for the Sept. 8 GI Woodward S. and finished third. He had his final Breeders' Cup prep in the Oct. 7 GII Goodwood Breeders' Cup H., where he was bet down to even money, but once again had to settle for third. A series of early morning antics did little to raise the confidence level of the bettors, and he was sent off at nearly 7-1 in his Classic title defense. But the real Tiznow showed up on Breeders' Cup Day. The Cal-bred broke well and tracked the early pace as longshot **Oriente** (Mt. Livermore) and a rejuvenated **Albert the Great** (Go for Gin) duked it out on the front end. Albert, off at 13-1, took command after six furlongs in 1:11.32 and led the field into the stretch, looking to pull off the upset. Tiznow was on his heels at the quarter pole, dropped back a bit in upper stretch as G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner **Sakhee** (Bahri) grabbed the advantage, but came on again at the eighth pole and fought past this year's European antagonist to take it by a nose. "He ran an outstanding race," jockey Chris McCarron said. "He's wonderful, but he has been cantankerous of late. I think he is spoiled and he gets bored. He gives us cause for concern, but he's always there at the end." The Hall of Fame horseman admitted, "To be honest, at the eighth pole, I thought I was riding for second. Sakhee seemed to have all the momentum. Tiznow has been strong-willed of late and has a mind of his own, and I had it in my head I wasn't going to force him to do anything. I wanted him to do it all on his own. But, at the sixteenth pole, I thought, 'I've got to do something.' I hit him and he just jumped forward." Jockey Frankie Dettori, aboard the runner-up, was full of praise for his horse. "He's a great jewel," he said. "He just wasn't adapted to the surface. He wasn't getting the propulsion he would have if he had been on the turf. I was in the right position with him, but it wasn't to be." Tiznow is expected to race again next year, but plans

for Sakhee are undecided.

Fantastic Light's connections stunned the racing world on Wednesday morning with their decision to run him in the Turf while sending stablemate Sakhee in the Breeders' Cup Classic. The five-year-old bay sported three wins and two seconds from five starts this year, but the knock on him going into the race was his suspect record at 12 furlongs. He was winless in two starts this year and two for 11 lifetime at the route. The crowd made the winner of the G1 Irish Champion S. Sept. 8 the favorite nonetheless, and he rewarded his backers with a pace-stalking victory. Away well from the second post, Fantastic Light settled into good position in fifth and stalked a moderate pace disputed by second-choice With Anticipation (Relaunch) and Timboroa. He split rivals on the far turn when sent toward the front by Frankie Dettori, took command at the top of the stretch and opened a clear lead down the lane. Milan made a gallant run late, but never threatened the winner. "The win was great relief," said Dettori. "He has a good turn of foot. He lost a bit of concentration when he was well clear, but I could feel Michael [Kinane] coming and I thought 'keep going a little bit more.'" Godolphin's Simon Crisford indicated that the horse may run in the G1 Japan Cup before he is retired at the end of the year.

Johannesburg, Europe's top juvenile, was unbeaten in six starts sprinting on the grass, a perfect record which included three straight Group 1 victories. He tackled both dirt and distance with aplomb yesterday, drawing off authoritatively in the stretch to the roaring approval of the Irish fans in attendance. Coming off a three-length tally in the Oct. 4 G1 Middle Park S., Johannesburg was never far back and bided his time into the stretch where he split foes and drove clear. "He's been a champion every step of the way all year," said winning jockey Michael Kinane. "We always thought he was made for the dirt and he proved it today. This horse was six-for-six and I think the Americans over-looked him a bit." Trainer Aidan O'Brien added, "He's a wonderful horse. He's a natural in everything he does." Officer (Bertrando), the 3-5 favorite, was rushed up to contest the pace through fractions of :23.61, :46.85 and 1:11.01 and tired in the final furlong to finish fifth. "Especially with the head wind, when I saw them cooking down the backside, I didn't like that at all," commented trainer Bob Baffert. "He didn't leave [the break] well--he came back with paint on his shoulder from banging into the side of the gate. I wish they would have cut him off, but the speed duel just cooked him." After the race, William Hill quoted Johannesburg the 7-2 favorite for the Kentucky Derby and 9-2 for the English 2000 Guineas.

The bay filly left the field in her wake as she finished with a final quarter of :22.67. A Group 2 winner in France in August of 1999, Val Royal was sent to California three weeks later and promptly won the GII Del Mar Derby. The 5-1 third choice, Val Royal raced next to last for the first three-quarters of a mile as a quartet of runners cut a quick pace. Ranging eight wide coming into the stretch, the bay horse finished brilliantly under jockey Jose Valdivia, Jr and drew off to win by a comfortable margin in stakes-record time. Valdivia, who was making his Breeders' Cup debut, said, "The main thing, like Julio had said, was to try not to move too soon. I didn't want to be cute and weed my way through the trafic. I had all the confidence in the world. He gave me such a powerful kick." Noverre (Rahy), the 4-1 favorite, raced five-wide in seventh position early, bid on the turn, but lacked the late response needed to make an impact. "Something went wrong," said jockey Frankie Dettori. "When I asked him, there was just nothing there."

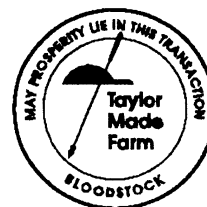
