### CEE THE TOPPER

A weanling full sister to 2000 Horse of the Year and two-time GI Breeders' Cup Classic hero Tiznow brought a bid of \$950,000 to top Saturday's session at Keeneland's November Breeding Stock Sale. Consigned by Craig Bandoroff's Denali Stud as agent, the January foal was purchased by John Ferguson Bloodstock on behalf of Godolphin. By the Relaunch stallion Cee's Tizzy, the bay filly is out of Cee's Song (Seattle Song), who sold for \$2.6 million on Tuesday at Keeneland. In addition to Tiznow, who has earned over \$6.4 million to date, Cee's Song has also produced Budroyale (Cee's Tizzy), an earner of over \$2.8 million and runner-up in the 1999 GI Breeders' Cup Classic. "She's a nice filly," said Bandoroff. "We were fortunate that lots of people had an opportunity to see her earlier in the week [alongside Cee's Song]." The highest-priced mare was Psychic Spirit (Deputy Minister), who attracted a bid of \$160,000 from Walnut Green Bloodstock. Offered by Taylor Made Sales Agency, the 10-year-old mare, a daughter of GSW Psyched (Hagley), is in foal on an April cover to Siphon (Brz).

### LINING UP THE LONG ISLAND

After a pair of close calls in her last two starts, **Queue** (French Deputy) finally earned her first graded-stakes victory by bounding up the middle of Aqueduct's turf course in the GII Long Island H. yesterday afternoon. The chestnut filly just missed to subsequent GSW Starine (Fr) in a Saratoga allowance before shipping to Delaware to take the New Castle H. Aug. 19, then missed by a head in the GIII Violet H. Sept. 28 at The Meadowlands. Trying 11 furlongs for the first time Oct. 19 over the same course, she was a 3/4-length second while giving 10 pounds to Cruise Along (Runaway Groom) in the Navajo Princess S. The second choice at 5-1 while stretching out to 1 1/2 miles, Queue was content to race at the back of the pack as 9-5 favorite **Moon Queen (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) alternated for the lead. Queue reached contention with a four-wide move on the far turn and kicked into gear in the stretch to record a sharp victory. "I thought she was very unlucky to lose her last two at The Meadowlands," said Mike Lerman, assistant to winning trainer Vinnie Blengs. "She just needs a clean trip and some pace to run at. I would imagine the La Prevoyante at Calder [GII, Dec. 29] will be her next start, because her owners are from Florida." Canadian **Sweetest Thing** (Candy Stripes), who defeated colts in the Breeders' S., rallied up the inside to get second. Moon Queen, a group winner in France, held the lead at the quarter pole, but tired in the final furlong to finish fifth. "We never had a chance to relax," said her jockey, John Velazquez. "We were always pressured. This was a new thing for her, she's used to running slower over there [France]. I thought we went pretty quick for this course." *Long Island chart, p2*

Danehurst has found success twice at the Listed level this season, including a score in the Travis Perkins Bentinck S. at Newmarket Oct. 19 last time. Increasing her stakes tally to four here, the filly denied the persistent Eastern Purple in Britain's last turf race of the season. Jockey George Duffield reserved his mount just off early pacesetter Bouncing Bowdler (GB) (Mujadil {USA}) in sixth place as the field split into two groups. Danehurst moved smoothly onto the heels of the leaders approaching the final quarter mile and was ridden into a slight lead at the distance. Duffield was at his strongest on the homebred throughout the final furlong as Eastern Purple made a determined bid, but the partnership had enough to prevail in a driving finish.

Boreas recorded his only stakes victory last year in this event under similar conditions and doubled his tally here with an impressive display of stamina in the rain-softened turf. Jockey Jamie Spencer oozed confidence throughout and settled Boreas in sixth place as Yorkshire (Ire) (Generous {Ire}) assumed his usual pacesetter role. The race began in earnest once the field turned for home as Yorkshire gave way whilst Boreas made progress on the bridle to challenge at the three-furlong pole. Spencer let out an inch of rein at the quarter-mile marker and his mount cruised to the front with ease. The race was over in a matter of strides as the 6-4 favourite went stylishly clear approaching the final furlong and he kept up a relentless gallop to the line for an easy win. Former G1 Derby third Border Arrow proved best of the remainder and ran on well to secure the runner-up berth.

**BALLYDOYLE THREE-HANDED**

Aidan O'Brien has three representatives, after yesterday's declaration stage, for this Tuesday's G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud in his bid to secure all except one of the European G1 juvenile races open to colts this season.

**Castle Gandolfo (USA)** (Gone West {USA}), runner-up in the G1 Racing Post Trophy looks Oct. 27, appears to be his main chance and is the choice of jockey Michael Kinane. Also in the field is Galileo (Ire)'s full brother **Black Sam Bellamy (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) and **Ballingarry (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}). Britain has three contender's in **Swing Wing (GB)** (In The Wings {GB}), Brian Meehan's **Angelus Sunset (USA)** (Numerous {USA}) and Giles Bravery's Master In Law (Ire) (Polish Precedent {USA}). The home defence is headed by **Agog (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}), representing the same Leigh-Pease-Gillet axis which was responsible for lowering the Ballydoyle standard in the G1 Criterium International with Act One (GB). The Andre Fabre-trained **Martaline (GB)** (Linamix {Fr}) and the unbeaten **Special Kaldoun (Fr)** (Alzao) enhance the home challenge. **Banyu Dewi (Ger)** (Poliglote {GB}), one of Germany's best two-year-olds, completes the 10-strong field.

Kiaran McLaughlin, who last won the training title in 1996/1997, sent out a pair of talented students who may assist the trainer to regain the title from the last season's leader Satish Seemar. **Ejitithaab (Ire)**, a four-year-old gelding out of the Graded Stakes winning mare Cunning (GB), ran impressively to score in a handicap event while still a maiden. A half brother to deceased Champion Dubai Millennium (GB), **Hobb Alwahtan (GB)**, appears to have benefitted from the addition of a visor and responded by coming home a two-length winner. The Peter Brette-conditioned **Swiss Law (GB)**, top dog in the new trainer's stable last season, marked his return with a win in the evening's feature event. He came home ahead of **Jalaab (Ire)** (Green Desert {USA}) with Italian Derby winner **Mukhalif (Ire)** (Caerleon {USA}) back in third.

In her pink and green colors, she campaigned Hall of Fame runners Affectionately, Searching and Stymie, trained by her husband, Hall of Famer Hirsch Jacobs. In addition, she owned Horse of the Year Personality, a son of Affectionately; and classic winner High Echelon. Those runners were trained by her son, John. "She was a great sportswoman, one who loved racing so very much," John Jacobs told *Thoroughbred Times*. "She was not only a great winner, but a great loser as well. You would run a horse for her and if it lost, she wouldn't bat an eye, as long as the horse came back okay. She was a real lady-- honest, with great spirit, and a tremendous amount of dignity." Ethel Jacobs was the nation's leading owner in 1936, 1937 and 1943. She is survived by her children Thomas E. W. Jacobs, Patrice Wolfson and John W. Jacobs; and her grandchildren John W.
