### OH SO SHARP DIES

Sheikh Mohammed's **Oh So Sharp (Ire)** (Kris {GB}--Oh So Fair, by Graustark) has died from complications due to laminitis. She was 19 years old. The chestnut made an immediate impact on the race-track, with three wins from as many starts at two, but became a legend as a sophomore when she swept the 1000 Guineas, Oaks and St Leger to become the last winner of the Triple Crown for fillies. The best of her offspring was Rosefinch (Blushing Groom {Fr}), who won the G1 Prix Saint-Alary in 1992, and U.S. graded-stakes winner Shaima (Shareef Dancer), the dam of G1 St Leger winner Shantou. "She was a lovely mare to have at the farm," said Darley Stud director Liam O'Rourke. "She was bon and bred at Dalham Hall Stud and after her fantastic racing career, she bred Sheikh Mohammed some excellent horses. We'll miss her very much, but we still have her last foal to look forward to." Her last foal is a weanling colt by Danehill.

### STUD FEE SET FOR ALBERT THE GREAT

**Albert the Great** (Go for Gin--Bright Feather, by Fappiano), who completed his racing career with a game third-place finish in Saturday's GI Breeders' Cup Classic, will stand for a fee of \$10,000 guaranteed live foal at Three Chimneys Farm in Lexington next season. The four-year-old, a Grade I winner of \$3,012,490, arrived at his new home yesterday. "As promised, we've set his fee at what we think is a very reasonable level," owner Tracy Farmer said. "Some people would call it low, but we want to be able to really pick and choose the mares we breed to him." Farmer himself will breed 15 to 20 mares a year to his stallion. "We're going to support him with mares and I can't wait to go out and be buying Albert babies two and three years from now," he said.

## LEVY DECISION REFERRED TO GOVERNMENT

Bookmakers and the Levy Board were unable to reach agreement on the 41st Levy Scheme, covering the year commencing April 1, 2002, by the midnight Oct. 31 deadline. Under statutory arrangements, the new Levy Scheme has therefore been passed to Tessa Jowell, the Secretary of State for the Department for Culture Media and Sport, for determination. This year's Levy Scheme is forecast to yield between £62 million and £65 million, to be used largely for the funding of the racing industry. There were almost continuous discussions throughout Tuesday between representatives of the British Horseracing Board, the Bookmakers' Committee and the three independent members of the Levy Board. Levy Board Chairman Robert Hughes said, "I very much regret that, despite determined efforts on Tuesday and beforehand, we reached the statutory deadline of midnight on October 31 without achieving an agreement. It is extremely disappointing that (the Secretary) and her officials should now have to devote time and effort to resolving this inter-industry dispute. It does not bode well for commercial agreements between racing and bookmakers on levy replacement arrangements. The representatives of both the British Horseracing Board and the Bookmakers' Committee have participated fully in a series of formal and informal meetings under my chairmanship during recent weeks. The process has been complicated by the insistence of both sides that a Levy Scheme should be part of a comprehensive agreement embracing commercial elements. This involved both the sale of television pictures and pre-race data. The two parties could neither agree on the structure, the total price nor the split between the commercial contracts and the levy. Both parties held strong views; neither side was prepared to blink first and, in the end, nobody blinked. At least the Secretary of State's decision is limited to determining the Levy Scheme. This will leave both racing and the bookmakers to try and find a way forward on the commercial contracts."

## DISTANT MUSIC TO STAND IN IRELAND

**Distant Music (USA)** (Distant View {USA}--Musicanti {USA}, Nijinsky II {Can}) has been retired and will stand his first season at stud at Gay O'Callaghan's Morristown Lattin Stud in Co. Kildare, Ireland for a fee of €9,500 (Ir£7,481). The Juddmonte Farms' homebred went undefeated in his three starts as a juvenile, culminating with victories in the G2 Champagne S. and the G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket. One of the favorites for last year's 2000 Guineas, the bay went on to take the G3 White Rose Park S. prior to a good third-place finish to eventual U.S. champion Kalanisi (Ire) and Montjeu (Ire) in the G1 Dubai Champion S. His one win this year came in the G2 Goffs International S. at The Curragh. He will remain the property of Juddmonte Farms, which stands another Group 1 winning son of Distant View, Observatory (USA).

## TATTERSALLS SALES FORGE AHEAD

As the Tattersalls Autumn Horses in Training Sale concluded yesterday afternoon, the company opened the doors on its Autumn Yearling Sale. The Horses in Training Sale concluded with gross receipts of 11.8 million guineas, just one percent shy of last year's record. Yesterday's final session was headed by the three-year-old filly Toccata Aria (GB) (Unfuwain {USA}), who brought a bid of 18,000gns to top the proceedings. She will be returning to the yard of trainer Milton Bradley for new owners. The first day of the Yearling Sale saw only moderate activity, with 112 head selling for gross receipts of 527,200gns, an average of 4,707. The top price for the evening was the 30,000gns paid for a colt by Hector Protector (USA) out of Moon Magic (GB), a half sister to Coronation Cup winner Sheriff's Star (GB) and St Leger hero Moon Madness (GB). The colt was purchased by Rachel Boffey of Kern/Lillingston and will be trained by Newmarket-based conditioner Michael Bell, who has accounted for the top lot at the sale each of the last two years. The sale continues this morning at 9:30.

**STRATEGIC MISSION TO GAINESWAY** *Strategic Mission* (Mr. Prospector--Sultry Sun, by Buckaroo), a graded-stakes winner of \$396,590, will stand the 2002 breeding season at Gainesway in Lexington. The six-year-old has won seven of his 23 starts to date, including the GIII Fort Marcy H. in May; he was also runner-up in last year's GII Shadwell Keeneland Turf Mile and third in the GII Maker's Mark Mile this April. Last time out, the Florida-bred finished second in the John Henry S. at the Meadowlands. A half-brother to Grade I-winning millionaires Solar Splendor and Sultry Song, the Live Oak homebred is expected to race again before retiring to the breeding shed. "We have been looking for a regally bred son of Mr. Prospector, and Live Oak Stud has provided us a great opportunity with Strategic Mission," Gainesway's Michael Herson said. Strategic Mission's stud fee will be set at the end of his racing career.
