




BELMONT FALL MEET SHOWS GAINS The 2001 Belmont Park Fall Meeting, which ended Sunday, Oct. 28, showed across-the-board gains in handle and attendance. The figures were bolstered by Breeders' Cup 18. Daily average attendance for the 32-day stand was 7,618, up 16.4 percent. The average on-track handle rose 24.4 percent to \$2,109,472, while the commingled handle grew 28 percent, averaging \$13,410,375 a day through the meeting. A pair of single-day handle records were set on Breeders' Cup day. On-track wagering hit an all-time high of \$13,087,814, while the commingled handle was a record \$98,835,163. "Even preceding Breeders' Cup week, both daily average on-track and total handle were up slightly for the meet," New York Racing Association President Terry Meyocks said. "It has been a very traumatic and trying time in New York and we are fortunate that business held up during the time period."

ARLINGTON NUMBERS UP The 101-day Arlington Park meeting, run with two fewer dates than last year, concluded Sunday, Oct. 28 with an 8.3-percent increase in total handle. This year's number rose to \$360,622,482, from \$333,111,438 in 2000, while average daily handle was \$3,570,520, a 10.4 percent increase over the \$3,234,091 posted last year. "Our business was very strong during the summer months, with both our on-track attendance and handle up through Labor Day," said President Steve Sexton. "Like many other businesses and racetracks across the nation, our business declined precipitously following the national tragedy on Sept. 11." Average daily attendance for the meet was 5,890, down 12.2 percent from the 6,790 achieved in 2000. For the first time, Arlington raced through October in order to position itself for a bid to host the Breeders' Cup Championships. The track was tentatively awarded the event for 2002.

FINAL DAY AT TATTERSALLS AUTUMN The Tattersalls Autumn Yearling Sales, an event aimed at the lower end of the market, finished yesterday with a clearance rate of 52 percent and turnover down by 38 percent from one year ago. Edmond Mahony, the Tattersalls chairman, said, "The Autumn Yearling Sales saw the usual solid demand for good individuals with the number of yearlings selling for 20,000gns or more--marginally lower than at last year's sale, but greater than at the 1999 sale. It has also been encouraging that buyers successful with previous Autumn Yearling purchases have been active throughout the two days. However, the sheer number of yearlings on the market this year has undoubtedly affected the clearance rate." A Bigstone (Ire) (Last Tycoon {Ire}) colt offered from Voute Sales headed yesterday's selling at a modest 20,000gns. Tom Goff of Blandford Bloodstock purchased the colt, but could not reveal where the youngster would be heading. He said, "He was the nicest individual in the catalogue--he was a good-walking and attractive colt." The Horses In Training Sale, which finished on Thursday, had been much more lively. Mahony added, "As ever the Autumn Horses in Training Sale has attracted buyers from literally every corner of the world--all making significant contributions to a sale which has recorded its second best aggregate behind last year's record breaker, and its third highest average."

DARLEY DREAM STILL ALIVE

Kevin Darley yesterday scored a double at Newmarket to put himself nine adrift of leading jockey Kieren Fallon. Having won on Bollin Nellie (GB) and Give Notice (GB), Darley is now on the 152 mark with a week to go. He told *PA Sport*, "Never say never--I am enjoying it, but I am not putting any pressure on myself." Meanwhile, the Irish Jockeys' Title looks closer to being decided as Johnny Murtagh yesterday lost his appeal against a two-day riding ban. Murtagh, who trails 77 race-winner Pat Smullen by three, was hoping to overturn the ban which is scheduled for Nov. 7 and Nov. 11. The ban was placed by the Fairyhouse stewards for "careless riding" Oct. 24, but his appeal was dismissed by the Irish Turf Club's appeals and referrals committee. Murtagh said, "I am disappointed to lose it. I thought it might get reduced to one day and I would have been back for eight races on the last day. It was going to make a good climax to the end of the season. There is no more racing. I can't win. It would have been nice to have been there on the last day. A lot of people were hoping I could get home and cause a bit of excitement on the last day. It would have been good for racing. It hasn't been so close in Ireland for years. Usually, one jockey has won by October, so it's disappointing. It is disappointing to miss the last two days of the season, but overall, it has been a great season for me."

Starting an early campaign for honors as the leading sprinter in the United Arab Emirates for 2001/2002, **Mutamayyaz (USA)** (Nureyev {USA}) captured the featured race at Jebel Ali yesterday by an impressive two lengths over **San Salvador (USA)** (Dayjur {USA}). The five-year-old, who has five victories from 15 career starts, but has yet to win a stakes race, will be pointed for the Jan. 3 Al Shindagha Sprint at 1200 meters on the turf at Nad Al Sheba, a race he won last year before finishing fourth in the Jebel Ali Sprint.
