LADIES DAY AT AQUEDUCT

There is only one graded stakes scheduled for North America this weekend, but today's GIII Ladies H. at Aqueduct has drawn a competitive field of 10 fillies and mares. Four-year-old **Irving's Baby** (Quiet American), a graded-stakes winner of \$701,302, is the highweight at 120 pounds, but it is the three-year-old **Summer Colony** (Summer Squall) who been awarded the role of morning-line favorite at 8-5. The dark bay took seven starts to win her first race, but has been unstoppable since. After a 32 3/4-length laughter vs. maidens, the Mark Hennig trainee strolled through her conditions, winning by 9 1/2 lengths at Saratoga Aug. 30, by 8 1/4 lengths at Belmont Sept. 23 and, after a short vacation, by 3 1/4 lengths at Aqueduct Nov. 23. She tries stakes company for the first time, but the 1 1/4-mile distance of the Ladies should not be a problem--Summer Colony's Belmont allowance score came at 1 3/8 miles. Irving's Baby also is suited to the route, with a record of four wins and a third in five starts at 10 furlongs. The bay captured the July 22 GIII Delaware H. and the off-the-turf Aug. 10 GIII Glens Falls H., then finished third in the Aug. 24 GI Personal Ensign H., all at that distance. She has not been out since being eased during the stretch run of the Oct. 6 GI Beldame S., but has worked steadily for her return. **Strolling Belle** (Strolling Along), who won the Ladies in 1999, crossed the finish line second last year, but was bumped late and earned th victory via a stewards' disqualification. The five-year-old goes for her third straight in the event after finishing second to **Stop For Schnapps** (Go for Gin) in an Aqueduct allowance test Dec. 7.

VICTORY SPEECH TO JAPAN

Freshman sire **Victory Speech** (Deputy Minister--Ida's Image, by Alydar), who has sired six winners from his first crop, will stand the 2002 breeding season in Japan, the *Thoroughbred Times* reports. The Coolmore stallion had been scheduled to stand at Ashford Stud near Versailles, Kentucky next year, but plans now have the eight-year-old going to East Stud on the island of Hokkaido. The New York-bred won four graded stakes during his career, including the 1997 GI Strub S. Overall, he won nine of his 27 starts and earned \$1,289,020. His first crop includes stakes-placed **Winning Talk**.

NAKATANI APPEALS

Jockey Corey Nakatani, handed a five-day suspension for careless riding aboard **Forbidden Apple** (Pleasant Colony) in the G1 Hong Kong Mile at Sha Tin Dec. 16, has been in touch with the stewards of the Hong Kong Jockey Club, hoping to get the decision reversed. The stewards have allowed Nakatani special dispensation to lodge notice of his intention to appeal the suspension outside the normal time frame normally allowed. Nakatani will be able to continue to ride pending a hearing on his appeal.

At least 11 sophomores are expected to go to the post for the Malibu, the first leg of the Strub Series. The probables include a pair from trainer D. Wayne Lukas--**Yonaguska** (Cherokee Run), winner of the GIII Sport Page H. and GII Fall Highweight H. this fall, and **Scorpion** (Seattle Slew), who captured the GI Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga in August. "He's coming up to the race well," Lukas said of Yonaguska. "He had a little time off in the summer, so he's a relatively fresh horse. He's had two wins in a row and he looks good. He's training about as well as ever." Gary Stevens will have the mount. Scorpion worked Thursday, going five furlongs in 1:03.40. Alex Solis will be aboard for the Malibu.

Making his second start following a win in a Nad al Sheba conditions event Nov. 29, the Irish-bred was content to linger in midpack while tracking the horse he narrowly defeated last time, Mukhalif (Ire) (Carleon {USA}), for most of the course. His rival was already under a hard drive to reach the front 600 meters out, but it was Resplendent Star that would work his way to the inside and set his sights on his front-running stable mates Hobb Alwahtan and Nadeem. Hobb Alwahtan, a three-quarters brother to champion Dubai Millennium, looked like a winner with 200 meters left run, but Nadeem and Resplendent Star got the better of him, with the latter claiming a narrow victory.

SLEWPTY DEAD *Slewpy* (Seattle Slew), sire of Breeders' Cup Sprint winner *Thirty Slews*, died Wednesday at Flag is Up Farm in California. This year, the 21-year-old stallion was represented by graded-stakes winners **Rare Charmer** and **Road to Slew**. On the racetrack, *Slewpy* won the 1983 GI Meadowlands Cup and 1982 GI Young America S. He retired to Wooden Horse Stud in Florida. He also stood at Jonabell near Lexington, Kentucky and Kerr Stock Farm in California before relocating to Flag is Up.

INJURY ENDS BRUTALLY FRANK'S CAREER
Grade I winner **Brutally Frank** (*Groovy*), eased during the running of Wednesday's seventh race at Aqueduct, suffered two fractures in his right front ankle and has been retired from racing, according to *Daily Racing Form*. Dr. Larry Bramlage will operate on the seven-year-old gelding next week. *Brutally Frank* rose from the claiming ranks to capture the 2000 renewal of the GI Carter H. and the GIII Bold Ruler H. "Obviously, he wasn't as good as he got at one time, but he loved to go out there and run and compete," trainer Mitch Friedman told the *Form*. "I'm definitely looking forward to getting him back and giving him a good home, which is what he deserves. That horse has been so good to me." *Brutally Frank* won 12 of 69 starts and earned \$636,663.
