BATIQUE EYES HONEY FOX

Trainer Michael Matz had three possible entrants in today's GIII Honey Fox H. at Gulfstream, but in the end he decided on running only the six-year-old **Batique** (Storm Cat). Batique is coming off a late-closing 1/2-length victory in the 1 1/8-miles GIII My Charmer H. at Calder on Dec. 8, but tired to second after setting the pace in the Oct. 26 1 1/16-miles GIII Athenia at Belmont. Asked if today's 1 1/16-miles distance put Batique at a disadvantage, Matz said, "I don't think it really matters. Actually, I was surprised she was that far back in that last race. She had to come on late, but usually she's right up there with the leaders. At Laurel [in a November 2000 optional claimer], she won by eight going a 1 1/16 miles, racing mostly on the lead, so I don't think the distance is a problem." Also in the full field of 18 distaffers is the late-closing **Veil of Avalon** (Thunder Gulch). The five-year-old mare, third in last year's GIII Just a Game Breeders' Cup H. and in the GII Winstar Galaxy, has been off since winning the Nov. 26 Solo Haina H. at Calder.

SPECTACULAR BOY

Maybry's Boy (Broad Brush) showed a strong stretch kick yesterday to take Gulfstream Park's opening day stakes, the GIII Spectacular Bid S. for three-year-olds. The grey colt blossomed towards the end of 2001, breaking his maiden by six lengths Nov. 17 at Aqueduct before finishing a late-charging second in an inner-track allowance Dec. 8. The 8-5 favorite in his stakes debut, Maybry's Boy broke awkwardly from his outside post and was allowed to settle into stride along the inside several lengths off a solid early pace. He advanced along the rail on the turn, angled out at the top of the stretch and collared **Showmeital** (All Gone) before edging away late by 1 1/4 lengths. "He never breaks really well, but he ducked out today and almost dropped me," said winning rider John Velazquez. "I was able to get him into the race right away and he likes to come from behind anyway, so it worked out for me." Winning trainer Shug McGaughey indicated that the GII Hutcheson S. (7f, Feb. 2) would be next for Maybry's Boy. "He's still a little green, but is learning how to run and he's getting better at it," McGaughey said.

Madraar Retired:

Madraar (Mr. Prospector--Jood, by Nijinsky II), half brother to Breeders' Cup Turf winner **Fantastic Light** (Rahy), has been retired from racing and will stand at Hideaway Farm near San Jacinto, California. The eight-year-old will stand for \$3,500, live foal, \$3,000 if paid by Sept. 1. Madraar began his racing career in Dubai, where he won seven starts and was on the board in 17 of 18 races. Purchased by Gary and Marlene Howard from Sheikh Maktoum, he returned to the United States where he raced three times. In his final start, Madraar finished seventh in the Lafayette H. at Golden Gate on Tuesday. "We brought Madraar to California last August and people immediately started calling us for seasons," Gary Howard said. "The pressure to stand him increased even more when they saw how gorgeous he is. He is an absolutely beautiful horse, he is bred to the purple and he could really run."
