



**BONNIE HEATH DIES** Bonnie Heath, an instrumental figure in the development of Florida's racing and breeding industry, died Sunday. He was 85. Heath and his partner Jack Dudley found success in the oil fields with their Dudley-Heath Drilling Company of Stillwater, Oklahoma. The two men were also partners in D & H Stables and campaigned Needles, who became Florida's first national champion when he was named the top two-year-old of 1955. In 1956, Needles became the first Florida-bred winner of the Kentucky Derby and Belmont S. and was named champion three-year-old. In 1956, Heath purchased the land that would become Bonnie Heath Farm in Ocala, Florida. He maintained the farm until 1991 when son Bonnie and daughter-in-law Kim took over the operation. A memorial service will be held on Nov. 16 at 2 p.m. at the Ramada Convention Center in Ocala. Contributions may be made to the Hospice of Marion County or the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation.

**NUMBERS UP AT CALDER** The 119-day Calder meeting concluded Saturday with gains in on-track attendance and average daily handle. Total money wagered, including full-card simulcasting both on-track and off, was \$631,641,042, compared to \$612,045,105 last year. Total on-track handle was \$50,534,300. With three more racing days last year, total on-track handle was \$51,745,886. The 2001 daily average handle was \$424,657, while the 2000 average was \$424,147. The average on-track attendance was 4,967--up from last year's figure of 4,722. "To have increases in on-track attendance and average daily handle over the course of a five-month meet is quite a statement," said Calder President Ken Dunn. "We were able to generate a great deal of enthusiasm early in the summer with the second annual Summer of Speed. Good racing and special events, including our main event, the Festival of the Sun, sustained the momentum to help us generate these results. We're very pleased." Jockey Cornelio Velasquez was the meet's leading rider. Bill White was the top trainer.

- Miesque's Approval earned his first win by four lengths over the Saratoga turf in August before a neck loss in the GII Summer S. at Woodbine in September. He returned to take an Oct. 11 allowance over this course last time out. Heavily favored against eight others, the Florida-bred colt raced with the early speed, rallied three wide turning for home and battled gamely to get up late. "There isn't much to say," winning rider Jerry Bailey commented. "I was riding for [trainer] Bill [Mott] and he always brings them over ready to roll. We had a good trip on the rail, tipped out and got up." As for what is next for Miesque's Approval, Mott said, "He's nominated to the [GIII] Generous [at Hollywood Nov. 24], but I would have to think about sending him out there. There are a couple of options at Calder, also. If I run him again this year, I run the risk of having him tail off. But there's not very much for three-year-olds on the turf until April."

**Bay Meadows Meet Ends:**

Continuing the trend that began during the Spring Meet, the 2001 Bay Meadows Fall Meet which ended Monday saw a 2.1-percent gain in daily average handle. The track averaged \$2,059,818 a day in total wagering, with \$738,185 handled on-track, up 2.4 percent from a year ago. There was a 4.1-percent drop in the handle from out-of-state locations, which averaged \$1,562,216 during the 51-day stand, but the decrease was in part attributed to the closure of racetracks and wagering facilities around the country following the terrorist attacks of Sept. 11. A Northern California record for a single day's handle of \$9,705,403 was set on Breeders' Cup Day. Perennial champ Russell Baze picked up his 26th riding title at the track after piloting 93 winners, 45 more than runner-up Frank Alvarado, who missed the last 13 days of the meeting after suffering a broken collarbone in a spill Oct. 19. Jerry Hollendorfer earned his 23rd straight training crown with 35 victories.

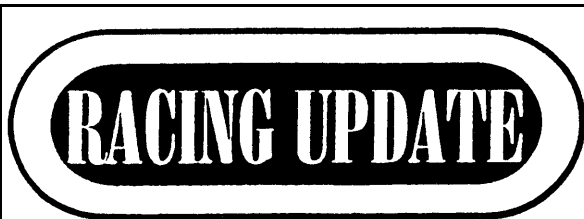
