Silky Sweep returned from a 4 1/2-month absence to register a neck victory in Belmont money-allowance company Sept. 28 before finishing a game runner-up to **Yonaguska** in the GIII Sport Page H. on the Breeders' Cup undercard Oct. 27. The five-year-old has turned in a pair of solid maintenance breezes since that effort and should be ready to fire his best shot in the third start of his current cycle. The highweight in the field at 131 pounds, Yonaguska resurfaced from nearly seven months of inactivity to finish third behind Delaware Township in the GII Forest Hills H. Oct. 7 prior to his 1 1/2-length success in the Sport Page. The lone Grade I winner in the race, the sophomore fired a bullet four furlongs in :47 2/5 just five days ago.

A year ago it was Bordelaise who sprung the upset over Breeders' Cup Distaff winner Spain in this race and **Printemps** has a solid chance to be this year's surprise. A multiple Group 1 winner on the dirt in her native Chile, the chestnut was victorious in her first two U.S. outings, including the GII Hawthorne H. May 6. Rested off that effort, the four-year-old came from well off the pace to finish an excellent third in the GI Spinster S. at Keeneland Oct. 7. Regular rider Chris McCarron is in for the ride. **Unbridled Elaine** finished second to Macho Uno in the GIII Pennsylvania Derby before checking in a wide fourth behind **Miss Linda** in the Spinster. The gray filly endured a tough trip in the Breeders' Cup Distaff, checking off heels at the head of the stretch, before running down **Spain** in the final jump.

UNCERTAINTY IN JERSEY A decision handed down by the New Jersey Racing Commission on Tuesday has thrown the future of Thoroughbred racing in New Jersey into a state of confusion. The commission unanimously rejected a request for 125 dates of Thoroughbred racing, a number which falls 16 short of the minimum as required by the New Jersey Off-Track and Account Wagering Act. The New Jersey Sports and Exhibition Authority initially requested 88 dates at Monmouth Park, but that proposal met with resistance from New Jersey horsemen, who were reluctant to accept six-day-a-week racing beginning July 21 through the end of the meet. Those dates are in direct competition with the Saratoga meeting. A revised 72-day meeting at Monmouth from Memorial Day to Labor Day, the traditional schedule at the Oceanport oval, was rejected by the NJRC while a request for a 53-day fall stint at The Meadowlands was dropped by the NJSEA. The commission has set a deadline of December 20 to conclude an agreement for both tracks. Barring an agreement, simulcasting could be halted at Monmouth as of January 1.

Cantkeepfromsingin returned from two-month absence to finish third in a pair of Monmouth allowance tests Aug. 17 and 31 before registering a 4 1/2-length win in a Delaware optional claiming event taken off the turf Sept. 26. The dark bay was most recently the 1/2-length winner of a Meadowlands turf sprint Oct. 9, but was nonetheless the longest shot in this field of four. Restrained just off the early pace, the homebred raced three wide at the quarter pole, was hooked by Look of the Lynx with a furlong to run, but dug in and spurted clear.
