### PHONE RINGS EUCHRE'S BELL

It wasn't easy, but favored **Wooden Phone** (Pick Up the Phone) survived a wide trip and a stretch duel with second choice **Euchre** (Personal Flag) to register a narrow victory in yesterday's GII San Pasqual H. at Santa Anita. Winner in his sophomore season of the GII Strub S. over nine furlongs, the gelding found the 10-furlongs and a horse named Tiznow a touch too much as he finished a clear second in the GI Santa Anita H in March. Shipped to the Midwest, the bay was third as the favorite in the GI Oaklawn H. and fourth in the GIII Texas Mile in April before being sidelined for the remainder of the year with an injury. Owned in part by Tom Durant, who also campaigned 2001 stakes winners Touch Tone and Lunar Bounty, Wooden Phone returned to the races in fine fettle, setting all the pace in a 7 1/2-furlong optional claiming event at Hollywood Park Nov. 14 and capped a stellar interim worktab with a bullet five eighths of a mile in :58 4/5 at Santa Anita Dec. 31.

### FISHIN' FOR APPLES

Aptly named as a March foal, **Pisces** (Prized) saved ground at the back of the pack, shifted out from behind a wall of horses in upper stretch and ran down 2000 Breeders' Cup Mile runner-up **North East Bound** (D'Accord) to win yesterday's GII Appleton H. at Gulfstream Park. The bay took a local turf allowance test exactly a year ago and was off the board just once in seven outings last season. A rallying third, beaten 1/2 length by Band Is Passing in the Miami Mile Breeders' Cup H. at Calder Sept. 3, the five-year-old most recently returned from a three-month hiatus to register a 1/2-length success in an optional claiming prep over the Appleton distance across town Dec. 13. Settled along the inside as **Conormara** (Carr de Naskra) and North East Bound alternated on the front end through deliberate fractions, Pisces had not been asked for his best while still in ninth place with two furlongs to run. Guided off the rail once into the stretch as North East Bound disposed of Conormara, he charged down the center of the track and was along in the final stride for the win. **Capsized** (Summer Squall), steadied into the clubhouse turn, raced four wide and finished with good energy to be third. "I knew I had a lot of horse, but I had nowhere to go," said winning jockey Roger Velez. "I just waited and waited. At the quarter pole it was just a matter of whether I could get clear, but at the eighth pole he just exploded. It was just a matter of whether I could get there in time. He just hit another gear. Man, it felt good." Added victorious trainer Mohammed Moubarak, "I guess the shorter distance helped my horse. The softness of the turf might have helped but he seemed to run well on all courses. I was quietly confident in this horse this afternoon." Moubarak said the next start for Pisces will be the GIII Canadian Turf H. Feb. 23. (Chart p2)

**WOODEN PHONE SURVIVES** Customarily at home on the front end, **Wooden Phone** (Pick Up the Phone) was outfooted to the lead by **Irisheyesareflying** (Flying Continental) and **Red Eye** (Fly Till Dawn) and was forced four or five wide into the clubhouse turn while relegated to fourth. Jockey David Flores decided to bypass an opportunity to edge to the inside at the half-mile pole and instead asked **Wooden Phone** to kick on while five deep turning for home. The gelding responded when asked, hooked up with **Euchre** (Personal Flag) just inside the eighth pole and narrowly bested that rival. "I wanted to stay close to the pace and keep my horse in the game without making him work too hard," explained Flores. "We were very comfortable, but we were a little too wide. He is a very game horse and he was able to get in front of them." Winning trainer Bob Baffert echoed those sentiments. "At the three-eighths pole I thought he's really going to be in trouble, but he gutted it out. The last 100 yards, that was all heart." Baffert gave no indication on where the winner would make his next start.

**Adams Plays Hallandale:**

Gulfstream was mobbed yesterday...overrun. More than 30,000 people showed up to see the Appleton H. and Brian Adams in concert. Most of the people were there for music. By 3:30 p.m., Gulfstream President Scott Savin told track security to close the gates and turn cars away. A crowd of 29,889 stormed through the gates, the largest crowd at Gulfstream, other than Florida Derby day and Breeders' Cup. "It was an amazing turn out," said Savin, who started promoting the idea of concerts more than five years ago as president of the Florida Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association. "And the people are betting, it show that the concert idea works."

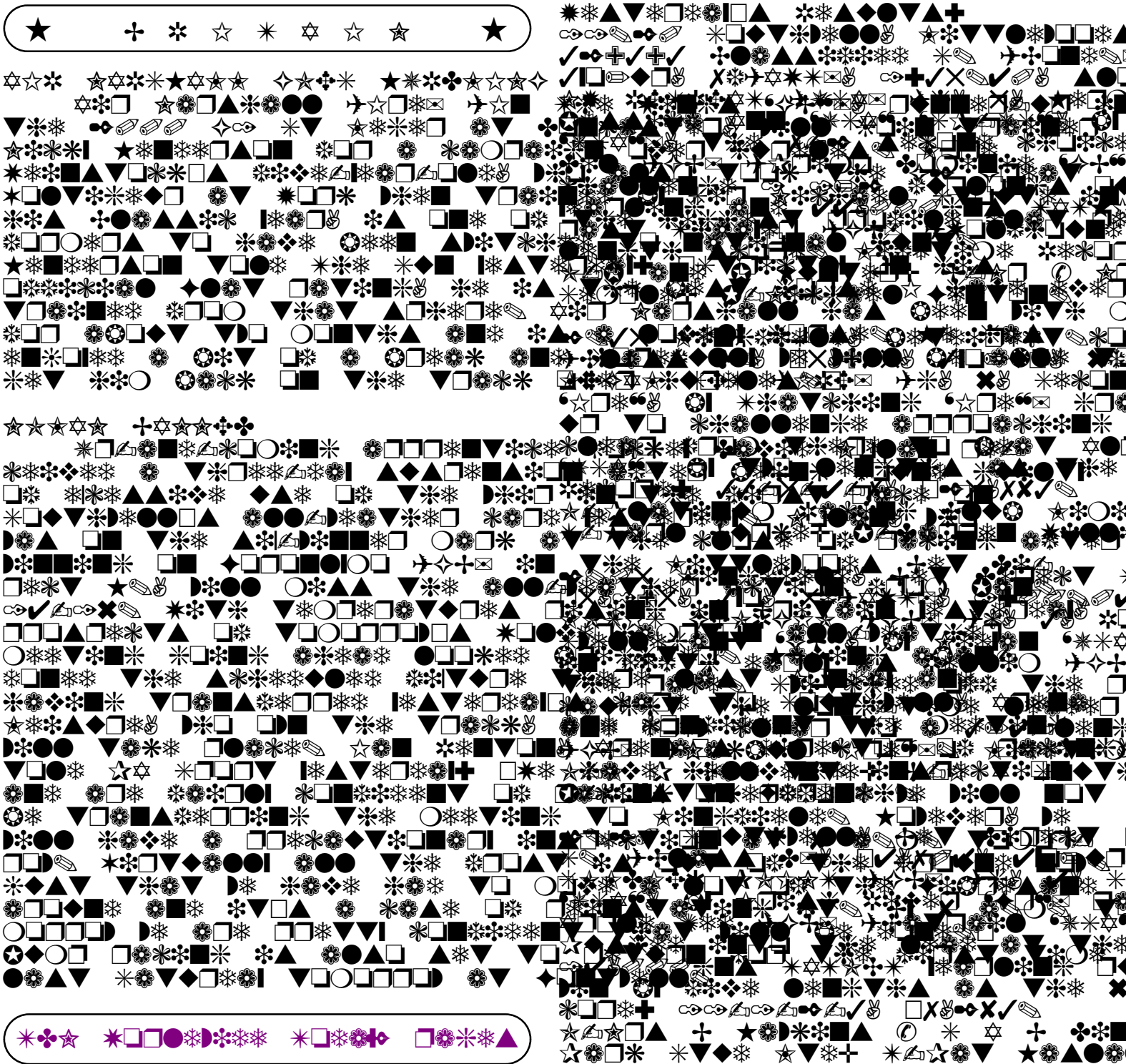
