### TIZNOW TO STAND AT WINSTAR

Taylor Made and WinStar Farms yesterday announced that they have purchased an interest in 2000 Horse of the Year Tiznow (Cee's Tizzy--Cee's Song, by Seattle Song). The four-year-old, who ended his racing career with a scintillating victory in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, will take up stud duty at WinStar in Versailles, Kentucky, next season, standing as the property of the Taylor Made/WinStar Venture. Michael Cooper and Cee's Stable, LLC, who raced the colt, will retain an interest. The only horse ever to win two Classics, Tiznow retired after winning eight of his 15 starts, including four Grade Is, and \$6,427,830. "With this deal, we are giving Tiznow every chance to succeed at stud like he did as a racehorse," Cooper said. Added Doug Cauthen of WinStar, "We had a pre-existing relationship with Taylor Made through Kris S. We approached them to come in and work with us to afford Tiznow every opportunity to develop into a leading sire of both sale horses and race horses." He continued, "At WinStar, we are positioning ourselves at the top and a marquis horse like Tiznow fits our program to a T. Tiznow is a great physical specimen, had extraordinary proven racing class and brings much-needed soundness to the breed. In addition, he's a wonderful outcross. We love the In Reality sire line." Duncan Taylor of Taylor Made was also enthusiastic about the new partnership. "We jumped at the opportunity for a horse like this," he said. "He's an awesome-looking horse. Our clients are looking to breed, sell and race the best horses in the world. You can't do anything but love a horse who has won perhaps the world's most prestigious race not once, but twice." Tiznow's stud fee has not yet been set.

Shibuni's Falcon put in a lifetime best effort to win the final Group race of the 2001 European season. This was far from his first try in Group 1 company, but the colt had failed to score beyond the Listed level in the past. Last year, he did manage a respectable fourth in the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club in Milan in October, but he looked rather exposed this term when off the board in a pair of elite events in May and June. He fared little better when fourth in a Listed event in Milan Sept. 23 and again in the G3 Premio Federico Tesio Oct. 6, but woke up in his latest to win a Milan conditions event in sparkling style Oct. 27. He showed the benefit of that confidence booster by setting a strong pace under Mario Esposito on the favoured rail before holding off the challenge of Monos. A jubilant trainer Murizio Guarnieri, enjoying his first Group 1 success, said, "He loves the autumn and this ground and I was expecting him to run well, but to win like that was fantastic. A trip to Dubai for the World Cup meeting could be on his agenda now."

**ALL-STAR CAST IN HONG KONG**

Hong Kong will play host to an array of the best jockeys in Europe, invited to compete in the fourth running of the International Jockeys Championship 2001 (IJC) at Happy Valley Dec. 12. Heading the list is Michael Kinane, who has ridden 116 winners from 1099 mounts during the past eight



seasons in Hong Kong. He captured the G1 Hong Kong Gold Cup on Idol (NZ) last term to add to his wins in the Hong Kong Derby, the Hong Kong International Bowl and Hong Kong International Vase, all Group 1 events. Also on the ticket is Olivier Peslier, who has tasted success in Hong Kong on Docksider (USA) and Borgià (Ger) in 1999, as well as winning the International Jockey's Championship in 1998. Andrasch Starke, winner of the International Jockey's Championship at Happy Valley last December and a seven-times winner from 72 rides during his first Hong Kong stint last season, and Kevin Darby, who rode five winners from 70 rides in Hong Kong during the 1996-97 season, are other notables. Frankie Dettori, representing the United Arab Emirates, is the regular rider of last year's Hong Kong Cup winner Fantastic Light (USA). The Italian-born jockey captured the International Jockey's Championship in 1999 and has recorded wins in the G1 Hong Kong Vase and QEII Cup in 1996 on Luso (GB) and Overbury (Ire) respectively. A total bonus of HK\$300,000 will be awarded to the contestants, with the top points scorer receiving HK\$200,000 and the runner-up receiving HK\$100,000.
