KEENELAND CONCLUDES

The Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale concluded yesterday. Topping the 11th and final session was a colt from the first crop of Expelled (Explodent) purchased for \$65,000 by Sheffield Lodge Stud as agent. Offered by Wimbleton Farm as agent, the bay colt was produced by the winning Cozzene mare Jeff's Type and is from the family of GISWs Hidden Light and Prince True. Another first-crop sire accounted for the second-highest price when a filly by Frisk Me Now (Mister Frisky) attracted a bid of \$50,000 from Evergreen Stables. Out of Joy of My Heart (Lil E. Tee), she was consigned by Old Frankfort Stud as agent. Thursday's final session saw 220 head change hands for a total of \$1,255,600. The average was \$5,707 and the median was \$3,500. The overall top price of the sale was the \$4 million paid for Twenty Eight Carat (Alydar), the dam of A P Valentine in foal to Fusaichi Pegasus. In total, 17 mares were sold for \$1 million or more. Just one weanling brought seven figures, a daughter of Storm Cat--Better Than Honour (Deputy Minister) at \$1.5 million. The next highest priced weanling was a \$950,000 Cee's Tizzy--Cee's Song filly. The California-bred bay is a full sister to 2000 Horse of the Year Tiznow. With 1,000 fewer horses catalogued this year than last, comparative figures are not applicable. In 2001, 2506 horses grossed \$179,568,600 for an average price of \$71,655 and a median of \$20,000.

NAYEF TO DUBAI G1 Champion S. winner **Nayef (USA)** (Gulch {USA}) is to be prepared for an attempt at the G1 Dubai World Cup next March. He is due to leave Britain within the next seven days and will be readied from his base in Dubai, but remains under the supervision of current trainer Marcus Tregoning. The decision assures that the colt will continue to race in Sheikh Hamdan's colors and will not be turned over to Godolphin. The trainer told the *Racing Post*, "Nayef will go over with Mubtaker and Elsaamri to winter in Dubai and prepare for Dubai World Cup night. Nayef has been put in the Dubai World Cup [2000 meters, dirt] and the Sheema Classic [2400 meters, turf]. I will go out there and supervise them through their training until the end of March. If he is going to run in the World Cup then it would have to be next spring because he is very unlikely to stay in training as a five-year-old."

DETTORI BLINDED BY THE LIGHT Wearing a pair of sunglasses as the result of recent laser eye surgery, jockey Frankie Dettori paid tribute to **Fantastic Light (USA)** (Rahy {USA}), who was voted Horse Of The Year as well as taking the prize for top older horse at the prestigious Cartier Racing Awards at the Four Seasons Hotel in London's West End Wednesday night. The five-year-old Godolphin star, who has now retired to stud, beat off Sakhee (USA), Galileo (Ire), Mozart (Ire) and Banks Hill (Ire) for the Horse Of The Year award. "I'm a lucky so and so to have ridden such a good horse." Dettori said. "He's like a good friend leaving school--everybody goes their own way and unfortunately he's going to have a better life than me right now. I'm very lucky to ride such great horses for a wonderful team like Godolphin." Dettori was also full of praise for the Coolmore team, whose Galileo (Ire) engaged Fantastic Light in two memorable races over the summer. "I would like to say well done to John Magnier and Coolmore for making a good rivalry, which has made each other a better team throughout the world, not just in England," the rider added.

MAGNUS TOPS GOFFS OPENER

Magnus (Fr) (Roakarad {Fr}), a Listed winner on the flat turned Group 1 winner over the jumps, brought a final bid of FF3.5 million to top the opening session of the Goffs (France) Autumn Sale yesterday at Saint-Cloud. The price is the highest ever paid for a national hunt horse in training. The winning bidder was Hubert Barbe, agent for trainer Martin Pipe. Highflyer Bloodstock, the direct underbidder on Magnus, succeeded in securing the second highest-priced horse on the afternoon when they went to FF1.5 million for **Sud Bleu (Fr)** (Pistolet Bleu {Ire}). The three-year-old remains a maiden, but has four top-three finishes from six starts on the flat and one placing from two outings over jumps. Out of G3 Prix Cleopatre winner Sudaka (Fr) (Garde Royale {Ire}), Sud Bleu is a half brother to G3 Prix de Flore winner Moteck (Fr) (Last Tycoon {Ire}) and will go into training with Paul Nicholls. Goffs reported 102 horses sold for a total of FF15,607,000 for an

average of FF153,000. The sale concludes today.

COURTEOUS TO ISLANMORE

The beautifully bred **Courteous (GB)** (Generous {Ire}--Dayanata {Ire}, by Shirley Heights {GB}), a multiple stakes performer, has been retired to stud, having been purchased from Newgate Stud Company in a deal brokered by Natalie Davis of Allan Bloodlines. The six-year-old will join Allan Bloodlines' band of English and Irish based stallions, owned and operated in association with Islanmore Stud of County Limerick where he will be based. Rated at 120 by Timeform, Courteous won the G2 Grand Prix de Deauville and the G3 Classic Trial at Sandown when trained by Paul Cole and he also finished third in the G1 International S. at Woodbine. The son of Generous is out of a full sister to Darshaan (GB) and the G1 filly and dam Darara (Ire). Courteous will stand at an introductory fee of €1,900 (about Ir£1,500) on Oct. 1 terms.

Jockey Richard Hills and his twin brother Michael each recorded a riding double on last night's seven-race program at Nad al Sheba.
