SHOOTING FOR THE MOON

Moon Queen (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), coming off a victory in the G2 Prix de Royallieu at Longchamp Oct. 6, will be the one to beat in today's \$150,000 GI Long Island H. at Aqueduct. The three-year-old filly is one of two in the overflow field to win at the 1 1/2-mile distance of the race, taking the Sept. 19 Listed Prix des Tourelles by four lengths at Chantilly two starts back, and she has been first or second in all seven starts this term. The other runner who has had success at 12 furlongs is three-year-old **Sweetest Thing** (Candy Stripes), who beat the boys in the third leg of the Canadian Triple Crown, the 1 1/2-mile Breeders' S. at Woodbine Aug. 11. The bay took a short break after that start, returning to post a 4 1/2-length score in the Wonder Where S. Sept. 29 to run her turf record to four-for-six. She blew the first turn in her latest, however, and finished a lackluster ninth in the Oct. 13 GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland. "I think she was confused at Keeneland," trainer Roger Attfield said. "She had only run on the big course at Woodbine and, when she went to Keeneland, it was like a bullring for her." Sweetest Thing will have a new jockey for the Long Island, getting Richie Migliore in the saddle.

IRISH RIVER MARE TOPS KEENELAND FRIDAY

Fiamma (Ire) (Irish River {Fr}--Florie {Fr}, by Gay Mecene), from the family of MGSW Fanjica (Ire) and champion Invanjica, brought a final bid of \$220,000 to top Friday's session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington. Consigned by Fred Seitz/Brookdale Farm, agent, the bay, who was not bred this year, was purchased by Hugo Merry Bloodstock. A winner in Italy, the six-year-old broodmare has produced one foal, a weanling filly by Real Quiet. Fred Seitz and Brookdale also accounted for the day's top-selling weanling, a colt from the first crop by Tactical Cat (Storm Cat) out of Schonbrunn (Val de l'Orne {Fr}). The gray, a half-brother to stakes winners Nymphenburg and La Habitant Time, was purchased for \$125,000 by Marshall W. Silverman, agent. The 11-day Keeneland November Sale continues through Thursday.

BECKETT RETIRED

Beckett (Ire) (Fairy King {USA}--Groom Order {GB}, by Groom Dancer {USA}), winner of last year's G1 National S., has been retired and will stand at Tally-Ho Stud in Co. Westmeath, Ireland. Trainer Aidan O'Brien's colt, who was purchased by Demi O'Byrne for 1.7 million guineas at the 1999 Tattersalls Houghton Yearling Sale, was a disappointing 10th in the G1 Dubai Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 20 on his final start. On the board in all but one start, Beckett retires with three wins in six starts and earnings of \$175,551. He is due to arrive at Tally-Ho next week and his fee has been set at Ir£3,500.

An unconfirmed case of West Nile virus in a race horse which had been stabled at Churchill Downs is under investigation by the Kentucky State Veterinarian's office. The unidentified horse was euthanized at an equine clinic in Lexington Oct. 25, and preliminary test results point to West Nile; the results of further tests conducted are expected to be available in seven-to-10 days. If the diagnosis is confirmed, it would be the first case of the disease at a Kentucky racetrack.

DON'T SHOOT THE MESSENGER

There were 1,386 hip numbers catalogued in the first two of Keeneland's six books for 2001. Of those 1,386, Keeneland's figures showed 787 listed sales, with just under 57% of the horses catalogued at least nominally changing hands. There were 256 outs--18% of the catalogue--and another 344 (30% of the 1,130 who were sent through the ring) were RNA'd.

This 57% clearance rate, which is 10-15% lower than is achieved when demand is high across the board, is at odds with the word on the ground that prices are still plenty high for 'what everybody wants.' The conclusion is inescapable that there are an awful lot of horses that nobody wants, however brisk the demand is for the privileged few.

The percentage of outs was considerably higher in Book 1 (22%) than Book 2 (16%), but it remains to be seen if that downward trend is sustained. What does look significant is the RNA percentages--37% of those through the ring on Monday, down to 27% on both Tuesday and Wednesday (revisions of reserves, no doubt), but back up to 32% on Thursday, which adds up to 30% overall for the first two books.

On Tuesday, the average dropped just 2% from last year's Tuesday session; on Wednesday, when 8% more horses actually sold than in last year's corresponding session, the gross dropped just 6%, and the average was down 14% from Wednesday of last year.

In fact, Book 2 may give us the clearest picture of all as to what is actually going on in the sale, because there were 455 horses sold on Wednesday and Thursday, 4% more than the 436 which sold on Wednesday and Thursday last year. Though it was plenty strong on Wednesday, prices weakened again on Thursday, when both the gross and average were down 30% from last year's Thursday session. Overall, Book 2 this year dropped 16% in gross and 20% on average from the corresponding days last year.

Through Thursday, including Fasig-Tipton and Adena Springs, a total of 896 horses were listed sales. Sixty of those--6.7% of those sold, or one in 15--sold for \$500,000 or more, and those 60 averaged over \$1 million each--\$1,077,750, to be precise, which means that 6.7% of the horses sold accounted for 43% of the \$148,887,100 in sales. If you weren't selling a \$500,000 horse, what did you have? On average, a \$100,000 horse--the other 836 grossed \$84,222,100, an average of \$100,744. That's the average figure for all horses sold through Thursday which did not bring \$500,000+, and that was the case for 93.3% of the horses sold.

How it Compares

If we compare this year's sales with last year's, but throw out Keeneland's Sunday figures from 2000 (no comparable day), we should get a precise measurement of how things have changed, although we have no way to measure, really, the differences in the catalogues. As Keeneland's Geoff Russell pointed out the other day, though, you wouldn't expect to achieve the same numbers if there were 10 mares in foal to Storm Cat last year, and only one this year. Given that caveat, and at least measuring like to like in terms of the number of days, here's what we find--Number of listed sales: 896 this year, 1006 last year, down 110 horses, or 11%; Total gross: \$148,887,100 this year, \$229,731,000 last year, down \$80.8-million, or 35%; Average: \$166,168 this year, \$228,361 last year, down \$62,000, or 27%.

A slightly different approach is to go ahead and add in last year's Sunday dispersal day, which gives us a comparison between everything that happened through the end of Thursday this year and everything that happened through the end of Thursday last year. There were 200 horses sold on opening Sunday 2000; the 2000 totals would then read: 1,206 sold, grossing \$257,826,100 and averaging \$213,786. By those measurements, this year's sales have seen 26% fewer sold, a 42% drop in gross (\$109-million), and a 22% drop in average. All those percentages are, interestingly, within 4% of the Book 1 declines vs. Monday-Tuesday last year.

The Two-tier Market

The fact that one out of 15 so far have averaged \$1-million plus, and the other 14 of 15 have averaged \$100,000, illustrates dramatically that we're referring to at least two tiers when we talk about the auction market. Though we're obliged to combine everything when reporting sales--because it's complicated enough even just doing that--further analysis invariably leads to the conclusion that the rarefied top tier behaves by rather different rules than the rest of us. Just the other day, I was writing about stud fees, saying they need to come down more--it's important for breeders to remind studmasters that only the top-tier stallions can really be priced as if the breeder can hit a home run using them. For 90% of the horses selling in even the top third of Keeneland November, you're selling \$100,000 horses. The stud fees to cover those mares need to be competitive for breeders, who have suffered huge losses this

year, to stay in the game.

There have been 48 mares, through Thursday, which sold in foal for \$500,000+ . They were in foal to 22 different stallions, of which five, interestingly, were standing their first seasons in 2001. At least with these 22 stallions, the argument can be made that you can sell a half-million dollar mare in foal to them. So I exempt these 22, at least in that respect, from my argument that their stud fees should drop.

Yes, the sales have been plenty strong in some respects. Quality is selling at a premium. Class mares have been very difficult to buy. Good-looking foals that vet clean have been equally strong. There is plenty of money being spent, and waiting to be spent. Much of the decline in prices can be ascribed to differences in the catalogue, the 'mare loss syndrome' catastrophe in Kentucky, and all sorts of world political and economic events. And, after all, the horse market advanced every year from 1992-1999, and peaked in 1999-2000. In a funny way, the market for horses is just as strong as it has been the last couple of years, in spite of these results, that's perfectly true. But it is also true that there are an awful lot of horses at these sales who are not getting sold, and especially, not being sold for a profit to anybody, considering the stud fees in them. Of course, that's the market cure for overproduction: lose enough money, take the mare out of circulation. By close of business Thursday, Keeneland was only one-third over; and that's the top third.

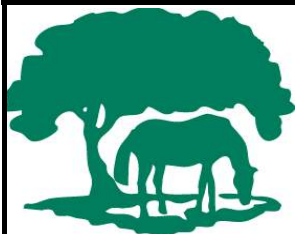
