DASHING INTO THE SUNSET

With all eyes focused on a rematch between Breeders' Cup Sprint rivals **Xtra Heat** (Dixieland Heat) and **Caller One** (Phone Trick), it was Breeders' Cup also ran **Delaware Township** (Notebook) charging to the front in deep stretch to win yesterday's GI Frank J. De Francis Memorial Dash at Laurel Park in the final start of his career. Delaware Township won the Sept. 1 GI Forego H. at Saratoga and the Oct. 7 GII Forest Hills H. at Belmont Park before his sixth-place finish in the Sprint. As the gates sprung open at Laurel yesterday, Xtra Heat and Caller One, second and third, respectively, in the Sprint, jumped out to contest the pace through speedy fractions of :21 2/5, :44 1/5 and :56 2/5, while Delaware Township was allowed to settle near the back of the seven-horse field. As Caller One faded, Xtra Heat battled on, but was no match for the late-closing winner. Favored **Kona Gold** (Java Gold), last year's sprint champion, offered little rally and finished fourth.

Snow Dance won the Aug. 20 GII Lake Placid H. at Saratoga and the Sept. 15 GIII Pucker Up at Arlington, before tiring to third after setting the pace in the Oct. 13 GI Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Keeneland last time out. Favored against nine others, the grey filly stalked the early lead of Ever With You (With Approval). She overtook the pacesetter just passed the three-sixteenths pole and held Stylish at bay to the wire for a narrow score. "I let the other filly go and I just tracked her," said winning jockey Craig Perret. "She's versatile and she can run just as easily when she settles." Winning trainer John Ward added, "The good thing about her today was, even though there was a horse on the lead, it wasn't too much for her to lay right off of her. Today, she muscled her way, while in the past she let her speed carry her to the lead. She'll race on the turf in Florida, but we'll also keep California in the mix. We can always get her on a flight out to California for a race."

Jockey Christophe Soumillon took advantage of the same strip of ground down the centre of the track that Inesperado (Fr) used in an earlier Listed event to score aboard Bedawin. Third in the Listed Grand Prix du Lyon at Lyon-Parilly June 23, the five-year-old improved to take the competitive Listed Grand Prix de Deauville Aug. 12 before finishing fifth to Keltos (Fr) in the G3 Prix Perth at Saint-Cloud Nov. 3. Here, he was held up with only one behind early as Isigny (Fr) (Ajdayt {USA}) led at a reasonable pace. Always confident, Soumillon waited to deliver his mount on the outside as they swung into the straight, and despite Bedawin drifting left, he had enough to win the race inside the final 25

yards.

Inesperado benefited from a highly advantageous strip of ground in the centre of the track to spring a 20-1 surprise. Although a consistent sort who has won two races over this course, including a conditions event Sept. 22, he looked exposed when fifth in a similar event over course and distance Oct. 10. Here, he settled in last place early as La Premia (Fr) (Priolo {USA}) cut out the running. Still last turning into the straight, he looked beaten until the leaders began to fade over the testing conditions. Despite drifting right under strong handling, he was able to quicken on the better footing and grabbed the lead with 50 yards remaining to draw away for his first stakes success.

He was very handy during the last three-eighths of the race and had no trouble coming a bit wide." Mr. Pleasantfar will ship back to Florida.

Off since May, Fonz's showed no signs of rustiness to outbattle Popular down the length of the stretch. The Florida-bred chestnut won by four lengths at first asking in a 4 1/2-furlong test at Hollywood May 12 and came back to run a game second, beaten a neck, to the highly regarded Expected Program in the Willard Proctor Memorial S. November 18, 1961...Pimlico...Jockey **Eddie Arcaro** rode the last race of his career, finishing third aboard Endymion in the Pimlico Futurity. He retired with a then-record \$30,039,543 in purses.

November 18, 1972...Two-year-old **Secretariat** capped his Horse of the Year season with a 3 1/2-length victory in the Garden State S. The winner's share of the purse was \$179,199, the most Secretariat ever won in a single race.

November 18, 1979...Jockey **Laffit Pincay Jr.** picked up his 4,000th career victory aboard Gladiolus in the eighth race at Aqueduct.

November 19, 1995...Jockey **Russell Baze** became the first rider to win at least 400 races a year for four consecutive years, riding Royal Boutique to victory at Golden Gate Fields.
