### WELCOME TO THE JUNGLE

Despite a qualified cast of international participants, Japanese horses swept the top five spots in yesterday's G1 Japan Cup at Tokyo Racecourse, with this year's G1 Japanese Derby winner **Jungle Pocket (Jpn)** (Tony Bin {Ire}) taking top honors. Jungle Pocket became only the second three-year-old to complete a Japan Derby-Japan Cup double by making a furious closing run under jockey Olivier Peslier to catch reigning Japan Cup champion **T.M. Opera O (Jpn)** (Opera House {GB}) in the final stages and win by a neck. The first homebred sophomore to win a Japan Cup, Jungle Pocket won two of three starts as a juvenile, including the G3 Sapporo Sansai S. He won the Feb. 4 G3 Kyodo News Service Hai S. to kick off his sophomore campaign and, after running third in the G1 Japanese 2000 Guineas, annexed the Japanese Derby May 27. Given nearly three months off, he returned a disappointing third as the 3-10 favorite in the G2 Sapporo Kinen Aug. 19 and was equally disappointing when fourth in the G1 Kikuka Sho (Japanese St. Leger) Oct. 21.

### TATTERSALLS DECEMBER SALES BEGIN

Tattersalls' largest and most historic fixture, the December Sales, begin in Newmarket today with a day of yearlings. There are 195 catalogued, the smallest number for 11 years, including many who have missed engagements at yearling sales earlier in the autumn. Sadler's Wells has three entries including Lot 107, offered by John Troy as agent, a Houghton withdrawal out of Group 1 winner Infamy (Ire), dam of four black-type performers to date. Her 1999 yearling realised 300,000 guineas. Lot 108, a Darshaan (GB) colt offered from Floors Stud, put in an appearance at the Houghton Sale, but was bought in for 100,000gns. Others to watch include Lot 144, a Rainbow Quest half-sister to the leading stayer Persian Punch (Ire); the filly's Singspiel (Ire) half-brother made 800,000gns as a yearling last year. Lot 141 is a colt by King Of Kings (Ire), one of several U.S.-based stallions represented. Out of Honor To Her (Sir Ivor), he was unsold at \$100,000 at Keeneland in September. "The December Yearling Sale has always been a source of high-class winners and never more so than this year, with Group 1 victors Summoner (GB) and Timboroa (GB)," Jimmy George, Tattersalls' marketing manager, said. "This year's catalogue would compare favourably with any of its predecessors." The December Sales continue Wednesday with the foal section which runs through Saturday; the breeding stock section begins Monday and concludes the following Thursday.

### SPOOK EXPRESS EUTHANIZED

GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare runner-up **Spook Express (Saf)** (Comic Blush) suffered a "complete compound luxation of her left fetlock" and had to be euthanized following the running of yesterday's GI Matriarch S. at Hollywood Park. Jockey Mike Smith, who had the mount on the seven-year-old, tried to explain the incident. "She just hit some loose ground," he said. "She just hit it funny. She was struggling over the course early, but it wasn't unsafe. These animals are very big and when they step funny, sometimes something goes, and that's what seemed to happen." A treble Group 1 winner in South Africa, the bay scored her most important U.S. victory when winning the GI WinStar Galaxy S. at Keeneland this past October.

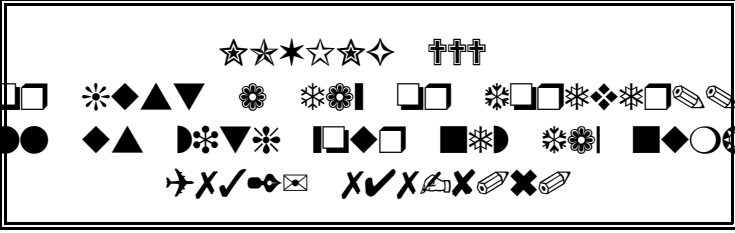
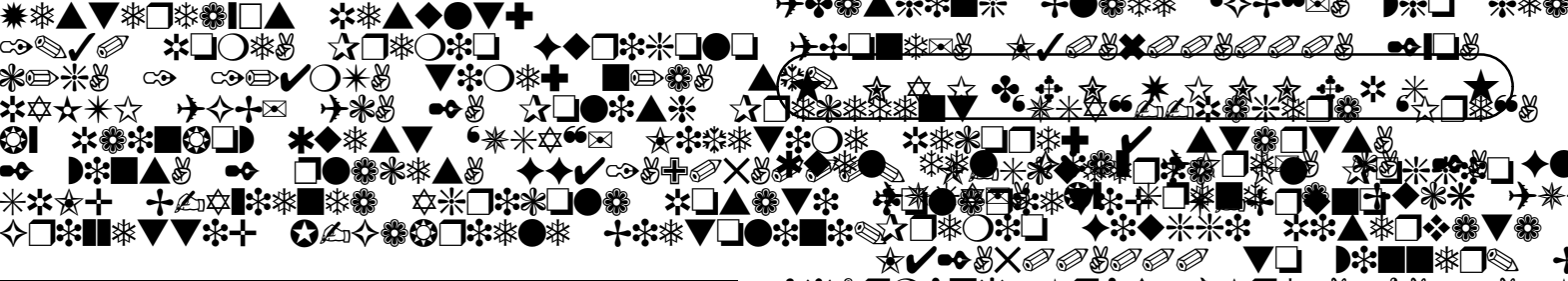
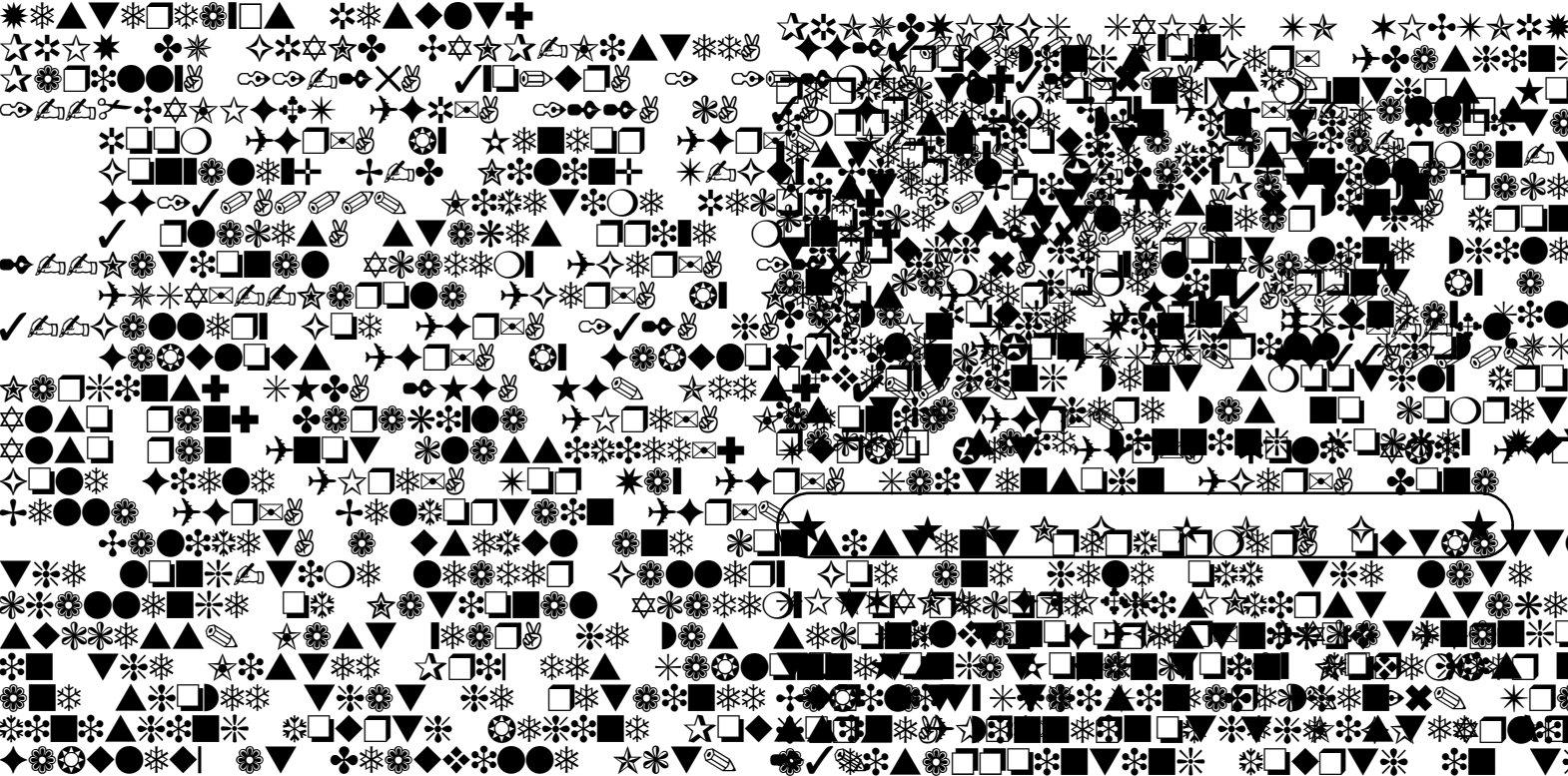

### MIXED RESULTS FOR CHURCHILL FALL

**MEET** Churchill Downs concluded its 24-day Fall Meet Saturday with record numbers for total wagering and an increase in on-track attendance, but average on-track handle showed a decline of more than six percent from last year's totals. Alex Waldrop, president of Churchill Downs, was pleased with the meet, which was run during the aftermath of the national terrorism crisis. "We entered our Fall Meet with uncertainty because of world events and a slumping economy," said Waldrop. "So there is no doubt that the meet was a great success and its results are very encouraging. The decrease in on-track wagering is a concern, but the biggest success story of the meet is the strength of our racing program, which is underscored by continued strong growth in simulcast wagering on our races across North America." Churchill's popularity as a simulcast product fueled a record handle of \$174.4 million, up nearly nine percent over last year's record. Average daily purses paid during the meet totaled \$404,959, a climb of one percent over last year's average (excluding Breeders' Cup day). Trainer Steve Asmussen earned his first Churchill trainer title with 13 wins. Pat Day won his 31st riding crown with 32 wins. Craig Perret gets credit for making the most of his mounts, winning four graded stakes out of six victories.

**Blazing Fury** (Dynaformer), winner earlier this season of the GIII Saranac H. at Saratoga, will make his next start in the GI Hollywood Turf Cup this coming Saturday, trainer Jimmy Toner announced yesterday. The gray was sidelined in June after a hairline fracture in his right knee was discovered following his third-place finish in the GI Belmont S. and returned to light training in early October. Ward sent the colt out for his first official breeze at Keeneland Nov. 17 when he covered a half mile in a bullet :47 4/5. 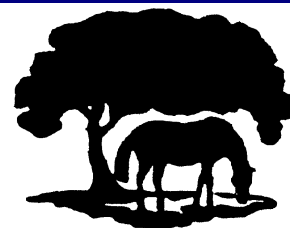

Starine stalked the early pace of Crystal Music before taking over in upper stretch en route to an easy victory in the GI Matriarch S., a race which was marred by a catastrophic injury to GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf runner-up Spook Express (SAf) (Comic Blush). Starine, a Listed winner in France, was second in the GIII Gallorette H. at Pimlico May 18 and fifth in the GIII Just A Game Breeders' Cup H. at Belmont June 9 before getting a rest. She returned two months later to register back-to-back wins, showing a remarkable turn of foot to take the GII Diana H. at Saratoga Sept. 5, but was third in the GI Flower Bowl S. and 10th in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf in her most recent outing Oct. 27. Settled just off a leisurely pace, the gray filly surged to the lead with more than a furlong to run and was never menaced thereafter. The win was the 15th in a Grade I for trainer Bobby Frankel in 2001. "I thought the soft turf would help her," the conditioner said. "There was no pace in the race. I told [jockey John Velazquez], 'Don't fight with her.' He said he was going to come away from there, not move on her and let her be where she's gonna be. I pretty much left it up to him." Added Velazquez, who was winning his fourth graded-stakes of the weekend, "I had a perfect trip. She broke good, was lying second and she settled beautifully. I asked her and she responded. She made it look really easy."

Nicholls said of the mare, who is also in foal to Fasliyev, "She is for a two-man partnership and she has a fantastic page. She will stay in Ireland and may be sent to Mozart (Ire)." An hour earlier, Italian-based Leonardo Ciampoli went to £150,000 for **Theano (Ire)** (Thatching {Ire}), in foal to Grand Lodge, from the draft of Longfield Stud, agent. Ciampoli, who has approximately 40 mares, will leave his purchase at Gallow Paddocks in Co. Meath.

**POCKET ROCKETS TO WIN** Despite his performance in the Japanese St. Leger, **Jungle Pocket** (Tony Bin {Ire})'s connections decided that a crack at the Japan Cup was warranted because of the colt's affinity for Tokyo Racecourse. "He recovered well from his last race," said trainer Sakae Watanabe. "We thought that he would have a good chance here." Jockey Olivier Peslier, who was riding the horse for the first time and winning his first Japan Cup, said, "All I have to say is that the horse was excellent. I was always watching T.M. Opera O, but my colt really gave a fight." Owner Yomoji Saito indicated that the colt would remain in training next year and may look for races in Europe after he runs in the Tenno Sho at Nakayama in the spring. Of the foreign contingent, **Golan (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}) finished the best, placing sixth, five lengths behind the winner after racing evenly throughout. Of the American horses, **White Heart (GB)** (Green Desert) hugged the rail throughout and made a mild late run to finish eighth, beaten just over six lengths. **With Anticipation** (Relaunch), who was on the pace from the outset, took the lead at the fourth corner, but faded late to place ninth. **Cagney (Brz)** (Roy) finished 12th and **Timboroa (GB)** (Salse) finished last. It was reported that With Anticipation, White Heart and 13th-place finisher **Paolini (Ger)** (Lando {Ger}) will be shipped to Hong Kong and run in the G1 Hong Kong Vase Dec. 16. The 115,196 fans in attendance at Tokyo Racecourse Saturday afternoon bet over ¥25 billion on the race.
