“SUMMER” STREAKS INTO WINTER

Summer Colony (Summer Squall) found herself in a dogfight for the first time, but added to a winning streak that started back in August with a game neck victory over the hard-charging **Stop For Schnapps** (Go for Gin) in the GIII Ladies H. at Aqueduct yesterday afternoon. Winless in her first six starts, the three-year-old filly broke her maiden in style, strolling to a 32 3/4-length score at Saratoga. She romped through her allowance conditions as well, most recently returning from a two-month freshening to win by 3 1/4 lengths at the Big A Nov. 23. The 6-5 favorite facing stakes foes for the first time in the Ladies, she took up her customary position on the front end as she dawdled through a half in :51 1/5 and six furlongs in 1:15 4/5. **Strolling Belle** (Strolling Along) pressed Summer Colony to the stretch, then weakened. Stop For Schnapps was running at the end, but the winner would not be denied...and the best may be yet to come “She’s still learning and is very green,” jockey John Velazquez said. “She started looking at the starting gate in the stretch and started slowing down. But when that other horse came near us, she gave another spurt.” Future plans for Summer Colony have not yet been decided.

T.M. Opera O, Japan's reigning Horse of the Year, will be looking for his eighth Group 1 triumph Sunday. The five-year-old was second behind G1 Hong Kong Cup winner Agnes Digital in the G1 Tenno Sho in October and is coming off a runner-up finish in the G1 Japan Cup. “He is very relaxed and he seems to be in the best condition of the autumn,” said jockey Ryji Wada. “I have a lot of confidence that he can win Sunday and I hope he captures his eighth Group 1 victory, since this is his last start.” Also making the final start of his career is **Meisho Doto**. After his win in the G1 Takarazuka Kinen in June, the five-year-old was off four months, then returned with a third-place effort in the Tenno Sho and a fifth in the Japan Cup. “He was interfered with by Golan (Ire) on the second turn of the Japan Cup, but if he has a clear run, he has a good chance of being a winner on Sunday,” said jockey Yasuhiko Yasuda.

PROUDWINGS SOLD TO JAPAN Doctor Rolf Wilhelms' five-year-old mare **Proud Wings (Ger)** (Dashing Blade {GB}) has been sold to Teruya Yoshida's Shadai Farm for an undisclosed sum. Proud Wings established her value in international racing by taking the G2 Prix du Muguet at Saint-Cloud May 1, and the G2 Falmouth S. at Newmarket July 11, before being the first under the wire in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville Aug. 19, only to be disqualified for causing interference. Her final victory came in the Capital S. in Hong Kong earlier this month. The homebred's owner Rolf Wilhelms has secured the right to own the first filly to be bred from Proud Wings in her upcoming stud career at Shadai Farm. She will be visiting the multiple champion sire Sunday Silence (USA) in her first season at stud.

APPRENTICE RIDER KILLED IN OHIO Apprentice jockey Arnold Ruiz died of massive head injuries after a spill at Beulah Park in Ohio Saturday afternoon, the *Thoroughbred Times* reports. Riding the 3-1 favorite Winds of Sonora in the second race on the program, a six-furlong event for \$5,000 claimers, the 33-year-old was thrown when the filly broke down in the stretch. My Martina, ridden by Mike Heath, and Kaicoltra, ridden by Chuck Costanzo, fell over the stricken horse and rider. Ruiz died shortly after the accident. Heath suffered only cuts and bruises, but Costanzo was taken to Grant Medical Center in Columbus for further examination. A native of Illinois, Ruiz had won 24 races from 426 mounts since taking out his license in 1997. A memorial service will be held in the Beulah winner's circle today.

Xtra Heat Honored at Laurel:

Top sprinter **Xtra Heat** (Dixieland Heat) was honored with a day named for her at Laurel Park yesterday. The three-year-old, second in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint and third in the GI Frank J. DeFrancis Memorial Dash, paraded down the stretch and into the winner's circle, where her connections received trophies. The filly, a winner of \$1.275 million, took the ceremony in stride. "You can take her anywhere and just drop the shank," trainer and co-owner John Salzman said. "She'll stand there and won't even move. That was such an asset to our program with her this year, because this horse can ship as far as you need to go and never waste a drop of energy. Nothing seems to really excite her--she's as quiet as they come." Xtra Heat will go next in the Jan. 1 Interborough H. at Aqueduct.

Graded-stakes winner **Phantom On Tour** (Tour d'Or), retired when his latest owner, Ed Price, was pressured into ending the seven-year-old's racing career, arrived at the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation's Blackburn Correctional Facility in Lexington, Kentucky Friday morning. Overlooked in her stakes debut, the chestnut settled in fourth early, came with a four-wide move at the top of the stretch to take the lead and held on despite drifting out late to take the photo. "I was pretty sure we had won," jockey Greta Kuntzweiler said. "She cocked her ears and dug in. I think she must have heard the other horse coming.
