TATTERSALLS BREEDING STOCK SALE OPENS

The annual Breeding Stock section of the Tattersalls December Sales, which begins at 9:30 a.m. today, attracts buyers from around the globe and has provided the foundation for many great breeding empires. Many of the world's top breeders are consigning surplus stock, including Gerald Leigh of Eydon Hall Farm in Northamptonshire, vendor of last year's 1.7 million guineas top lot Brocatelle (GB), a half-sister to Baratheia (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). Lot 1816 in this year's sale is **Zibeline (GB)** (Rainbow Quest), another half-sister to Baratheia who was covered by Machiavellian. The family has been further boosted this year by the G1 Fillies' Mile win of Baratheia's two-year-old full sister Gossamer (GB). The Niarchos family's Haras de Fresnay-le-Buffard offers an outstanding draft that includes lot 1302, the three-year-old **Swan's Loop (GB)** (Caerleon), a half-sister to G1 winners Johann Quatz (Fr) and Hernando (Fr); Lot 1295, **Pagoda (Fr)** (Sadler's Wells), who is a full-sister to Scenic (Ire); and lot 1651, **Pipalong (Ire)** (Pips Pride {GB}), winner of last year's G1 Haydock Sprint Cup. Lot 1846, **Lydara (Alydar)**, will attract attention as the only offering covered by Sadler's Wells and lot 1916, **Riviere D'Argent (Nijinsky)**, boasts an outstanding family as a daughter of 1981 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner Gold River (Fr) (Riverman). Offered by the Wertheimer brothers, she is now 17 and the dam of five winners. Stallion prospects include Lot 1390, Urban Ocean (Fr) (Bering {GB}), a G3-winning half-brother to Galileo (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). The sale runs through Friday, beginning at 9:30 a.m. each day.

JAPAN WINS WORLD JOCKEY CHAMPIONSHIP

Home team representative Katsuya Samejima won two races and finished third in another to take the World Super Jockeys Series at Hanshin Racecourse in Japan this weekend. Samejima became the first jockey to win the championship in his first attempt. He defeated a stellar field which included second-place finisher Victor Espinoza from the United States, sixth place finisher Edgar Prado from the U.S., and European representatives Michael Kinane (8th) and Kieren Fallon (10th).

EXCLUSIVE: CALLER ONE UPSET

He was the favorite in the 1997 Breeders' Cup Sprint at Hollywood Park. He wasn't the best that day, but four years later **Men's Exclusive** (Exclusive Ribot) is still around. If his performance in winning yesterday's GIII Vernon O. Underwood S. at Hollywood Park is any indication, his best days may be ahead of him. The winner of this event last year, **Men's Exclusive** began his eighth year with a win in the GII Palos Verdes H. at Santa Anita in January. He ran second in the GIII Dubai Golden Shaheen in March, but hadn't been the same since, posting three out-of-the-money finishes, the most recent of which came when he was fourth in the Cal Cup Sprint at Santa Anita Nov. 3. Tracking favored **Caller One** (Phone Trick), who broke on top and set the pace, **Men's Exclusive** ranged up on the outside as they came into the stretch and responded late to take the lead when **Caller One** began to tire. Ridden out to the wire he was never seriously threatened by **Tavasco** (Tabasco Cat), who came flying late for second. "He's a tough old guy," said jockey Laffit Pincay, Jr. "He ran perfect today."

WHAT'S DOING DOWN UNDER

A PREGNANT PAUSE

Boutique breeder Jim Fleming has provoked unprecedented debate among Australia's bloodstock community by announcing he plans to challenge the Australian Stud Book rule preventing him from registering an embryo transfer foal conceived between Sunline's sire Desert Sun (GB) and 19-year-old blue hen mare Eau D'Etoile (NZ). And, intriguingly, Fleming appears to have the overt support of Keeper of the Stud Book John Digby, who has already caused dissent by seeming to lean toward the introduction of artificial insemination. Digby recently published a paper on protocols should AI be allowed.

"I'll be heading to court arguing their decision [to block the registration of the foal] is a restraint of trade...Eau D'Etoile is worth A\$2 million, maybe more, as long as she's producing, that is," Fleming said in the *Daily Telegraph* newspaper.

Fleming, a Sydney Turf Club committeeman and former Aushorse chairman with an enviable band of mares at Tyreel Stud in New South Wales, says common sense should prevail and the filly, transplanted to a surrogate mother and foaled Nov. 17, had passed DNA testing.

Digby said he agreed with Fleming's move to challenge the rule.

"I'm a professional regulator and administrator and I've tried unsuccessfully to have this rule changed," he said.

Eau D'Etoile is the dam of Group 1 winners Bint Marscay (Aus), Filante (NZ) and Kenny's Best Pal (Aus), while her daughters have produced top runners such as Group 1 winner Stella Cadente (Aus). Her last foal was the Gai Waterhouse trained Eau D'scay, a A\$400,000 Inglis Easter purchase in 1998 whose best effort was the Listed Gosford Guineas; and Bint Marscay's \$A850,000 Woodman (USA) colt Sheraton has not quite lived up to the family name either. Eau D'Etoile suffered uterine problems following a caesarian of an especially large foal by Danehill in 1997, and Fleming says although she has successfully conceived since, the embryos have not survived. He said to deny recognition

of the foal would be "living in the dark ages" and prominent veterinarian Angus Mc Kinnon, who assisted, was quoted in the Daily Telegraph saying embryo transfers were "a hidden practice around the world". However, one influential breeder argued there was emerging evidence that while embryo transfer produced a genetically valid foal, the physical type could alter as it was developed in a different environment.

An article in the Blood-Horse quotes Equix Biomechanics founder Paul Mostert: "Studies have shown that mares contribute more to the size of the offspring and that the stallions have more influence on the pattern or body type ... the environment inside the mare clearly has some effect on the size of her progeny. Putting embryos from one mare into another, larger surrogate mare will even change the foal's size somewhat." Thoroughbred Breeders' Victoria President Mike Becker, of the Independent Stallion Station, said in a statement Fleming's embryo transfer while aware of the stud book rule was "arrogant" and "inflammatory" and had "insulted" the industry. He said an industry not noted for rapid change was grappling with issues presented by modern technology.

"Mr Fleming has decided that his mare is worthy to be allowed to have foals by embryo transfer but who made him the umpire in deciding that? Where will a line be drawn on deciding qualifying mares - if at all?," Becker said. "Who says Mr Fleming will not decide to breed several foals by this method each year from this mare? The technology is available for this to happen." Becker said he was disappointed McKinnon had supported Fleming: "He has shown a blatant disregard of the industry which has given him his business and reputation by his actions which now force the industry into an invidious position of having to make knee-jerk responses to this threat of legal action."

Pregnancy and racing are indeed in the news, with the Australian Racing Board likely to act on legal advice and ban female jockeys from riding past their first trimester, although the NSW Jockeys' Association will argue women should be allowed to ride to six months. NSW Jockeys' Association President Lee Ann Olsen, who rode in the early stages of her pregnancy, said the decision should be individual. "We aren't totally crazy and we aren't going to put our babies at risk," she said.

START The opening day of the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic December Mixed Sale took place yesterday with a session of mares. The seven-year-old mare **Buckles and Kinks** (Waquoit--Rolling Mill, by Hagley) topped the proceedings when she brought a final bid of \$90,000 from Edward Schuler. Sold in foal to Breeders' Cup Classic winner Concern, the dark bay was consigned to the sale by Walnut Green, agent for the estate of Nancy L. Bayard. Based on the same number of horses reported as sold, both the gross receipts and average were ahead of last year's totals by 4.3 percent. The sale concludes today with a session of weanlings set to begin at 10 a.m. at the Maryland State Fairgrounds in Timonium.

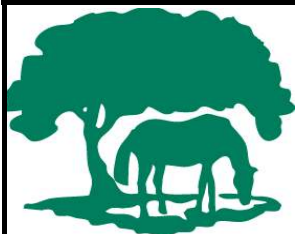
