BREATHLESS AT KEENELAND

Keeneland's November Breeding Stock Sale continued its 11-day run yesterday in Lexington, Kentucky with top honors going to lot 1353, the three-year-old filly **Takesmybreathaway** (Gone West). John Manganaro of JMJ Stable, bidding by phone, brought home the broodmare prospect for \$420,000. Takesmybreathaway, a half sister to multiple group placed Mutakddim (Seeking the Gold), was consigned by FitzGerald/Keogh, agent for Abergwaun Farm. "She's a young, good-looking mare who hopefully has a long career ahead of her," said Ned Toffey, representing JMJ Stables in the sales pavilion. Toffey originally indicated that he was done bidding at \$415,000, but jumped in for one final bid. The top-priced weanling at the fourth session was hip 1328, a colt from the first crop of European champion Stravinsky (Nureyev). The bay weanling, out of Sintanous (Danzig) was consigned by Denali Stud, agent and was purchased by Bradley & Bowden, agent, for "an unnamed group who will try to pinhook him as a yearling," according to Pete Bradley. Asked if he had any reservations about the unproven sire, Bradley said, "Stravinsky was an extremely good racehorse. I think young horses like him, they are not tarnished at all and for an athlete from a family like his, it's worth taking a shot on." The weanling is a half brother to Japanese stakes performer Raise Suzuran (Woodman) and hails from the family of dual GI Pacific Classic winner Skimming, Eltish and Forest Gazelle. During Thursday's session, Keeneland sold 225 horses for \$12,725,100 and an average of \$56,556. The sale continues today at 10 a.m.

MILAN FINISHED FOR SEASON Milan (GB) (Sadler's Wells {USA}), winner of the G1 St Leger at Doncaster and the G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York, will remain in training as a four-year-old, but will not race again his year. It had been hinted that the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe fifth and GI Breeders' Cup Turf runner-up might attempt the G1 Japan Cup or head to Hong Kong to bring the curtain down on a fine season, but Aidan O'Brien indicated otherwise. He told the *Irish Times*, "Milan has been put away for a campaign next year and won't be running again this season." O'Brien also reported that **Hemingway (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}--Welsh Love {Ire}, by Ela-Mana-Mou {Ire}), who was undefeated in his two starts as a juvenile in 2000, has been retired and will go to stud next year. The three-year-old was the one of the ante-post favorites for this year's G1 English 2000 Guineas, but, hampered by muscle problems, never made it to the races. He captured the Listed Acomb S. at two.

Unsuccessful in four metropolitan starts as a juvenile, Mister Pacha Pacha ensured his debut as a sophomore was a winning one when securing a Saint-Cloud conditions event May 14. In his last two starts he won a valuable handicap at Longchamp Sept. 1 and, in his first venture into stakes company, was second behind Abajo (Ire) in the Listed Prix Vulcain at Longchamp Oct. 14. Here he showed a willing determination to grab a first stakes win in the closing stages and deny the game Pampa Negra. Kingmage (Fr) (Fairy King {USA}) was sent to the front from the outset as jockey Dominique Boeuf bided his time in rear aboard the eventual winner. Pampa Negra tried to poach the prize by being sent clear once into the home straight, but Mister Pacha Pacha made good progress to go second at the eighth pole. The son of Pistolet Bleu responded well to Boeuf's urgings and the partnership eventually reeled in Pampa Negra to wrest victory in the final strides.

Godolphin's **Kutub (Ire)** (In The Wings {GB}) yesterday exercised over six furlongs at Kranji racecourse in preparation for a bid at tomorrow's Singapore Gold Cup, where he is expected to start a warm favourite. Work rider Brandon Walsh told *Racing Post*, "Kutub is working well and he seems to like the track here." Kutub, who will be partnered by Frankie Dettori, has won three Group 1 races this term, the Grosser Dallmayr-Preis at Munich Aug. 5, the Preis von Europa at Cologne Sept. 23 and the Gran Premio Del Jockey Club at Milan Oct. 21, and finished second in the G1 Premio Presidente Della Repubblica at Rome May 13. He will face stiff opposition in the form of **With The Flow (USA)** (Irish River {Fr}) as well as local fancies **Bocelli (NZ)** (Lord Ballina {Aus}), **Ouzo (NZ)** (Oregon {USA}) and the former Aidan O'Brien-trained **Our Aristotle (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}).

GOLAN READYING FOR JAPAN CUP

G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas winner **Golan (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}) looks to be on target for the G1 Japan Cup in Tokyo Nov. 25, having satisfied connections when completing his final serious piece of work on Racecourse Side at Newmarket Wednesday. Golan's latest racetrack appearance came when he finished fourth to Sakhee (USA) in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 7. Trainer Sir Michael Stoute will be looking for a hat-trick of victories in the Japan Cup following the previous successes of Pilsudski (Ire) and Singspiel (Ire). Golan is set to take up stud duties at Coolmore Stud next season. Kieren Fallon seems set to retain the ride aboard Golan despite the recent announcement that he will not be Stoute's retained stable jockey next season.

Magical Miss recorded one of the most impressive wins of the Melbourne Spring Carnival with this effort. "She is obviously a very good filly; you don't get a filly looking any better than her, she is foolproof to train, eats like a draught horse and races like a champion. She'll be a weight-for-age horse next year," trainer Bart Cummings said. Purchased for A\$520,000 by Cummings' long-time client Bill Wyllie at the 2000 Inglis Easter Sale, Magical Miss had been sent out the 3-1 favorite in her past four starts and had earned a cheque in three autumn appearances before being tucked away for a spring assault. Second on her return, she then finished fourth to Ugachaka (NZ) in the G2 Edward Manifold S., but silenced the critics winning the G1 1000 Guineas a fortnight later at Caulfield, beating Golden Slipper heroine Ha Ha (Aus). Last time out, she managed only sixth of 16 in the G2 Wakeful S., but jockey Steve Arnold said it was "a good run on a hard track, with top weight and the outside barrier." Magical Miss settled sixth early here before being eased to the outside at the 500-meter mark to gobble up the leaders and easily sprint clear. "She relaxed well and she was very strong at the finish, a really good turn of acceleration when I asked her," said Arnold. Wyllie revealed Cummings, collecting his eighth VRC Oaks, had a case of pre-race nerves. "We were quietly confident, but Bart was nervous; this is his first Oaks in 10 years," he said. A record Oaks Day attendance of 101,201 eclipsed the previous best attendance by 4,795.

WITNESSING THE NOVEMBER SALES

The Amish usually rely on horse-drawn carriages to move from point A to point B. The Amish don't use telephones, they don't have fax machines. But, believe it or not, they do attend major Thoroughbred auctions.

A group of Amish from near Fort Wayne, Indiana, which owns Arborvita Lane Farm in the northern Indiana community, arrived in Lexington Monday night for the November Sale and they wasted little time entering the fray.

Advised by Sun Valley Farm's Barry Butzer and Jody Huckabay of Elm Tree Farm, Arborvita signed the ticket on hip number 491 during Tuesday afternoon's second session. Consigned by Mill Ridge Sales, agent, the four-year-old filly Mombasa (Dynaformer) was purchased for \$240,000 and is carrying a Carson City foal. The filly is a half sister to Funistrada, winner of the GII Fall Highweight H. and dam of stakes winner Conte di Savoya and graded-stakes performers Krisada and Zahwah.

This is not their first trip to Central Kentucky, however. The group also attended the 2001 January Sale and gave \$50,000 for the seven-year-old mare Emphasis (Green Dancer), who was carrying a foal from what would become the final crop of the late Affirmed. The mare, a half sister to the dam of multiple Grade I winner Janet (GB), is back in foal to Behrens. They also privately acquired a Gone West mare carrying a foal from Grade I winner Joyeux Danseur and Arborvita plans on raising the foals at their farm before consigning them to subsequent yearling sales.

"We hope to sell them at the September Sale," said a representative of the farm, who wished to remain anonymous. "We are trying to produce high-quality racing stock."

But, if and when the foals make it to the races, don't expect Arborvita to be putting any money through the windows.

"No, we don't gamble," the representative said, adding that he has never even been to the races. "But if they run, I'll probably go and watch them run and leave it at that."

Arborvita is also dabbling in the breeding end of the business as a one-third partner in the Storm Cat stallion Cat Power, who entered stud this year at a fee of

\$1,500 at RC Racing in Fort Wayne.

The group has been warmly received at Keeneland. "We're trying to do an honest and fair business," he said. "The people have been very kind to us and have welcomed us despite what is obviously an unusual situation."

UNBRIDLED EXCITEMENT

When Ernie Paragallo and his bloodstock advisor Baden "Buzz" Chace slide into a sales pavilion, you know they mean business. The team saw off all bidders to take home a yearling colt by Paragallo's young stallion Unbridled's Song for a "mere" \$220,000. "I thought that he actually would bring a little more than the one that sold [Wednesday]," Paragallo said, referring to that quarter-million dollar colt. When asked what it was that he liked about the gray colt, he answered predictably. "He's a very athletic and good-looking colt. He reminds me of his father," he said. And speaking of the latter, how did Paragallo feel when Unbridled Elaine caught Spain in the final jump of the Breeders' Cup Distaff? "I was ecstatic," he commented. "I felt sick at the top of the stretch when she got checked, but when [jockey] Pat [Day] got her out and she came flying, I was just hoping for the best and it worked out. I felt about as excited as when her father won [the 1995 Juvenile]."
