RICH IN TALENT

With just two days left on the calendar, **Affluent** (Affirmed) made a belated bid for an Eclipse Award as champion three-year-old filly by defeating a tough field in the GI La Brea S. at Santa Anita yesterday afternoon, giving her Grade I victories on both turf and dirt. A granddaughter of champion Bayakoa (Arg), Affluent earned her first graded victory in the GII Hollywood Oaks July 14, then switched to the turf and was caught late by Golden Apples (Ire) in the GI Del Mar Oaks Aug. 18. She evened the score with that filly by outbattling her in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Keeneland Oct. 13 and was given a brief freshening with an eye to Santa Anita's winter program. The chestnut was first out of the gate from post 11, but dropped back as a pair of In Excess (Ire) fillies, favored **Above Perfection** and longshot **Royally Chosen**, battled up front, with second-choice **Love At Noon** (Afternoon Deelites) tracking them in third. Having advanced four wide on the turn, Affluent was still five lengths back at the eighth pole, but kicked into another gear and ran by the early leaders to win going away. "This was the beginning of the La Canada series," explained winning trainer Ron McAnally. "It only makes sense to run her against her own age group as long as we can. It's been a while since she raced, and I thought she'd at least show enough speed where she would lay close enough to mow them down in the stretch. That :44 half [:44.27] helped us out, too. That was our strategy, and I figured it's a good time to shorten her up, because she is fresh." McAnally indicated that Affluent would go on to the second leg in the La Canada series, the GII El Encino S. over 1 1/16 miles Jan. 20. Trainer Bob Baffert said that third-place finisher Love At Noon would also point to the El Encino. Above Perfection, off since July 22, grew leg weary in the final sixteenth and finished fifth. The Cal-bred filly's only previous defeat was a neck loss to top filly sprinter Xtra Heat in the GI Prioress S. at Belmont July 4.

ISTABRAQ RETURNS A WINNER Having fallen twice in his three previous starts, reigning champion hurdler **Istabraq (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA})'s first objective on his return was to safely complete a round of hurdling. With that task fulfilled, hurdling's undisputed star resumed normal service at Leopardstown yesterday with a smooth if narrow win as the 4-11 favourite in the G2 Tote December Festival Hurdle at the expense of 20-1 chance **Bust Out (GB)** (Bustino {GB}). Despite a mistake at the third-last flight, Istabraq safely negotiated the last two hurdles and only needed to be shaken up by jockey Charlie Swan to score by a head. Trainer Aidan O'Brien told *PA Sport*: "The odds are that we won't be going for the [G1] AIG Europe [Irish] Champion Hurdle here next month. We will try to keep the miles off the clock as he's getting older and he might be around a bit longer because of that. I think, fitness-wise, he's only a bit more than half-ready. It was a huge result for us today. We wanted a safe, clear round and winning was a bonus. He's very lazy often on the way to getting fit." Ante-post betting on the G1 Champion Hurdle at Cheltenham Mar. 12, remained largely unaffected with Istabraq the 13-8 choice to secure a record-breaking fourth hurdling crown.

CURLEY CHOOSES CHARITY WORK

Newmarket-based trainer Barney Curley has decided to quit the training ranks to devote more time to his charity work. The controversial Irishman is a prominent fund-raiser of Direct Aid For Africa (DAFA), a charity which helps the people of Zambia, which has realized £500,000 in just over a year. Curley told *Racing Post*, "I have resolved not to buy any more racehorses and I mean it. I've applied for my licence for next year, but under no circumstances, will I continue training after I've sold my string. All eight of my horses are for sale and when they are gone, I'll hand in my licence. I cannot justify buying racehorses simply to lose 80 percent of my money overnight when there is so much poverty in the world. After handing in my licence I intend to give most of my time to DAFA." Curley will travel to Zambia again on New Year's Day, with other DAFA officials, to monitor the progress of two ongoing projects. He added, "We will be going deep into the bush so I don't know how long this trip will take."

Krisada came flying down the center of the course to catch Sweetest Thing at the wire and earn her first stakes victory. Her most recent trip to the winner's circle was Mar. 15, when she captured a Gulfstream allowance. Stepped up to stakes company following that win, she had finished third in the GIII Bewitch H. at Keeneland in April and encountered some traffic problems last out when fourth, beaten 3 1/2 lengths, to Queue (French Deputy) in the GII Long Island H. Nov. 10 at Aqueduct. She settled into a ground-saving fifth as Summer Solstice (Caerleon) tugged her way along on the front end and angled out on the far turn. Sweetest Thing grabbed the lead as they straightened away, but Krisada was in full flight on the outside and just got her head down in time. "She's fresh; she hasn't run much this year, that's due to the distance," explained Rob Medina, assistant to winning trainer Shug McGaughey. "There aren't that many opportunities at this distance. She handles the hard turf better than any soft going. I would guess her next start to be in the 1 3/8 miles race at Gulfstream [GII The Very One H., Feb. 17], with the main objective being the Orchid [GII 12f, Mar. 24]." Queue faded to finish seventh as the 5-2 chalk.

Profit Option started 2001 with a victory in a \$100,000 optional claimer at Gulfstream Jan. 24, but failed to win in his next six starts. He finished second to subsequent MGISW With Anticipation in the Louisville H. at Churchill June 2, but hadn't run since Sept. 23, when he was seventh in the Kentucky Cup Turf H. Profit Option caboosed the field early as Eltawaasul led through a sedate three-quarters in 1:16 2/5, but advanced four wide on the far turn and rallied strongly on the outside to win by a half-length. "He's a terrible gate horse, which explains some of his poor races, but the crew here did a great job with him," acknowledged winning trainer and co-owner Kenneth Hoffman. "He's had all kinds of physical problems at one time or another--a bow, chips--but he can run. I think we'll probably run him in the mile and three-eighths at Gulfstream [GIII Mac Diarmida, Jan. 20]."

Second in 1998 and 10th in 1999, he won this race when it was held on Jan. 1, 2001. Shipped to California following a second in the GII Aqueduct H., he finished fifth in both the GII San Luis Rey H. Mar. 11 and GII San Bernardino H. Apr. 7 before heading to the sidelines. Third in his return at Suffolk Oct. 27, the Arizona-bred tuned up for the Gallant Fox with a front-running victory in a 12-furlong allowance over this surface Dec. 9. Coyote Lakes settled into fourth, several lengths back as Paynes Bay (Mr. Prospector) fought for his head through splits of :49 2/5 and 1:15 2/5. Top Official moved to the front as the field straightened away, but Coyote Lakes came to his hip in midstretch and pulled away in the final strides. "I didn't know if he'd catch Top Official at the top of the stretch because it looked like that horse took the lead pretty easily," said winning trainer Bruce Levine. "This is the race we point him for each year. It's a big win." Favored Grundlefoot (Unaccounted For) made a sharp move down the backstretch, but flattened out turning for home.
