GETTING INTO THE ACT

Refusing to let Aidan O'Brien steal the show entirely, **Act One (GB)** (In The Wings {GB}) derailed Ballydoyle's juvenile juggernaut, beating O'Brien's **Landseer (GB)** (Danehill) by a half length in the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud yesterday. Now undefeated in three starts, Act One provided owner/breeder Gerald Leigh with another high-profile two-year-old success, following in the hoofsteps of stablemate Gossamer (GB), winner of the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot Sept. 29. "Act One is a very serious horse," Leigh said. "I don't usually race colts, but we had very few in that crop and, as I keep the fillies, I thought that I might as well keep the colts." He added, "We have an amazing year between England, United States and France and, with two Classic prospects like Gossamer and Act One, we can look forward to next year." In denying favoured Landseer's challenge up the inner in a driving finish, Act One also provided jockey Thierry Gillet with his first Group 1 success. He followed a smooth debut success at Chantilly Sept. 5 with a win in the G3 Prix Thomas Bryon Oct. 15. This time, he settled in second early, took command with 400 yards remaining and lengthened well late to hold off the determined runner-up.

GETTING NASTY

Nasty Storm (Gulch), scheduled to sell Tuesday as Hip 499 during the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sales, could not have produced a better advertisement for herself than her victory in yesterday's GII Churchill Downs Distaff H. The winner of the GIII Dogwood S. over the track in May, the chestnut miss didn't handle the turf in the GIII Regret S. next time out, but ran a creditable third in the GI Test S. at Saratoga July 28. Freshened after that effort, she came back to win the Sept. 15 Weekend Delight S. at Turfway Park and the Oct. 10 Raven Run S. at Keeneland. Looking to make it three in a row, the 6-5 choice had a head in front after a quarter and never looked back. The victory may have convinced her connections to hold on to her. "We don't know whether we're going to sell her," trainer Dallas Stewart said. "It'll be a fight to get her out of my barn, and I've got a big say-so." Added co-owner Denny Crum, the retired Hall of Fame basketball coach from the University of Louisville, "There are a lot of options, but we know we've turned down \$1.2 million something for her already."

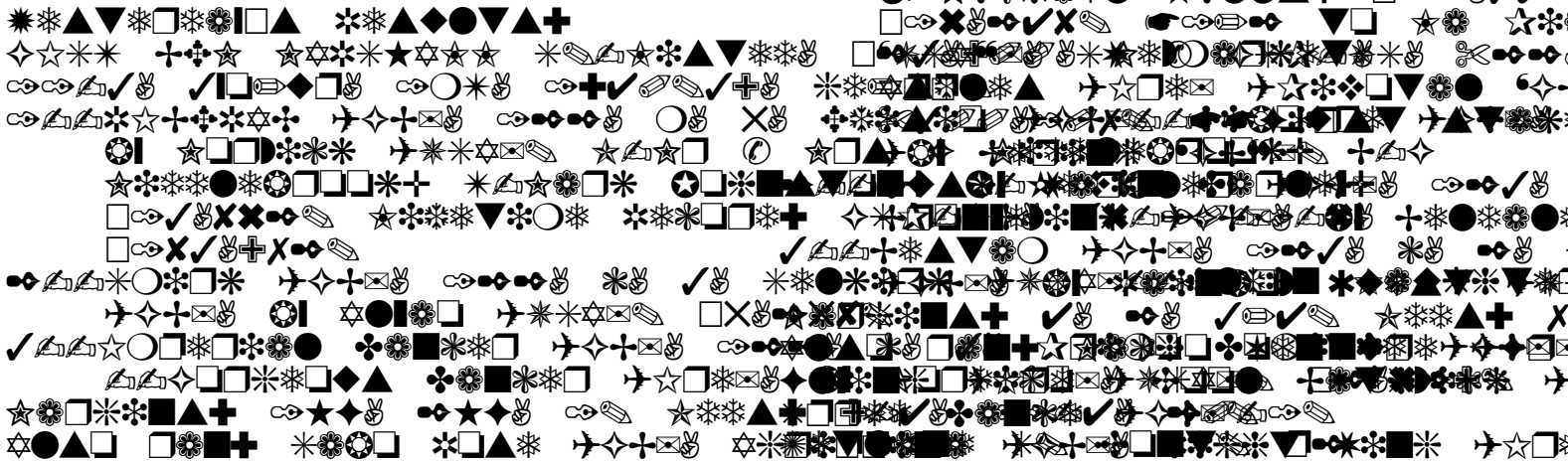
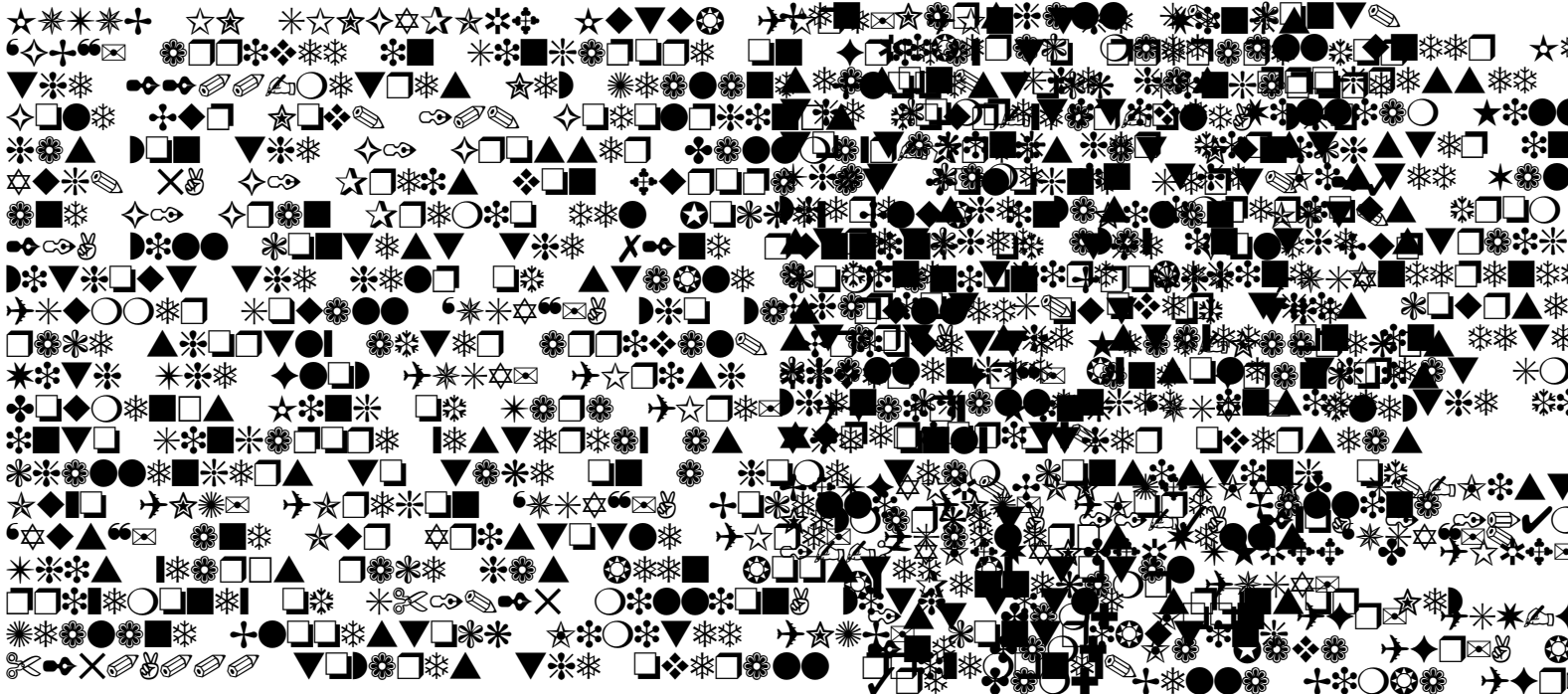

Native Desert ran a respectable third last November in the GII Citation H. before shipping to the other side of the world for a 10th-place finish behind Sunline (NZ) in the G1 Hong Kong Mile. The gelding had faced top company several times this year as well, running a close-up fourth behind Irish Prize in the May 28 GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile and, after a two-month layoff, a close second in the nine-furlong GI Eddie Read H. July 28 at Del Mar. The eight-year-old recorded his first win of the year last time out, taking the Sept. 3 California Turf Championship H. for Cal-breds at Bay Meadows. The 6-5 favorite to make it two in a row, he settled far back early, was no better than fifth entering the stretch, but moved boldly late for the narrow score.

Losing not only the race, but also more than a few votes for year-end honors, Officer disappointed here as the heavy favorite. The dark bay romped through his first five starts, capping the streak with a handy victory in the Oct. 6 GI Champagne S. Sent off at 4-5 in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile just one week ago, he dueled on the front end from his inside post, but tired late and suffered his first loss, finishing fifth. Shipped cross-country after the race, the colt had the blinkers off for this effort and was asked to come from well off the pace for the first time. He split horses on the backstretch, rallied wide around the turn and took the lead at midstretch, but could not turn back the challenge of Yougottawanna. Jockey Gary Stevens took responsibility for the defeat. "I made too much of a middle move," Stevens said. "He really hung the last eighth, but it was my fault, not his. He's a quality colt and I'll take the blame for this one." Trainer Bob Baffert indicated the two-year-old would run one more time this year, in the GI Hollywood Futurity Dec. 15. The winner was coming off a victory in the restricted Pinjara S. on the Santa Anita turf Oct. 12. Passed by Officer at the top of the lane, he came back in a game effort. "I never lost hope," jockey Laffit Pincay Jr. said. "I still had horse. I was still working on him and, when I felt him responding, I said, 'Boy, I've still got a chance.' He just kept fighting back. And boy, I could hear the crowd--the crowd went wild." Yougottawanna will be pointed for the Gill Generous S. on the grass Nov. 24.

Wake At Noon captured six of his 10 starts last year, including the Gill Highlander H. over this track, and kicked off his 2001 campaign with a victory in the Jacques Cartier S. at Woodbine Apr. 8, but had been held winless since. The chestnut reeled off three straight second-place finishes in the Apr. 28 Gill Vigil H., June 9 Gill True North H. and July 28 Gill Philadelphia Breeders' Cup H., then stepped up to the Grade I ranks and was fourth in the Forego H. at Saratoga Sept. 1. He was wheeled right back in the GI Atto Mile on the grass eight days later, finishing 13th at 39-1, and fared little better when sent off at 4-5 defending his title in the Sept. 30 Highlander, running fifth. But one month ago, Brisbane-based trainer Peter Moody told connections of NZ\$110,000 Karaka Premier purchase Amalfi they needed just two things to win this A\$1.25 million event: a sound horse and jockey Damien Oliver. Amalfi began his campaign in August winning at his home track Doomben, then headed south where he was second in the Adrian Swan Quality H. by a neck. He then chased home Viscount in the G2 Bill Stutt S. before scoring a neck win in the G2 Norman Robinson S. Oct. 20. Flashy chestnut The Bax Factor (Thunder Gulch), bred and part-owned by high-profile model Kylie Bax, set the pace in front with Amalfi settling in eighth before Oliver came out seven deep at the turn and set after the leaders. Viscount, fractious in the stalls, struggled to maintain his ground when the pace quickened at the 1000-metre marker and Ustinov was fourth. Oliver put his whip away and drove Amalfi with his hands to surge over the line a short half-head in front of 60-1 shot Zarek with Pentastic a further 1 1/2 lengths away third. "He really tried, but there was not too much left in the tank and when a horse is almost running on empty it is good to lift them over the line," said Oliver.

In the ultimate racecaller's challenge, the field inevitably divides in two for the Salinger, but Sudurka swept to a four-length lead on the inside of Flemington's vast 1200-meter straight and maintained the formidable margin until the 300-meter marker, then fought off Hire to win by a long head. Camena (Aus) was first home on the grandstand side to take third, a further short half-head away. "He felt great when he worked the other morning and he didn't leave it all on the track," said winning jockey Dan Nikolic. "The key to this horse is getting him balanced, using himself properly." The win restored respected trainer Brian Mayfield-Smith's faith in himself. "I was getting a bit cranky with myself, not going so well with my horses, so to pull a Group 1 out of the bag is great," said the trainer, who returned four years ago from a sabbatical where he worked with endangered wildlife in Africa. "Sudurka has been a frustrating horse this campaign, his work has been enormous, but things haven't been going his way in his races."

Sudurka's win was Mayfield-Smith's fourth Group 1

win and 23rd stakes success since resuming his training career and re-establishing himself in Melbourne.
