### LEADER OF THE PACK?

One day after his scintillating victory in the Breeders' Cup Classic, **Tiznow** (Cee's Tizzy) was reported in good order by trainer Jay Robbins, who continues to ooze praise for the first repeat winner in the history of the Classic. "I thought he was beat," the conditioner said yesterday. "I hadn't seen a horse go by him before and have him come back and beat the horse. I thought he'd given everything he had." Now, can the four-year-old, who is the leading candidate for champion older horse, repeat as horse of the year? "I think we have an outside chance," Robbins continued. "Point Given didn't beat older horses and I don't know how tough the three-year-old division was." Immediate plans call for the dark bay to return to California tomorrow, while a specific plan for 2002 has yet to be formulated. "I'd like to just try to do what I did last year and back off a little bit," Robbins explained. "I'd like to walk him for 10 days or two weeks and then start jogging him." **Sakhee** (Bahri), a gallant runner-up in Saturday's main event while making his dirt debut, will remain in training next year and will likely be pointed for the Dubai World Cup.

### EXOGENOUS HOLDING HER OWN

A day after suffering a serious head injury when she reared and fell on her way to the track for the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, **Exogenous** (Unbridled) was on her feet in her stall at Barn 23 at Belmont Park. An attendendant is at her head 24 hours a day in an effort to keep her quiet. "She's kind of dopey right now," trainer Scotty Schulhofer said. "She's been anaesthetized and has a funny look in her eye. They say the next 12 hours will be critical to her. The vet is worried about her brain swelling. If it does swell, they'll have to put her down. If not, there's hope." A neurologist is scheduled to examine the three-year-old filly today.

### ROE MOWS DOWN ROYAL OAK

**Vinnie Roe (Ire)** (Definite Article {GB}), sent off the second favourite at 7-2, closed to take the lead late and held off **Generic (Fr)** (Hero's Honor {Fr}) to win yesterday's G1 Prix-Royal Oak at Longchamp. In doing so, he completed the Irish-French St. Leger double, having taken The Curragh Classic Sept. 15 for his third consecutive stakes success. Trying to extend his winning streak, the colt settled in seventh as first **Yavana's Pace (Ire)** (Accordion {Ire}) and then **Fair Question (Ire)** (Rainbow Quest), setting a fair gallop, led. Yavana's Pace regained the advantage as they raced into the false straight, but Vinnie Roe, who had threaded his way through the field while traveling easily, cruised through under a tight rein, hit the front at the top of the straight and was shaken up to put the result beyond doubt. Winning trainer Dermot Weld said, "He's a tough horse and it was a tough call whether to come here or to go to the Melbourne Cup. We'll probably go there next year with this horse. He was just a bit young for that race this year. He's finished now until next season." (Results cont p3)

## NUCLEAR DEBATE UP FOR GRABS AT

**TATTERSALLS AUTUMN** The biggest renewal of the world's largest exchange of horses of racing age, the Tattersalls Autumn Horses In Training Sales, begins at 9 a.m. in Newmarket today. This year's catalogue boasts 1,306 lots, and even with the usual high number of withdrawals, some marathon days are anticipated at what is expected to be a solid sale. Jimmy George, marketing manager at Tattersalls, said: "It's certainly the largest horses-in-training catalogue we've ever put together and there is the usual strength in depth as well as some outstanding lots, most notably the top-two-year-old Firebreak (GB) (Charnwood Forest {Ire}) and recent Group 1-winning sprinter Nuclear Debate (USA) (Geiger Counter {USA}). It is very rare to have horses-in-training for sale at public auction with that level of recent form." Firebreak, Lot 678, was bought for 27,000gns at last year's Tattersalls October Yearling Sales and is being sold in accordance with the rules of his Kennet Valley Thoroughbreds Racing Partnership. He landed the G2 Mill Reef Stakes at Newbury for trainer Ian Balding on September 21. John Hammond's French stable will offer Lot 943, dual Group 1 winning Nuclear Debate, who landed last month's Haydock Sprint Cup and the 2000 Nunthorpe Stakes at York. He is being offered to dissolve his ownership partnership, which includes British-trainer Lynda Ramsden. It is anticipated that buyers from the United States, Hong Kong, and British and Irish interests looking for jumping prospects, will fight out the top lots. Among the many other stand outs are Lot 962, Falcon Hill (GB) (Polar Falcon {USA}), recent winner of the Constant Security S. at Doncaster and Lot 199, Montecastillo (Ire) (Fairy King {USA}), winner of the G3 Concorde Stakes at Tipperary on October 7 for Charles O'Brien. The two-year-old Prince Cyrano (GB) (Cyrano de Bergerac {Ire}), Lot 1116, finished fourth to Firebreak in the G2 Mill Reef Stakes and looks like an exciting sprint prospect for next season. He was beaten just a short head in the G3 Prix d'Arenberg at Chantilly last time. The sales runs today through to Thursday, beginning at 9 a.m. each session, with the Autumn Yearling Sales set to commence around Thursday at 2 p.m.

**O'BRIEN DOMINATES JUVENILE RANKS**

Aidan O'Brien's two-year-olds were placed firmly in pole position in Britain's ante-post lists. Coral Eurobet, impressed by the success of **Johannesburg (USA)** (Hennessy {USA}) in Saturday's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, made the unbeaten colt 5-1 for the 2002 GI Kentucky Derby at Churchill Downs May 4. He was cut down to 2-1 favouritism for the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket run on the same afternoon. O'Brien now accounts for five of the first six quoted in the betting for that Classic, with **Johannesburg's** stable-companion **Hawk Wing (USA)** (Woodman {USA}) second favourite at 4-1. That colt is also quoted at odds of 16-1 as joint favourite for the 2002 G1 Epsom Derby June 10.

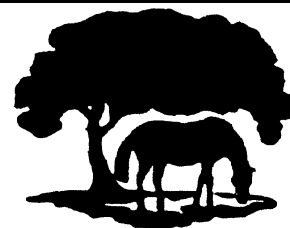

## BREEDERS' CUP WRAP-UP

**DISTAFF...** Distaff winner **Unbridled Elaine** (Unbridled's Song) was one of a large contingent of horses which flew to Kentucky yesterday morning. "She's doing great," Elaine Averill, the filly's namesake and the daughter of owner Roger Devenport, said. "She'll return to Kentucky and run again next year." Sent off the even-money favorite, **Flute** (Seattle Slew) tired to be seventh, but trainer Bobby Frankel said the filly also would race as a four-year-old. **Tranquility Lake** (Rahy), who tired to be ninth after setting the early fractions, could run again, but is likely to head to the breeding shed next spring. "We may consider running her on the dirt this winter at Santa Anita," trainer Julio Canani said. "She'll probably be retired early next year, but we don't know."

**JUVENILE FILLIES...**All was well in trainer Eoin Harty's barn yesterday morning. Harty saddled the one-two finishers in the Juvenile Fillies, **Tempera** (A.P. Indy) and **Imperial Gesture** (Langfuhr). "They came out of the race great," he said of the Godolphin colorbearers. "The horses and I are headed back to Dubai the first week in December. They'll leave for California [last night] and do 30 days of quarantine there." He added, "I can pretty much guarantee Tempera will be back here to race next spring." **You** (You and I), who finished a lackluster fourth as the even-money favorite, apparently had an excuse. "She came out of the race with a 102.3 degree temperature," trainer Bobby Frankel said, adding, "I still think she's as good as any two-year-old in the country."

**MILE...** While most of this year's Breeders' Cup winners will be getting a vacation, Mile hero **Val Royal** (Fr) (Royal Academy), who was making only his second start of the year, will be back before the end of the year. "He could go to Hong Kong for the Mile or the mile-and-a-quarter race [Hong Kong Cup [Dec. 16], but there is also the Citation H. [GII, Hollywood Park, Nov. 24]," trainer Julio Canani said. "He's a brand new horse, like a three-year-old. He's very sound." It was also reported that **Noverre** (Rahy), who finished seventh as the lukewarm 4-1 favorite, will remain in training next season.

**SPRINT...** Trainer Bobby Frankel broke on 0-for-38 streak when **Squirtle Squirt** (Marquetry) came home first, but it was John Salzman, Sr. who seemed happiest about his Sprint runner's performance yesterday morning. Salzman saddled the gallant three-year-old filly **Xtra Heat** (Dixieland Heat) to finish second, beaten only a half length after setting the pace. "I know everyone said the speed wasn't holding and the rail was dead, but she was on the front end and she stayed there a long time," he said. "I am really satisfied." He added that the bay will face the boys again in her next start, the GI Frank J. DeFrancis Memorial Dash at Laurel Nov. 17. Third-place finisher **Caller One** (Phone Trick) will head to the GIII Vernon O. Underwood H. at Hollywood Park Dec. 2.

**FILLY/MARE TURF...** Juddmonte Farms' **Banks Hill** (GB) (Danehill), arguably the most impressive winner on Saturday's card, as well as Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum's third-place finisher **Spring Oak** (GB) (Mark of Esteem {Ire}), are both expected to remain in training next year with trainer Andre Fabre. Prince Khalid Abdullah was not in attendance at Saturday's races, but was reported in good spirits by Dr. John Chandler, Juddmonte's U.S. representative. "(Trainer) Andre (Fabre) asked me whether the Prince was happy," Chandler explained. "I said to him, 'What is the French word for handsprings?' To win our first Breeders' Cup race is really astonishing," he said. **Starine** (Fr) (Mendocino) never got a chance to tuck in behind horses, according to Bobby Frankel, who was nonetheless pleased with her performance. She could make her next start in the Nov. 25 GI Matriarch S. at Hollywood Park.

**JUVENILE...** Undefeated **Johannesburg** (Hennessy), the second European-based two-year-old to win the Juvenile, will return to his Ballydoyle base to prepare for a possible try in next year's Kentucky Derby. Meanwhile, race favorite **Officer** (Bertrando) is set to return to California this Wednesday and will be pointed for the GI Hollywood Futurity Dec. 15. Trainer Bob Baffert said that the colt displaced his palate during the running of the race, which would at least in part explain his performance. Rushed up after a tardy start, he remained in contention to midstretch before faltering. "He can't be ridden like that," Baffert explained. "I knew the only way he'd get beat was if he got in a match race with (seventh-place finisher) **Came Home** (Gone West) and that's what happened." (*Breeders' Cup Notes cont p7*)

**STREET CRY RETURNS** Godolphin Stable's **Street Cry (Ire)** (Machiavellian), unraced since a runner-up finish to Express Tour in the G3 UAE Derby this past March, makes his return to the races in Wednesday's GIII Discovery H. on opening day of the Aqueduct meeting. One of the top juveniles in 2000 and third in last year's Breeders' Cup Juvenile, the dark bay took the UAE Guineas at Nad al Sheba Mar. 1 prior to his UAE Derby effort. He injured his right front ankle while preparing for a start in the Kentucky Derby, but has trained well for the comebacker. "The time off has done him a world of good," said Laurent Barbarin, assistant to trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "Maybe he'll need a race to get back to his best form, but we're definitely in it for the win." He faces six fellow sophomores in the 1 1/8-mile event, including GI Jim Dandy S. runner-up Free of Love (Meadow Flight). Street Cry totes high weight of 118 pounds and will be ridden by jockey David Flores.

**TURF... Fantastic Light** (Rahy), who eclipsed the \$7 million mark in career earnings with his victory on Saturday, is to be retired at the end of the season, but could make one more trip to the post. Laurent Barbarin, assistant to Godolphin trainer Saeed bin Suroor, said that the five-year-old is possible for either the G1 Japan Cup in Tokyo Nov. 25 and/or the Hong Kong International Races at Sha Tin Dec. 16. **Timboroa (GB)** (Salse) logged the second-best performance for the Bobby Frankel stable on Saturday with his third-place finish in the Turf. "Timboroa ran great and two good horses beat him," Frankel said at yesterday's post-race breakfast. "He might run in the [GI] Hollywood Turf Cup [Dec. 1] or the [G1] Japan Cup [Nov. 25]."
