THE CUP RUNNETH OVER

Fourteen horses will go after the winner's share of the purse in Sunday's HK\$18 million Hong Kong International Cup, with GI Arlington Million hero **Silvano (Ger)** (Lomitas {GB}) getting the far outside post in the 2000-meter test. But jockey Andreas Suborics was unconcerned about the draw. "It makes no difference," Suborics said. "The horse won the [G1 Audemars Piguet QE II Cup at Sha Tin in April] from the 13." He added, "I could not be happier with him. Seriously, this horse is feeling fantastic." The five-year-old was fifth in the 2400-meter Hong Kong International Vase last year, but has fared much better since shortening in distance. Still, he will have his work cut out for him facing the likes of **Jim and Tonic (Fr)** (Double Bed {Fr}). The seven-year-old has raced at Sha Tin six times before, finishing in the frame in every start. The winner of the Cup in 1999, the consistent chestnut was third behind Fantastic Light last year. He will come away from post 5. "That's tight enough for him, but he's drawn everywhere in his runs here in Hong Kong and always performed well," trainer Francois Doumen said. "He's happy to be back--he really seems to love it here."

ONE LAST CHANCE AT GOLD

Stay Gold (Jpn) (Sunday Silence), who has yet to win a Group 1 race, will have his last chance in the G1 Hong Kong International Vase at 2400 meters. The seven-year-old, who handed Fantastic Light a nose defeat in the G2 Dubai Sheema Classic in March, was fourth in the Nov. 25 G1 Japan Cup last time out. "This race will be the last of his career before going to stud," owner Haruya Yoshida said, adding, "The track here is very similar to the track in Dubai where he beat Fantastic Light." The likely favorite for the race, Stay Gold will break from the far outside in the field of 14, but Yasutoshi Ikee, the son of trainer Yasuo Ikee, said, "It suits him to be out there with some room." Last year's Vase champion **Daliapour (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) drew post 8, but will have to improve on this year's form, which has seen him finish out of the money in all five appearances. **White Heart (GB)** (Green Desert) will have jockey Gary Stevens in the saddle Sunday, but the Hall of Fame rider stood on the rail as the two-time Grade I winner galloped yesterday. "I had planned to be on him, but the flight I took from California to get here lasted 15 hours," Stevens explained. "I rode in the International Jockeys' Championship at Happy Valley [finishing tied for sixth] last night, and this morning I feel pretty wasted. So an exercise rider was on White Heart instead of me, but it's no big deal. The horse is fit and ready--I think everyone can see that."

AS AMERICAN AS FORBIDDEN APPLE

Forbidden Apple (Pleasant Colony) is the lone U.S. representative in the G1 Hong Kong International Mile. The runner-up in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile last time out, the dark bay has visited Sha Tin once before, running fourth in last year's Cup. He drew post 9. Also looking to improve off last year's International performance is **Electronic Unicorn** (Housebuster), who comes into the Mile on a two-race winning streak. The five-year-old was fifth behind Sunline (NZ) and Fairy King Prawn (Aus) in the 2000 running of the race. But jockey Olivier Peslier, riding Japanese rep **Zenno El Cid (Ire)** (Caerleon), feels ready to pull off the upset. "This is a very strong Japanese team in Hong Kong, but this horse is the best of them," he said.

ANOTHER FANTASTIC AWARD The 6,500 members of the Racehorse Owners' Association (ROA) have awarded **Fantastic Light (USA)** (Rahy {USA}) the Horse of the Year award in favour of **Galileo (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) and **Sakhee (USA)** (Bahri {USA}). The GI Breeders' Cup Turf winner also beat the same rivals when awarded a similar accolade at the recent Cartier Awards. Team Ballydoyle, however, did not leave empty handed as Sue Magnier and Michael Tabor were named jointly as owner of the year. Galileo was named top three-year-old colt, and **Johannesburg (USA)** (Hennessy {USA}) was voted best two-year-old colt. Other award recipients included **Queen's Logic (Ire)** (Grand Lodge {USA}) (2yo filly), **Banks Hill (GB)** (Danehill {USA}) (3yo filly). York scooped the Racecourse of the Year award, confirmation of the same outcome recently reached by members of the Racegoers Club.

NAYEF CANTERS AT NAD AL SHEBA

Nayef (USA) (Gulch {USA}), who closed the 2001 season with four straight victories, including a 3/4-length win in the G1 Dubai Champion S. Oct. 20, got his first taste of Nad al Sheba last night, cantering one lap around the main track. "He had a good look at the lights tonight as well as the crowd and experienced the atmosphere and it will do him well," said his regular rider Richard Hills, who was aboard for the move. "That is about as fast as he has gone so far since he has been here and from what he has shown me, there is no reason why he won't handle the dirt as well as he has handled the turf," he added. Nayef is entered for both the G1 Dubai World Cup as well as the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic on the turf. "The Dubai World Cup is the race we all want to win," Hills continued, "While he will be aimed at that race, Sheikh Hamdan has the final say and we do have a choice between races."

THE RETURN OF A CHAMP

Flight Pattern (Aus) (Manshood {Can}), last year's champion UAE-based sprinter, returned to his winning ways last evening at Nad al Sheba and stamped himself the favorite for the Dhs350,000 Al Shindagha Sprint at 1200 meters over the Nad al Sheba turf course Jan. 3. The six-year-old defeated **Countless (USA)** (Danzig {USA}) by three parts of a length in the Al Shindagha Sprint Prep, covering the six furlongs in 1:11.7. In other news from Thursday night's racing, **Just Call Me (NZ)** (Blues Traveller {Ire}), the top lot at Dhs2 million at the inaugural Pearls of Dubai Sale, returned to the main track to score her first victory from three starts in the 2001/2002 meeting.

DANEHILL SET TO STAR AGAIN IN HONG KONG

He accounted for three of the top five lots during last year's Piaget Hong Kong International Sale and Coolmore's dual hemisphere stallion Danehill looks to steal the show again tonight at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre. The 15-year-old, sire of Hong Kong's most prominent runner in Fairy King Prawn (Aus), accounts for nine of the 38 ready-to-run two-year-olds, which were purchased as yearlings from some of the world's leading auction houses. One of the more expensive offerings in the sale is lot 29, a colt by Danehill--Caraniya (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}) bred on Southern Hemisphere time. The bay, a half brother to Irish multiple Group 3 winner Cajarian (Shahrestani), was purchased for A\$650,000 at this past April's Inglis Easter Sale in Australia. Danehill is also represented by lot 7, a gelding out of Dance Date (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), who was hammered down for Ir£200,000 during the 2000 Goffs Orby Sale. His dam is a full sister to Sonus (Ire), winner of the G3 Goodwood Cup and third in the G1 French St Leger, and a half to Hawaiian Sound, winner of the G1 Benson & Hedges Gold Cup, runner-up in the G1 Epsom Derby and third in the G1 Irish Derby in 1978. A yearling full brother sold for FF4.2 million at this past August's Deauville Sale. Also represented in the catalogue are juveniles by Anabaa, Barathea (Ire), Danehill's son Danasinga (Aus), Grand Lodge, Quiet American, Rahy and Spectrum (Ire). "We are very excited about this year's Hong Kong consignment," said Geoffrey Russell, director of sales at Keeneland, which will conduct the auction. "It is an absolutely splendid collection of two-year-olds and I fully believe the bidding for them will be aggressive." Bidding is set to begin at 5:30 p.m.
