FOREIGN FLAVOR SPICES UP JAPAN CUP

An internationally flavored field of 15 has been assembled for this afternoon's 21st G1 Japan Cup at Tokyo Racecourse. **Golan (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}) rates a solid chance to upset the home defense of last year's champion **T.M. Opera O (Jpn)** (Opera House {GB}) and runner-up **Meisho Doto (Ire)** (Bigstone {Ire}). The 11-1 winner of the G1 2000 Guineas on his seasonal debut May 5, Golan finished second and third to Galileo in the G1 Epsom and Irish Derbies, respectively. He returned from a 10-week absence to annex the G2 Prix Niel Sept. 16 and was most recently a solid fourth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. Finishing behind him in fifth that Oct. 7 afternoon in Paris was Milan, who subsequently finished runner-up to Fantastic Light in the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf in his next start. Reigning Japanese horse of the year T.M. Opera O has been less spectacular this year than he was last year, when he posted an unbeaten record in eight starts. The five-year-old has made just five trips to the post in 2001, with a half-length win over Meisho Doto in the G1 Tenno Sho (Spring) Apr. 29 and a victory by disqualification in the G2 Kyoto Daishoten, when Stay Gold (Jpn) (Sunday Silence) was demoted to last for causing a rival to fall. The chestnut was most recently second in the G1 Tenno Sho (Autumn) over this turf Oct. 28. From the American contingent, **With Anticipation** (Re-launch) rates a strong chance. He won the G1 Sword Dancer at Saratoga in August and the G1 Man o'War at Belmont in September, but faltered to finish seventh in the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf. He will look to set the pace and hang on late. Bobby Frankel sends out **Timboroa (GB)** (Sabe), who won the G1 Turf Classic before finishing third in the Breeders' Cup Turf. **Japan Cup field p. 2**

yesterday's G1 Cigar Mile at Aqueduct, provided the second big win of the day for his sire French Deputy, who was also represented by G1 Japan Cup Dirt winner Kurofune (see page 2). Fifth in the Cigar Mile last year, Left Bank got his first Grade I win two back in the Vosburgh at Belmont Sept. 22, then finished well to be fifth, beaten only 2 1/2 lengths in the G1 Breeders' Cup Sprint Oct. 27. Sent off the favorite, Left Bank was quick out of the gate and engaged **Affirmed Success** (Affirmed) in a speed duel right from the start. He drew away from that one when roused on the far turn and took a commanding 2 1/2-length lead into the stretch. **Graeme Hall** (Dehere) chased the winner home valiantly, but was unable to make up any ground as Left Bank drew off to win easily. The final time was the third fastest Cigar Mile in history. Last year's Preakness winner **Red Bullet** (Unbridled), who bobbed at the start and came from the back of the pack, closed well and just missed completing the exacta. Affirmed Success, worn out on the front end, faded to finish fifth. "I thought the horse was doing really well," said winning trainer Todd Pletcher, who saddled the top two here and won the GII Dan Patch with Smokin' Frolic. "This time last year, he had the reputation of running giant against allowance horses, but not running that well when he stepped up against better horses. He has matured a bit physically and mentally." Winning jockey John Velazquez added, "When I set him down, he really responded and took off. Todd has done a great job of keeping this horse together." Kinsman Stable & Team Vabir's **Illusioned** (Woodman), winner of the GIII Ack Ack H. at Churchill last time, broke down in the stretch and was pulled up. Aqueduct track veterinarian Dr. Neil Clary reported that the three-year-old colt appeared to have fractured both sesamoids in his right front leg. FIXTURE LIST DISCUSSED

The British Horse racing Board (BHB) and the attheraces consortium have held preliminary discussions which may lead to possible changes in Britain's fixture list. The attheraces consortium, Arena Leisure, BSkyB and Channel 4, have suggested that start times for race meetings during the summer could be staggered. Paul Greeves, BHB Director of Racing, told *Racing Post*: "The Attheraces team, headed by Chris Stoddart introduced the thought at the preliminary meeting that we attended with representatives from the racecourses. At the moment, they are refining their thoughts. It has been explained to them that BHB must obviously look at the request in context of maintaining competitiveness of the race program. So if they are asking us to stage extra fixtures we'll certainly consider it, but we can't expand the fixture program in a way that will undermine competitiveness. To produce the changes to the fixture list that Attheraces are suggesting would mean discussions with the Levy Board to change the fixture criteria which they are funding. At this stage they have indicated in a very preliminary meeting what they have in mind, but their request does have implications in other parts of the industry."

 The Aidan O'Brien-trained Galileo (Ire) (Sadler's Wells {USA}) has been voted Flat horse-of-the-year by users of sportinglife.com. Galileo was successful in both the G1 Epsom and G1 Irish Derbies before beating Fantastic Light (USA) (Rahy {USA}) in an epic duel for the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot in July. He lost his unbeaten record when Fantastic Light gained revenge in the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown and finished unplaced behind Tiznow (USA) in the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic, his final career start. Galileo secured 30% of votes, 3 percent more than runner up Sakhee (USA) (Bahri {USA}). Fantastic Light finished third at 19 percent and Johannesburg (USA) (Hennessy {USA}) was fourth with 16 percent of the votes.

Off well from the fourth post position, the gray filly was allowed to set a leisurely pace of :24 1/5 and :48 3/5 and opened up a six-length lead entering the stretch. The favorite was never seriously challenged en route to a 4 1/2-length tally. Lady Shari, winner of the GIMazarine at Woodbine two back, stumbled at the start but rallied late to get up for second. "The last thing I said to Johnny [Velazquez] was that if you found yourself on the lead that it's okay," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "I always had a feeling she would stretch out, even though most people saw Smoke Glacken and thought she would just be a sprinter. We'll probably take her down to Florida with the idea of freshening her up and the Kentucky Oaks would be the obvious major goal."

Hirsch H. and GII Palm ar H. at DelMar earlier this summer and was second to Janet (GB) in the G1 Yellow Ribbon prior to her Breeders' Cup effort.

The bay returned with a vengeance to be up in the final jump of the GI Secretariat S. at Arlington Aug. 18, but was most recently a disappointing sixth in the GII Oak Tree Derby Oct. 13.

DELAWARE TOWNSHIP HEADED HOME TO FLORIDA Satish Sanan's Padua Stables have purchased an interest in New Farm's multiple Grade I stakes winner **Delaware Township** (Notebook--Sunny Minosa, by Sunny North) and will stand the Florida-bred at the Padua breeding operation in Summerfield, Florida. The five-year-old won 11 of 21 starts and earned \$996,950 while under the care of trainer Ben Perkins, Jr. He earned his first Grade I win in the Forego H. at Saratoga Sept. 1 and followed that up with a victory in the GII Forest Hills for the second year in a row. Sixth, beaten only 2 3/4 lengths in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, the chestnut rebounded to finish off his career with a three-length score in the GI DeFrancis Memorial Dash. He will stand the 2002 breeding season for a fee of \$6,500 live foal.

BROODMARE SESSION BEGINS AT GOFFS There was a solid, if unspectacular start to the first day of the Broodmares and Fillies Sale at Goffs yesterday. It was no surprise that Kevin O'Brien had to go to £90,000 to secure the top priced filly **Dafariyna** (ire), who was consigned by Giltown Stud. Brian Grassick won the battle for **Ghassak** (ire), paying £86,000 to secure the full sister to **Kooyonga** (ire). The winning daughter of **Persian Bold** (ire) is already the dam of a winner and is currently in foal to **Intikhab**. While 11 more horses were sold this year than in the corresponding session last year, the gross receipts were down 18.2 percent and the average was down 23 percent. The sale continues today in County Kildare at 10 a.m.
