GOING THE EXTRA MILE

Volponi (Cryptoclearance), winner of a Belmont allowance at eight furlongs Oct. 6 before a 2 3/4-length triumph in the Oct. 19 GII Pegasus H. at the Meadowlands last time out, looks for his third consecutive victory in today's GI Cigar Mile at Aqueduct. But his Hall of Fame conditioner is concerned that the three-year-old might need more ground to be at his best. "I think he prefers two turns," conceded trainer P.G. Johnson. "I just hope he's as good at one mile."

Left Bank (French Deputy), who has been at his strongest when sprinting, was second behind Delaware Township in the GI Forego H. in September, then returned to take the Sept. 22 GI Vosburgh H., both at seven furlongs. The four-year-old finished well to be fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint in his last trip to the post. "He should be forwardly placed going a mile," said trainer Todd Pletcher, who also saddles **Graeme Hall** (Dehere) in the race. "At one turn, it plays like a long sprint." Since returning from a four-month freshening, Graeme Hall took a Belmont allowance by six lengths Oct. 7 and then romped home by 6 1/4 lengths in the GIII Stuyvesant H. on the Breeders' Cup undercard. "He's proven he's a quality horse and his last two races are very good," said Pletcher. "He's probably better at a mile and a sixteenth or a mile and an eighth than he is at a mile, but the Belmont races were around one turn and so is the Cigar."

TURNING JAPANESE

The fields for today's G1 Japan Cup Dirt and tomorrow's G1 Japan Cup were drawn Thursday, with a total of 31 international runners tossing their names in the hat. Heading the Japan Cup Dirt is Chilean-born and American raced **Lido Palace (Chi)** (Rich Man's Gold), trained by Bobby Frankel. The colt bids for a third consecutive victory after taking the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga July 28 and the GI Woodward S. at Belmont Park Sept. 8. "He is in really great shape," Frankel said after watching the chestnut gallop over Tokyo's main track Thursday. "The dirt track here is not much different than the one at Belmont, so he should be able to handle it. I think he'll run up to our expectations." Local hopes rest on the shoulders of **Kurofune** (French Deputy), a solid miler who stretched out to be a decent fifth in the 2400-meter Japanese Derby on the grass. The gray tried dirt for the first time in his latest, the G3 Musashino S., and set a track record of 1:33.3 for the eight furlongs. It could be history in the making in the Japan Cup, with last year's Japanese Horse of the Year **T.M. Opera O (Jpn)** (Opera House {GB}) looking to become the first horse ever to successfully defend his title in the race. He faces G1 2000 Guineas winner **Golan (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}), who will be retired after the race, American Grade I winners **With Anticipation** (Relaunch) and **Timbrooa (GB)** (Salse), and fellow home-team member **To The Victory (Jpn)** (Sunday Silence), who was the runner-up in the G1 Dubai World Cup in March and came back to win the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup Nov. 11. Manndar (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}--Madiriya {Ire}, by Diesis {GB}), who suffered a fractured left sesamoid during a workout at Hollywood Park Nov. 15, is recovering from Monday's surgery. "So far, he's doing well," said trainer Beau Greely. "Dr. Wayne McIlwraith performed the surgery at the Equine Medical Center at Los Alamitos. They put six screws in during a three-hour surgery. He could be back here in a few days if he continues to progress this well. Then, I would have to start looking for a place for him to stand at stud, probably in England, Ireland or France." VAHORIMIX TO VAL HENRY One of the luckiest horses this past season, three-year-old **Vahorimix (Fr)** (Linamix {Fr}--Vadsa Honor {Fr}, by Highest Honor {Fr}) has been retired and will enter stud alongside his sire at owner-breeder Jean-Luc Lagardere's Haras du Val Henry in Normandy, France. His fee has been set at €7,000, Oct. 1 terms. Trained by Andre Fabre, the French-bred grey was awarded a victory in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp after Noverre (USA) was disqualified due to a medication positive and backed into another laurel when Proudswings (Ger) altered course in Deauville's G1 Prix Jacques Le Marois. On his own merits, Vahorimix finished second to Okawango (USA) in the G3 Prix La Rochette as a two-year-old and won the Listed Prix Matchem in April. In his final career start, he finished fifth in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot Sept. 29. His career record stands at 9-4-1-0 with converted earnings of \$414,444. Vahorimix is from the same family as GI Breeders' Cup Mile hero Val Royal (Fr); the two share the same second dam, Vadsa (USA) (Halo {USA}).

KIRSTEN RAUSING TO HEAD NATIONAL STUD BOARD

Kirsten Rausing has been re-appointed as a director of the National Stud, Newmarket, by the Horserace Betting Levy Board (HBLB) for a second three-year term. The owner and manager of Lanwades and St Simon Studs in Newmarket was first appointed to the National Stud Board in August 1998. The National Stud has been the responsibility of a board of directors appointed by the HBLB since 1986. The chairman is Peter Player and the other directors are John Dunlop, James Wigan, Geoff Howard-Spink and Peter Stanley. Among the stud's stallions for the 2002 breeding season are Bahamian Bounty (GB), Golden Snake (USA), Mutamam (GB), Silver Patriarch (Ire) and Handsome Ridge (Ire).

The next significant launch period will focus on the attheraces live interactive digital television channel, which will be initially available on Sky Digital in May 2002.

LAST DAY FOR DETTORI'S BRITISH SEASON

Jockey Frankie Dettori bids farewell for the year to British racegoers when he has his final three rides of the season at Lingfield today. He partners Border Arrow (GB) in the day's feature event, the Listed Gallagher Group Churchill S., and supplements that with rides aboard Uproar (GB) and April Stock (GB). Dettori, who has ridden 96 winners this season, will not remain in Britain to try and achieve his century. His agent Ray Cochrane told *Racing Post*: "He won't be staying here. He's had 17 Group 1 winners this year, which I think is quite sufficient. It's his last day in England, then he goes to Mauritius and then Hong Kong. He'll be going to Dubai in February after a month off in January. He'll be riding in the international jockeys' challenge for the first time in Mauritius."

Third on his debut at Salisbury Oct. 3, King Solomon went one better when second at York Oct. 12 and broke his maiden next out in a mile conditions event at Maisons-Laffitte Nov. 2. Renewing his association with a metropolitan French track here, the British challenger displayed a willing determination to secure his first stakes success. Yatsuhashi (Octagonal {NZ}) set a steady pace with King Solomon close up in second. The latter made his bid from the quarter-mile pole and was ridden to the outright lead approaching the final furlong. Challenges were mounted on all fronts, most notably from Begueule on the wide outside, but jockey Christophe Soumillon extracted one final effort from his mount and King Solomon gave a positive response close home to ensure victory.

Second in last season's G2 Prix Foy at Longchamp, Crillon enjoyed a consistent campaign with placings in three further stakes races. This year has been something of a different story with no wins from four starts in lesser company. He returned to his old form here and secured a first stakes win with a determined effort. Jockey Davy Bonilla employed patient tactics in fifth as the British raiders Yorkshire (Generous {Ire}) and Give Notice raced prominently throughout, leading their opponents in single file. Yorkshire's lead was eroded by the time the field entered the straight where Give Notice made his bid for success. It was not to be however as Bonilla timed his challenge to perfection, getting into contention at the eighth pole and driving Crillon forward to assert inside the last 100 yards.

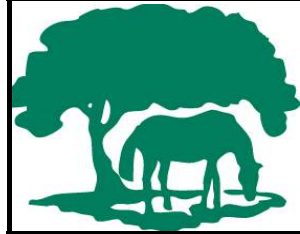

"I think a mile and an eighth should help," trainer Mark Hennig said of Monthir. "With the Nashua under his belt, he's become more serious and he's training much more aggressively." Listen Here took his record to three-for-three while winning his stakes debut in the Nashua. "We're giving him a test to see if he can go this far against a nice group of horses," trainer Bill Mott commented. "He's a very intelligent horse and he seems to have a very good disposition." **Saarland** finished fourth in the Oct. 6 GI Champagne S., despite stumbling badly at the start in just his third outing. He finished eighth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. "We were disappointed in the Breeders' Cup, but he wasn't beat that far--only 5 3/4 lengths," said trainer Shug McGaughey. "I'm interested in running him two turns. The farther the better for him."
