## HEADLINE NEWS

### MORE RECORDS AT TATTERSALLS DECEMBER

The final day of the Tattersalls December Foal Sales saw no let up in the incredible trade which has marked the sale, ensuring that the 2001 renewal finished with a record average of 26,400 guineas, up 10 percent on last year. Although the catalogue seemed to lack some of the better lots seen at previous renewals and was 14 percent smaller than 12 months ago, the turnover was just 8 percent short of the 2000 figure. Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony said, "The December Yearling Sale got the week off to a bright start with a record average, and the Foal Sale has also defied the prevailing trends by following suit. As well as the record average, the turnover from a smaller catalogue has been only fractionally lower than at last year's record-breaking sale and the sustained demand throughout the week has definitely exceeded expectations. Competition at the top has been as fierce as ever, but the real feature of the sale has been the remarkable strength of the market at the 20,000- to 50,000-guineas level. Overall, we felt that the catalogue was not quite as strong as some of its predecessors, but the vendors have certainly been rewarded, with six foals making more than last year's 230,000 guineas sale topper and 60 making 50,000 guineas or more." Owner Colin Davey, who had been underbidder on the 1.1 million guineas sister to Galileo (Ire) Friday, bought yesterday's top lot, a Desert Prince (Ire) (Green Desert) colt out of a half-sister to the stallion Desert Style (Ire), offered from Ballybin Stud. Agent Richard Frisby signed for the colt on Davey's behalf, having outlasted Adrian Nicoll of BBA Ireland at 240,000gns. "He will go to Cliff Stud and we will decide next year whether to resell him or put him into training with Henry Cecil," said Frisby. Coolmore's Paul Shanahan, acting as Ashtown Bloodstock, signed for a 205,000gns first-crop filly by Fasliyev (Nureyev) out of a half-sister to G1 Epsom Derby winner Dr Devious (Ire) sent up from Tom Gaffney's Churchtown House Stud. Peter Doyle, agent for Cathal Ryan's Swordlestown Stud, bought a 200,000gns Grand Lodge (Chief's Crown) filly. Consigned by Oak Lodge Stud, the bay is closely related to another Derby winner, Sindar (Ire) (Grand Lodge). ### SWEET SEVENTEEN

How sweet it is. **Super Quercus (Fr)** (Hero's Honor), part of a three-horse entry favored at 6-5, charged down the stretch to take yesterday's GI Hollywood Turf Cup by two lengths from fellow French-bred **Bonapartiste (Fr)** (Kendor {Fr}), and in the process gave trainer Bobby Frankel his 17th Grade I win of the season. The victory also marked Frankel's 48th stakes win of the year, and his 35th in graded company. But the Brooklyn native is already worried about 2002. "You can imagine what happens next year when I don't win any races," Frankel said. "I'll be depressed. But everything is good now and we've got a few more to go." Super Quercus could be one of the bullets left in Frankel's Saturday Afternoon Special. The five-year-old, who captured the GI Hollywood Derby two years ago, posted a rallying two-length tally in the Sept. 22 GIII Bay Meadows Breeders' Cup H. last time out and could look to make it three in a row in the GII W. L. McKnight H. at Calder Dec. 29. (More on the Turf Cup, p2)

A consistent performer this season, Bedford Forrest provided the middle part of a German 1-2-3 in the G3 Premio Federico Tesio at Milan Oct. 6 on his most recent start and he confirmed the form of that race here by securing a last gasp win at long odds.

Jockey Andreas Boschert was content to bide his time towards the rear of the field aboard the eventual winner as Cry Risks (Fr) (Take Risks {Fr}) led from Sossus Vlei (GB) (Inchinor {GB}). Bedford Forrest made his move once into the home straight, but came under pressure as Reallier set sail for home at the quarter-mile marker. The German runner responded well to his jockey's urgings and challenged on the outside at the eighth pole. Displaying an ample supply of determination in the closing stages, he stayed on well to deny Execute in the final strides. "He showed good form in his last race in Italy and I thought that was good enough to win the race today," Boschert commented. "The ground is very heavy, but he does need it soft. He gave everything I asked for in the last 200 meters and won well."

### KINANE SET FOR TAMBURLAINE, BACH

Trainer Richard Hannon has booked Michael Kinane to ride G1 2000 Guineas runner-up **Tamburlaine (Ire)** (Royal Academy {USA}) in the Hong Kong Mile at Sha Tin Dec. 16. The three-year-old's regular partner Richard Hughes is recovering from a broken leg. "He is still a very good horse," Hannon. "I think he will give a good account of himself around Sha Tin if we can get a good draw." Kinane will also ride **Bach (Ire)** (Caerleon {USA}) for Aidan O'Brien in the main race on the card, the International Cup. He will need to reverse form with G1 Breeders' Cup Mile conqueror **Val Royal (Fr)** (Royal Academy {USA}), but the extra two furlongs of the Cup should be in his favour. "Bach came back from America in super form and he has been getting better and better throughout the year," trainer Aidan O'Brien. "Mick [Kinane] said his run in the States was his best so far and I think he is more suited to this trip."

### DIAMOND FIRST FOR KING OF KINGS

Many believe the winner of the 2002 Golden Slipper and the Magic Millions juvenile feature in January are among several classy two-year-olds who made their debuts Saturday, but 12-1 chance **Diamond Head (Aus)** (King of Kings {Ire}) wasn't among the pre-race talk at Rosehill. The \$50,000 Inglis Easter graduate, the third starter for her speedy sire, became the first winner for the 1998 G1 2,000 Guineas hero (by Sadler's Wells {USA}). Trainer Ron Quinton was not surprised to see his charge emerge victorious as Diamond Head jumped to the lead, settled second and shot through on the rail to beat **Sunday Joy (Aus)** (Sunday Silence {USA}) by a half-length in the 1100-metre Dux Hot Water H. "All the pre-race hype was on these well-bred horses, but she did not surprise me, I knew she would give her best," Quinton remarked. "When we bought her I thought she would need time, but her rate of improvement since her trial has been quite dramatic, and she ran a second faster in her trial than Very Funny (Aus) (Danehill {USA}) [a full sister to Golden Slipper winner Ha Ha who finished fifth in the race]." Sunday Joy, the A\$1 million sale-topping Magic Millions filly, raced greenly and was caught wide, but quickened effortlessly at her first start and Waterhouse will press on with her to fulfill owner John Singleton's desire to have her racing in the Magic Millions Jan. 12. "Anything she does now is a bonus," said Waterhouse. In the colts' division, **Architrave (Aus)** (Woodman {USA}), a A\$28,000 Inglis Sires' Produce Sale purchase, won the Gainsborough Door Furniture H. (1100 meters) by a half-length, while even-money favourite **Portfolios (Aus)** (Octagonal {NZ}) was third after being shuffled back. "He has always shown a lot of ability and I've had luck with Woodmans--if nobody else wants them I'll take them all," said trainer Gary Portelli, who also prepares G3 Black Opal S. winner Coral Salute (Aus) (Woodman). Woodman has covered big Southern Hemisphere books of outstanding mares, but has failed to live up to lofty expectations, with three stakes winners and a stakes-placed horse among 17 winners from 68 starters. Not bad statistics by any reckoning, but given the quality of mares he covered and his outstanding Northern Hemisphere record, the bar was always set way high for the charismatic son of Mr. Prospector (USA).

### MIDLANTIC DECEMBER SALE STARTS TODAY

The 2001 Fasig-Tipton Midlantic December Mixed Sale, with 691 hips catalogued, starts today at the Maryland State Fairgrounds in Timonium. Today's session offers broodmares, broodmare prospects and stallions, while tomorrow's second and final session includes weanlings, yearlings and horses of racing age. Mares in foal to sires such as Honour and Glory, Jade Hunter, Langfuhr, Louis Quatorze, Not For Love, Polish Numbers and Two Punch will go through the ring. Promising young stallions such as Malibu Moon, Partner's Hero, Unbridled Jet and Victory Gallop will also be represented. Weanling sires include Artax, Captain Bodgit, Clever Trick, Favorite Trick, French Deputy, Honour and Glory, Jade Hunter, Malibu Moon, Not For Love, Open Forum, Silver Deputy, Siphon (Brz), Two Punch and Victory Gallop. Bidding begins at 10 a.m. each day.

**LONE STAR CHANGES DERBY DATE** Lone Star Park officials announced Friday that they have moved the newly upgraded nine-furlong \$500,000 Gill Lone Star Derby from four weeks prior to the Kentucky Derby to one week after. The race will now be run Saturday, May 11 as a lucrative opportunity for horses not quite ready to run for the roses. "The Illinois Derby, which is now run four weeks before the Kentucky Derby, had been carded on this date for many years and was very successful," said Lone Star President and General Manager Corey Johnson. "We hope to fill that void."

**Slots Drive Mountaineer Purses Higher:**

Boosted by the success of slot machines at the track, the purses for overnight races at Mountaineer Park in West Virginia will be increased by an average of 12.7 percent, effective in January. Average daily purse distribution is expected to total \$160,000. In addition, the minimum purse for Mountaineer's 28 stakes races will be \$75,000, with next year's Gill West Virginia Derby to be worth \$600,000.

**Cesare's Petition Denied:**

Trainer Bill Cesare Friday filed an emergency petition with the Third District Court of Florida (Dade County) to have his suspension by Calder Race Course set aside, but had his petition denied. Cesare, a former college and pro football player, was suspended after he was accused of brandishing a gun on the Calder backstretch. He claims in his petition that "the Board of Stewards and Calder have no jurisdiction or authority to suspend a pari-mutuel occupational license under the circumstances of this case..." The Third District Court turned down the petition, but ordered Calder to file a response by noon on Tuesday. Calder President Ken Dunn said, "The court sided with Calder's stewards and management. We didn't suspend his license; we denied him access to the grounds. This is private property and we have that right." Cesare began serving his 60-day suspension Nov. 30.

 The seven-member California State Horse Racing Board Friday gave unanimous approval to regulations that will govern account wagering, known as Advanced Deposit Wagering (ADW), in the state. While ADW betting becomes legal Jan. 1, 2002, it will take at least a month for the regulations to be reviewed by the Office of Administrative Law. Many changes have taken place in the last forty years in our sport of thoroughbreds, many for the good, but some not. One major change of great concern is the presentation of new sires. This concern is the disappointment new members and new breeders to our sport experience speculating on these new unproven sires and the millions of dollars lost every year. This financial loss, plus the discouragement often leads these newcomers, which we so dearly need, to depart from our wonderful sport. Unfortunately, only one in about twenty of these new kids on the street ever becomes a proven, profitable sire, the rest are losers, some real big losers. All the hype and extravagant promotion in the world cannot make them into proven sires, as the records thoroughly indicate.

Al Smith, the crusty old governor of New York, was famous for saying, "Well boys, let's look at the record". When a controversy would arise in the famous political machine known as Tammany Hall, old Al would call the boys to his office, lean back in his chair, take a couple puffs

on his cigar, listen to the problem and then say, "Well boys, let's look at the record". That same wisdom applies to horse breeding. We must consistently look at the record. All the necessary figures are available; they just need to be properly analyzed.

**Records vs. Hype**

Fortunately, thanks to the racing and breeding publications, sires can be evaluated for their worthiness, particularly by the percentage of graded stakes winners they have produced. Another valuable figure is the average earning of the runners of the unproven sires compared to the proven sires; generally a very substantial difference.

How can proven sires like Gone West, Broad Brush or Dynaformer, to name a few, be compared to the "Johnny-Come-Lately" sires in the same price range when the bottom line is producing stakes winners? The proven sires will consistently produce more stakes winners than unproven sires; again, the records are there.

Another detrimental change in the industry is the number of mares being bred to a sire in one year, apparently generated by sheer greed. Percentage figures are so important in determining the worth of a sire, because some are siring so many foals, which results in deceiving figures. And the fact that a horse has accomplished great feats on the track does not necessarily relate to his capacity to project those qualities to his off-spring, particularly if he has out run his pedigree. Again, the records clearly demonstrate this. Danzig, for instance, probably one of the greatest sires of our century, earned \$32,400 on the track, while Mr. Prospector, whose greatness as a sire is unparalleled, earned a mere \$112,171. Both had the genetic background to produce stakes winners year after year after year. They have the quality of genetic makeup that should be incorporated in every breeding program. Rather than be influenced with hype, blue sky and extravagant promotion, it is far better to deal with the facts - as Al Smith would say, "Let's look at the record".

It is also amazing how quickly these horses with great earnings slip into oblivion along with the investment which, again, is clearly demonstrated in the records.

**Super Quercus** started his career in his native country, finishing first or second in all six starts, but he didn't take on graded foes until shipping across the Atlantic. The chestnut made his U.S. bow in the GII Oak Tree Derby in October of 1999, running third, then showed his strong late kick to take the GI Hollywood Derby over Manndar (Ire), but he has been raced sparingly since. "He had some problems and we gave him some time off," trainer Bobby Frankel explained. "We operated on his ankle, and he came back pretty good." Out of action for nearly more than 10 months after the Derby, Super Quercus went winless in three starts last season, then was fourth in an optional claimer at Santa Anita Jan. 4. He went to the sidelines for nearly eight months after that outing, but returned to be third in the GI Eddie Read H. at Del Mar July 28 and followed that effort with a third-place finish in the Aug. 25 GII Del Mar H. going 1 3/8 miles prior to his Bay Meadows success. He was trying a mile and a half for the first time in the Turf Cup. "I was nervous...he'd never run that far," Frankel admitted. "But the way he ran at Del Mar, I thought he could get the distance." Get it, he did. Allowed to trail the field as they ground out a mile and a quarter in 2:05 3/5 over a course labeled good, the winner swept four wide into the stretch and finished full of run to take command late and draw clear. "That's his style," jockey Alex Solis said. "He likes to sit back there and make a run. He was very relaxed the whole way." **Bonapartiste**, let go at 53-1, had to wait for running room at the top of the lane and rallied well once clear to catch **Blazing Fury** (Dynaformer) for second, but was no match for Super Quercus. "He quickened when I asked him and I felt for a second that I was going to get there," jockey Jose Valdivia Jr. said. "Then the winner came flying on the outside." Corey Nakatani felt his mount, three-year-old **Blazing Fury**, had an excuse for his loss. "He just wasn't handling the course, bobbling and struggling around there," Nakatani said of the colt, who was fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf.

Evening Attire was moderately successful as a two-year-old, breaking his maiden by a nose in his second start. After finishing seventh in the GI Hopeful, he ran second in a pair of entry-level allowance races. The gray disappeared for 10 months after the second of those efforts, however, returning to be third behind subsequent Indiana Derby winner Orientate in an allowance race at Saratoga Aug. 11. Off the board in his next two, including a sixth-place finish trying turf and blinkers for the first time two starts back, he came alive at 65-1 in the Oct. 31 GIII Discovery H., rallying up the inside to beat favored Street Cry by a length. A little less of a dark horse while taking on older horses this time, the three-year-old stalked the pace while riding the rail to the top of the stretch, found his way to the outside for the final drive and kicked past odds-on favorite Balto Star for his second straight stakes win. "To beat older horses is always good, but at this time of year, three-year-olds that are getting good have a big shot," trainer Pat Kelly said. "I'm glad he ran back to his last race." The free-running Balto Star tried new tactics here, sitting second through the opening six furlongs and grabbing the lead in the stretch before being outfinished by the winner. "I didn't want to see him get in a speed duel situation," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "He was just outrun from the sixteenth pole to the wire." Both the winner and the runner-up could go next in the Jan. 19 GIII Aqueduct H.
