### GUIDED TOUR TO MIDDLE EAST

Millionaire **Guided Tour** (Hansel), who was purchased privately by Buckram Oak Farm just before his fifth-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, leaves Churchill Downs today on the first leg of his journey to Saudi Arabia for the Jan. 11 King's Cup. The five-year-old, a five-time graded-stakes winner, was scheduled to make one final U.S. appearance in the Nov. 23 GII Clark H., but will skip that start. Niall O'Callaghan offered the gelding's new trainer Louis Albertrani some words of advice. "I told him all the little things," O'Callaghan said, "like the only time you know that he's training good is when he's sprinting off the training track and back to the barn. And he won't run without peppermints--that's the key to him."

### SMILE MARE TOPS KEENELAND SUNDAY

**I'll Get Along** (Smile--Don't Worry Bout Me, by Foolish Pleasure), in foal to MGSW **Doneraile Court** (Seattle Slew), brought a final bid of \$130,000 to top Sunday's session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington. The nine-year-old mare, a multiple stakes winner from the family of MGSW Cowboy Cop and GISW Basie, was consigned by Walnut Green, agent for Someday Farm, and purchased by Brent Fernung, agent for Cloverleaf Farm. Her first foal is a yearling of 2001. A colt from the second crop by world-record setter **Elusive Quality** (Gone West) out of Judys Wild Rose (Wild Again) was bought for \$100,000 to top Sunday's offering of weanlings. Consigned by Mill Ridge Sales, agent, the dark bay was purchased by Wark Bloodstock.

### KASH IN THE BANK

Changing hands after his victory in the Aug. 25 GIII Fourstardave H. at Saratoga, **Dr. Kashnikow** (El Gran Senor) made his first start under new management in the Sept. 22 GIII Cliffhanger H. The gray was sent off the 19-10 favorite in that Meadowlands event, but flattened out late to be fourth. Looking to bounce back after a brief freshening, the four-year-old overcame a bumpy beginning to win yesterday's GIII River City H. at Churchill Downs by 1 1/2 lengths over

9-10 favorite **Tijiyr (Ire)** (Primo Dominie {GB}). The Canadian-bred was jostled at the start and found himself a couple of lengths last through the opening six furlongs in 1:11 4/5, but hit the afterburners when angled to the outside for the final quarter, grabbed the lead at the sixteenth pole and drew clear to run his turf record to six-for-nine.

### DUAL DERBY WINNER HEADS TO BRITAIN

**Shahrastani (USA)** (Nijinsky II {Can}--Shademah {Ire}, by Thatch {USA}), winner of the Epsom and Irish Derbies, will stand in England for the first time at Walton Fields Stud for the 2002 season. The 18-year-old stallion has covered limited books of mares in Ireland since his repatriation from Japan in 1999. "In Shahrastani's 1996 crop alone, 87.5% of the foals have won," said David Allan of Allan Bloodlines, who brought the horse back from Japan at the end of 1998. Shahrastani, who defeated eventual G1 Prix de L'arc de Triomphe winner Dancing Brave (USA) in the 1986 Derby at Epsom, will stand for £1,250, on 1st Oct. terms.

### SMULLEN AND FALLON KINGS

As Britain's champion jockey Kieren Fallon scored in Toulouse on **Goncharova (USA)** (Gone West {USA}), Pat Smullen yesterday sealed the Irish title at Leopardstown. The defending champion took the opener, the Bracken EBF Maiden, on Sun Seasons (Ire) (Salse {USA}) before watching his chief rival Michael Kinane close the gap with a dramatic 130-1 treble aboard Listed winners Shoal Creek (Ire), On The Nile (Ire) and handicap victor Tortue (Ire). It was too little too late, however, as Smullen remained three wins ahead with a total 81 winners. Smullen commented: "Other than winning Group 1s, keeping the title has been very important for me. I have always wanted to be champion from the time I started out in racing, and it's great to be ending the season in front again." Smullen is scheduled to depart for Dubai this week where he will remain throughout the winter. Fallon, meanwhile, was basking in his fourth British title after closing the turf season with 166 winners. Fallon said: "It has been exciting for the public. It has been a pretty good season. Highlights would be being here today getting this trophy, winning the Guineas on Golan and the Eclipse on Medicean. I am looking forward to next season. There are plenty of trainers I can ride for and I hope I can pick up where I left off. When you win something you always want to hold it and let's hope I am standing here next year."

Aidan O'Brien ended the 2001 domestic season on a high when Shoal Creel (Ire) scored in the Knockaire S. and later in the day, On The Nile made it a double for her trainer. Respectable in defeat, she ran third to her smart stable companion Kournakova (Ire) in a Navan maiden Oct. 17 before placing sixth behind Marionnaud (Ire) in the Listed Silken Glider S. over this course Oct. 27. While still a maiden, she gained her first stakes success over the soft ground on which her three-quarter brother Kutub (Ire) thrives. Held up in eighth place early by jockey Michael Kinane as Ardara (Ire) (Sadler's Wells {USA}) cut out the running, she moved closer as they approached the turn into the straight. Heading the pacesetter with 300 yards remaining, she kept on well to deny the challenge of Wrong Key in the final furlong. O'Brien said: "On The Nile loved the strongly-run race and is only getting fit now. She is a three-part sister to Kutub and should do well next season."

Shoal Creek, a pacemaker for **Giant's Causeway (USA)** in the G1 Juddmonte International S. at York last August, kept the pace honest to help the "iron horse" succeed, and still managed to claim fourth place for himself in the process. He then went on to win the Listed Solonaway S. at The Curragh in September before returning to be a fair third behind Muakaad (GB) in the Listed Mooresbridge S. over the same course May 7. Following a five-month respite, he returned last time out to finish second by 2 1/2 lengths to **Free To Speak (Ire)** in a conditions event here Oct. 27. Showing the benefit of that run, he disputed the early lead with **Merchant of Venice (USA)** (**Storm Cat {USA}**) until making his move in the straight. Sent clear passing the quarter-mile pole, he was never in danger from there, crossing the line a convincing winner from **Tiger Royal**. Shoal Creek may now head for the G1 Hong Kong Mile at Sha Tin Dec. 16 to accompany stable companion **Bach (Ire)** (**Caerleon {USA}**), who heads for the Cup. O'Brien said: "Shoal Creek is Bach's working companion at home and with Bach going for the Hong Kong Cup next month, we may now send Shoal Creek as well for the Mile."
