AS IT WAS IN THE BEGINNING...

Irish Prize (Irish River {Fr}), who started the season with a victory in the Jan. 1 GII San Gabriel H., closed out the campaign with a win in the same event, charging down the Santa Anita stretch yesterday to best Sligo Bay (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) by a head. Given a four-month break after his first San Gabriel score, the chestnut was fourth in his return, then put together consecutive tallies in the May 13 GIII Fastness H., May 28 GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile and July 4 GII Firecracker Breeders' Cup H. Fourth in his next two outings, including the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, he was coming off a third-place finish in the Nov. 24 GII Citation H. The gelding was bounced around at the break in his 2001 finale, but overcame the start to get up for the game victory. "What a lovely old horse, isn't he," trainer Neil Drysdale said. "If everything is all right, we'll go on to the [GII San Marcos H., Jan. 21]."

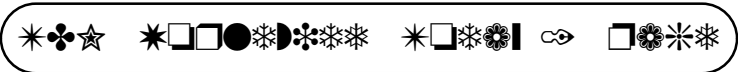

Second by a head in the June 30 Mike Lee S. for state-breds at Belmont Park, Sweet Ricky stretched to a distance of ground for the first time to annex the New York Derby at Finger Lakes July 28. The colt had fallen on tougher times of late, with off-the-board finishes in his last three efforts, including a fourth in open allowance company at this track Nov. 29. Back in against New York-breds for this, he was part of an entry which was sent off the second choice in the wagering. Unhurried early, the homebred commenced a rally entering the far turn, circled horses entering the stretch and prevailed after a sustained drive. The win was the first in stakes company for jockey Lorenzo Lezcano. "The kid rode the horse perfectly," commented winning owner Robert Perez. "I brought him up from Panama and he is like a godson to me."

**Four Jockeys to Hospital After Turfway Spill:**

Four jockeys ended up in the hospital and one horse had to be euthanized after an accident during the second race at Turfway Park yesterday. The incident started when Polish Colleen broke down while dueling for the lead in the \$7,500 claiming event and fell. Dance'n in the Red, with Jose Calo aboard, and A Great Woman, ridden by Chris Rosier, were unable to avoid the fallen horse and her jockey, Mike Morgan, and went down as well. Crest Dancer jumped to avoid getting tangled up in the spill, but lost her rider, James Lopez, in the process. The *Thoroughbred Times* reported that Polish Colleen had to be put down. Morgan suffered a broken wrist and Lopez, Turfway's leading rider, had his arm placed in a sling after X-rays proved inconclusive. Calo complained of shoulder pain and Rosier of general soreness, but neither appeared to be seriously injured.

**Summer Date for 2002 Ohio Derby:**

The GII Ohio Derby, which highlights a 24-race stakes calendar at Thistledown next year, will once again be run in July in 2002. The \$300,000 event, held Sept. 29 this year, has been moved back to a traditional midsummer date of July 20. "We tried to use it as a prep for the Breeders' Cup, but the numbers didn't add up," Thistledown Racing Secretary Bill Couch told *Daily Racing Form*. "In the three prior years, the Ohio Derby drew 11-horse fields. This year, the field was six."

**Monarchos Continues on Comeback Trail:**

Kentucky Derby hero **Monarchos** (Maria's Mon) worked over the Gulfstream main track yesterday morning, going five furlongs in 1:01 3/5. The three-year-old, out since finishing third in the June 9 GI Belmont S., is expected to make his return in the GI Donn H. Feb. 9. Also pointing for the Donn is 2000 Preakness winner **Red Bullet** (Unbridled). "Our plans are to run him in the Skip Away [GIII, Jan. 12] and, if everything is OK, then we'll swing right back and run him in the Donn H.," trainer Joe Orseno told *The Blood-Horse*.

**Outofthebox Out of the Donn:**

GI Super Derby winner **Outofthebox** (Montbrook) injured an ankle during a workout at Gulfstream Park last week and will miss the Feb. 9 GI Donn H., it was reported yesterday. The three-year-old had been pointing for Saturday's GIII Fred W. Hooper H. at Calder when the injury occurred. "He wrenched an ankle blowing out for the Hooper," trainer Steve Flint told the *Daily Racing Form*. "It's nothing serious, just a minor setback, but he's going to need a little rest. He'll probably miss about 30 days." It's possible the colt could be back in time for the Mar. 30 GI Gulfstream Park H.
