A RAY OF HOPE

After taking the 2000 GI Florida Derby by a head, **Hal's Hope** (Jolie's Hab) fell on hard times, suffering double-digit defeats in the GI Blue Grass S., GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness. It wasn't until March of 2001, a year and five days after his Grade I victory, that the dark, dark bay returned to the winner's circle, taking an optional-claiming event at Gulfstream by 6 1/4 lengths, but he has been on the board in six of his nine starts since. His owner/breeder/trainer Harold Rose believes he can add to his resume in today's GIII Skip Away S. at Gulfstream Park. "He's doing good, training well and we're going," the 90-year-old horseman said. Now five, Hal's Hope has three wins and a second from four starts at the Hallandale oval and has been first or second in five of seven tries at the Skip Away distance of a mile and a sixteenth. Last time out, he missed by a length when second in the Dec. 29 GIII Fred W. Hooper H. going nine furlongs at Calder. **Traditionally** (Mr. Prospector) has also demonstrated an affinity for the Gulfstream main track, winning back-to-back starts by a combined 15 1/4 lengths last season before travelling to Hot Springs to take the GIOaklawn H. The five-year-old looks to get back on track after ending his 2001 campaign with three consecutive off-the-board finishes, including a fourth-place effort in a Saratoga allowance test last time out Aug. 22. GI Preakness winner **Red Bullet** (Unbridled) has not raced at Gulfstream since capturing an allowance race in February of 2000. The chestnut came back after more than a year on the bench to take a Saratoga allowance last July, but has been out just twice since, most recently finishing third after a troubled trip in the GI Cigar Mile H. at Aqueduct Nov. 24.

DANEHILL TAKES TOP HONOURS

Heads swiveled when a relatively unheralded Danehill colt from the American mare Strawberry Girl walked into the ring during the second Magic Millions Premier Yearling Sale session at Queensland's Gold Coast Friday. But it was David Lamond, bidding for retired Sydney businessman Bill Gibson, who outstayed four others to secure the bay for top price of A\$650,000. "Obviously, he is by Danehill and I thought he was certainly the best horse, ahead of the Grand Lodge colt and the Danehill-Great Vintage [to be offered as Lot 668 on Sunday by Cambridge Stud]," Lamond said. "He was a standout, with real poise and athleticism. I was going to go to A\$500,000, but I was very fortunate to have a good client next to me."

Sheikh Wins Star Pair

He didn't get the day's top lot, but Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa Al Maktoum was active at yesterday's second session, giving a total of A\$1,150,000 for two star colts. The Sheikh's agent, accomplished equestrian Tim Boland, outlasted several determined underbidders, including Roy Thompson and David Lamond, to secure a Grand Lodge colt from GI Flight S. winner Pontal Lass (Aus) (Marauding {Aus}) for A\$625,000. Consignor Newhaven's John Kelly said, "He is a fantastic mover and the perfect horse. I was a little surprised-- I knew he would be popular, but did not anticipate he would sell with such vigour." Not long afterwards, the Sheikh's three-strong team, including adviser Mohammed Kabeel Ahmed, launched a stealthy bidding war for an Octagonal (NZ) colt, finally securing him for A\$525,000. The result delighted consignor Ron Gibert, owner of boutique stud Highgrove, who said, "It is hard to get a line on them when you see them at home-- we knew he was lovely, but didn't realize how really nice he was until we got here. He was inspected more than 100 times and the more he came out, the better he went." Boland believes his client secured the two classiest colts at the sale. "We

found it hard to split the Grand Lodge and the Octagonal. Neither are likely to be early two-year-olds, but they are such quality horses. We paid more than we expected for both actually, but they were the feature horses of the sale," he said, adding, "Australian yearlings are cheap by world standards and Australian prize money is terrific."

Sunline's Sister Goes Home to Inverness

Inverness Stud's Dr. Jack Woolridge will take his strapping half sister to Sunline (NZ) home and race the Danehill filly himself after bidding faltered at A\$800,000 yesterday, short of her A\$1 million reserve. "If there had been an offer of A\$825,000, she would have sold and that would have been awful. I like her a bit," Dr. Woolridge said. "The plan is that she will go home on Tuesday to the spelling paddock before she is broken in. Eventually she'll go to a pre-trainer who will tell us whether to persist. I hope she is as fast as she is strong; she is a hard filly to hold. I'm really quite pleased."

OBS REVAMPS MEDICATION RULES The Ocala Breeders' Sales Company announced yesterday that they will restrict the use of the prescription medications procaine penicillin, furosemide (Lasix/Salix) and the bronchodilator clenbuterol in all of their 2002 two-year-old sales. Consignors will be required to stop treating their sales horses with these drugs 72 hours before the two under-tack shows. "OBS continues to fine tune its policies for the comfort and confidence of our buyers. By making these adjustments, the guidelines for the use of clenbuterol will be consistent with common racing practices and within the framework of existing laws for horse sales within the State of Florida," said OBS General Manager Tom Ventura. "The National Association of Two-Year-Old Consigners [NATC] also feels strongly that we must be proactive in addressing the medication issue and fully supports our decision." The first juvenile sale to be affected will be the upcoming OBS Select Two-Year-Old in Training Sale at Calder Race Course Feb. 5.

De Bertie captured a pair of graded stakes during her last visit to Gulfstream, taking the Gill Sabin H. in January and the Gill Rampart H. Mar. 4. Given another chance as the public choice, she settled in eighth through a moderate opening half, rallied four wide around the final bend and kept coming down the lane to catch Sara's Success at the wire. "A slow pace is my mare's Achilles heel and it almost got her today," trainer Steve Flint, enjoying his first stakes success, said. "But she gutted it out and I'm very pleased with that. She was coming off two dull races, but she loves this track and this win will be a real confidence builder." The mare will go for repeats in the Sabin H. Feb. 8 and Rampart H. Mar. 2.

TRAINER CALLS FOR UMPIRE

Trainer Andrew Reid yesterday spoke of the need for an "umpire" in racing after winning an appeal against the disqualification of **Dispol Evita (GB)** (Presidium (GB)) Tuesday at Lingfield. Having overturned the denotion of his filly, the 4-5 favourite and comfortable winner of a seller on the card, Reid told *PA Sport*: "Perhaps there should be another permanent body in the afternoon ready to take appeals. It would be having a second panel standing by, a bit like they have in cricket now where they can call on the third umpire. That may be the best way to resolve things a bit faster and where you have large sums of money involved. It is perhaps the only way that would help the betting man." However, he added: "I don't think you can necessarily blame the stewards at Lingfield. They had to deal with it in the heat of the moment and had to rely on what is said to them at the time." John Maxse, public relations director of the Jockey Club, said: "On a practical basis I think it is hard to justify having an appeal board here. In 2001 there were three reversals of placings following appeals to the disciplinary committee from around 7,500 races. I don't think those sort of statistics in any way justify having a special panel sitting every day of the week dealing with maybe one incident a month." Racing's ruling body also announced that director of regulation Malcolm Wallace will visit the Lingfield

McCoy, who has sported bandages on his injured neck after a fall at Newbury on Wednesday, is just 69 winners short of Sir Gordon Richards' all-time record of winners in a British season and is quoted at 1-4 by the Tote to do so. He commented: "I'm lucky that I'm in the position where I get to ride a lot of good horses so I'd like to think it was going to come eventually--obviously the sooner you get it out of the way the better. The head's sore but there's no real pain there--I thought it was worth coming as I'd have been bored if I was at home!"
