MAGIC MILLIONS CONTINUES

Sixteen yearlings from 103 catalogued for yesterday's third session of the Magic Millions Premier Yearling Sale at Australia's Gold Coast fetched A\$100,000 or more. The sale kicked off on a steady note, but was marred by 20-odd pass-ins, generally at the lower end of the market. A notable exception was lot 453, a filly by Danehill out of Alicia (ire) (Darshaan {GB}) which was passed in at A\$385,000, A\$15,000 short of her reserve. A pair of yearlings topped the sale's third session at A\$310,000--hip 408, a colt by Zabeel (NZ)--Warning Express (GB) (Warning {GB}), sold by Cambridge Stud to agent Mark Pilkington Bloodstock; and hip 395, a bay filly by Timber Country--Vaburina (Aus) (Snippets {Aus}) who was purchased by Tony Wilman from the consignment of Twin Palms Stud. The filly's second dam is Bravery (Aus), winner of the G1 Queensland Derby and G1 Queensland Oaks. The Premier Sale enters its fourth and final session today, with highlights likely to include lot 504, a filly by leading Japanese sire Sunday Silence from the unraced Sadler's Wells mare Blue Feather (ire), herself a half-sister to Group 1 winner Bigstone (ire) and stakes winners Bague Bleue (ire) and Blue Cloud (ire). The filly will be offered by Arrowfield Stud, agent. Vinery Australia sends out the highly regarded Danehill--Fitting (Aus) (Marsday {Aus}) colt, a full brother to Australian champion Catbird (Aus), as lot 639. (Toppers, p2)

DA BEAR WINS DA SKIP AWAY

Sir Bear (Sir Leon), making his nine-year-old debut, drove past 2000 GI Preakness winner **Red Bullet** (Unbridled) in the final 70 yards to take the GIII Skip Away H. at Gulfstream Park yesterday. "For him to do that at his age--he's a phenomenon, one of a kind," trainer Ralph Ziadie said. "You look at him and he doesn't look like a nine-year-old. He looks like a four-year-old--all dappled out." It was the third win in the event for the veteran gelding, who took it twice when it was called the Broward H. The dark bay had just one victory to his credit last year, capturing the GI Gulfstream Park H. in his 2001 bow, but he was also second in the GI MassCap and third in both the GI Philip H. Iselin H. at Monmouth Park Aug. 26 and the Spend A Buck H. at Calder Oct. 13. The Florida-bred tried turf in his final start of the season, but faded to eighth in the restricted Pass The Line S. at Calder Oct. 27. No better than fifth choice in the Skip Away, Sir Bear trailed the field for a half, closed ground on the far turn and kept coming to catch Red Bullet in the shadow of the wire. "The Old Man knows what to do," jockey Edgar Prado said. "And better yet, he knows where the finish line is." The winner is possible for the GI Donn H. Feb. 9, or could wait for the Gulfstream Park H. Mar. 30.

LAKE CONISTON RETURNS

Champion sprinter **Lake Coniston (Ire)** (Bluebird {USA}--Persian Bold {Ire}, by Persian Bold {Ire}) has arrived at Collin Stud near Newmarket after having served dual-stallion duty in the southern hemisphere, where he sired G1 winner Kapiston (Aus). From three crops to race, the 1995 G1 July Cup winner has sired numerous winners, including Grizedale (Ire), Lake Verdi (Ire), Lupine (Ire), Princess Electra (Ire), Ayr Gold Cup winner Continent (GB) and black-type filly Alegranza (Ire). The son of Bluebird, who used to reside at Coolmore's Castle Hyde Stud, will be paraded during Tattersalls February Sales and will stand at a fee of £2,750 on Oct. 1 terms.

ISTABRAQ TO MISS IRISH CHAMPION?

It seems increasingly likely that **Istabraq (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) will not line up to defend his crown in the G1 AIG Irish Champion Hurdle at Leopardstown Jan. 27. Hurdling's undoubted star has won Ireland's show-piece event for the last four seasons, but connections are keen to keep the 10-year-old fresh for a tilt at a record-breaking fourth victory in the G1 Smurfit Champion Hurdle at Cheltenham Mar. 13. Although entered for the Leopardstown classic, trainer Aidan O'Brien has indicated that it is only a precaution in case plans change, although the intended target is to go for the Smurfit Champion Hurdle without another race. The son of Sadler's Wells was denied the chance for a fourth Champion Hurdle last March due to the foot-and-mouth epidemic that caused the cancellation of the Cheltenham Festival.

HA HA DOMINATES TROPHY

Magic Millions sales company co-owner John Singleton has two Golden Slipper trophies, but the sales incentive races eluded him until Slipper heroine **Ha Ha (Aus)** (Danahill {USA}) duly delivered yesterday in winning the \$1 million Conrad Jupiter's Magic Millions Trophy. Ha Ha, the 2-1 favorite, fought gamely to edge past **Empire (Aus)** (St. Covet {Aus}) to win by a long neck, with **Dash For Cash (Aus)** (Secret Savings) 1 1/4 lengths away in third. Ha Ha smashed the previous race record by .5 seconds, with a brilliant 1:20.38 final time. Waterhouse plans to target the 1600 meter Doncaster S. at Randwick in March. "She is a great filly and she really came to hand in the last 48 hours," said trainer Gai Waterhouse. Jockey Jim Cassidy had Ha Ha beautifully placed in fourth before angling into the clear after entering the home straight. "It was always my plan to be in the first four all the way and she showed plenty of ticker when she needed it," Cassidy said.

JUBILANT CLASSIC

Lovely Jubly (Aus) (Lion Hunter {Aus}) surged through on the rail to win yesterday's \$1 million Conrad Jupiter's Magic Millions Classic at the Gold Coast by a length, thus denying champion trainer Gai Waterhouse her third win with the classy **Chuckle (Aus)** (Danehill {Ire}). The Dean Lawson-trained **Cool Trent (Aus)** (Nediym {Ire}) was a further three-quarters of a length behind in third. Racegoers and horses alike sweltered in 43.2 degree Celsius heat, with the barometer smashing a 1902 record. But, the good-looking grey filly appeared unfazed by the sticky conditions, sending the profile of the well-regarded, up-and-coming son of Danehill soaring in the process. "We were up all night bathing her to keep her cool," said trainer David Throsby. "It was a fantastic ride, Scott Seamer can do no wrong at the moment, and I honestly thought we had no chance after she missed the start." Lovely Jubly, a \$36,000 purchase when offered at the 2001 sale by Queensland Stud Carnation Lodge, will miss the Golden Slipper in March so she can be conserved for a Queensland winter campaign. Chuckle's owner Rob Ferguson confirmed speculation all had not been right when he revealed post-race she had injured her hock on Sunday night and had been restricted to trotting and cantering all week. "She missed a bit of work with that setback, but it was a game effort all the same," he said. Melbourne colt Cool Trent struck trouble mid-race before charging home to finish third in an effort that pleased trainer Dean Lawson. The 6-4 choice **Snowland (Aus)** (Snippets {Aus}) was caught three wide before weakening to finish 10th. "He was there if he was good enough, but he didn't come on as well as I thought he should have," jockey Chris Munce said.

MONARCHOS CONTINUES ON COMEBACK TRAIL Getting closer to his first start since last year's June 9 GI Belmont S., 2001 GI Kentucky Derby winner **Monarchos** (Maria's Mon) worked five furlongs in 1:01 4/5 under jockey Jorge Chavez yesterday morning at Gulfstream Park. The four-year-old galloped out the three-quarters in 1:15 1/5. "It was a good workout," trainer John Ward said. "I got him going out seven furlongs in 1:29 and a mile in 1:44. He's on track for the Donn, and we only have a few more weeks to go." Monarchos, three-for-three at Gulfstream, will make his return in the GI Donn H. Feb. 9.
