### SPECIAL ECLIPSE TO SHEIKH MOHAMMED

Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum has been honored with a Special Eclipse Award of Merit in recognition of "his extraordinary contributions and accomplishments in both racing and philanthropy," the National Thoroughbred Racing Association announced yesterday. Sheikh Mohammed, the Crown Prince of Dubai and Defense Minister of the United Arab Emirates, is the head of Darley Stud and Godolphin. Attending the Keeneland September Sales during the Sept. 11 terrorist attacks, the Sheikh donated \$5 million to the disaster relief fund organized by Keeneland; he also pledged 100 percent of the earnings of the Godolphin runners in the Breeders' Cup to the fund and paid out approximately \$2 million after his stable won the Juvenile Fillies with *Tempera* and the Turf with *Fantastic Light* and finished on the board in two other Breeders' Cup events. Three Godolphin horses are finalists for 2001 Eclipse Awards--*Tempera*, *Fantastic Light* and *Sakhee*.

### HILLS REACT TO WIRE ACT

William Hill, the British-based bookmaker, announced yesterday that they will stop taking bets from its U.S. on-line customers as of Jan. 31. The move follows the analysis of the 1961 Wire Act, which states that the use of phone lines in interstate or foreign locations to place sports bets is a criminal offense. Graham Sharpe, spokesman for Hills, told *Racing Post*, "The Wire Act is obviously the catalyst for the decision. We took the view that the legal uncertainty surrounding the issue was unlikely to be resolved in the foreseeable future."

### WARD EXPLAINS SURPRISE ENTRY

Last year's GI Kentucky Derby winner *Monarchos* (Maria's Mon) was expected to make his four-year-old debut in the Feb. 9 GI Donn H., but his name showed up in the entries for an allowance race at Gulfstream Park this afternoon. "He hasn't run since the Belmont S. in June," trainer John Ward Jr. explained. "I thought a race under his belt would be a much better tightener than a morning workout going the same distance. Our objective with him is the Donn H. next month. This way, if there is some kind of hiccup, it still gives us time to work it out before the Donn." Ward will target the GI Santa Anita H. in March after the Donn.

### ALL THE RAGE

*Raging Fever* (Storm Cat) bobbled slightly at the start and found herself sitting second for the opening quarter, but powered to the lead as they raced out of the turn to take yesterday's GIII First Lady H. at Gulfstream Park by two lengths over favored *Cat Cay* (Pleasant Colony). "When you ride this kind, it's pretty easy," jockey John Velazquez said. "At the half-mile pole, I put my hands down and let her go and she responded very well. I really like to ride this kind." Velazquez had not been aboard the dark bay since an 11 1/4-length victory in the Astoria S. back in July of 2000. The filly went on to win the GII Adirondack S., GI Matron S. and GI Frizette S. before suffering her first defeat when sixth in her two-turn debut, the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. The Edward Evans homebred started just three times last year, running second in the Dame Mysterieuse S. at Gulfstream in March and third behind *Xtra Heat* in the GII Beaumont S. Bothered by a hind end problem, she went on the shelf for more than nine months after that race, returning to take the Dec. 8 Garland of Roses H. at Aqueduct last time out. "She's doing just great," trainer Mark Hennig said. "I think she's back to where she was in the summer of her two-year-old year. It took her awhile to get over the hind end problem, but she's back to full strength now." As for what's next, Hennig said, "I'll run either her or *Gold Mover* in the Shirley Jones [GIII, Feb. 15]. I could run them both in it. I'll have to take a look at what else is around the country." *Gold Mover*, scratched from the First Lady, won the GIII Foward Gal S. over the Gulfstream main track last January and most recently finished second by a nose in the GIII Chaposas Springs H. at Calder Dec. 29. *Cat Cay*, the 3-2 favorite yesterday after winning the Oct. 21 GIII Thoroughbred Club Of America S. at Keeneland and the Nov. 23 GII Top Flight S. at Aqueduct, was outrun early, but closed ground down the stretch to prove easily second best. 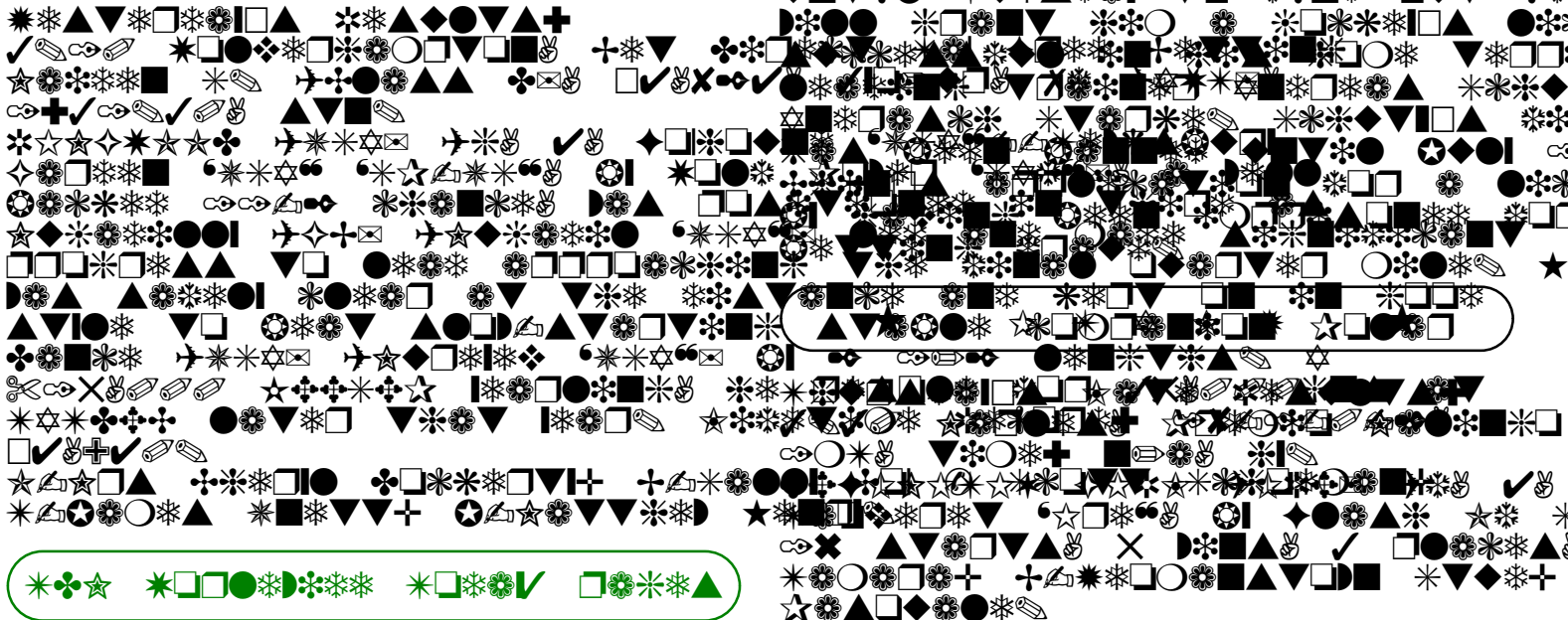
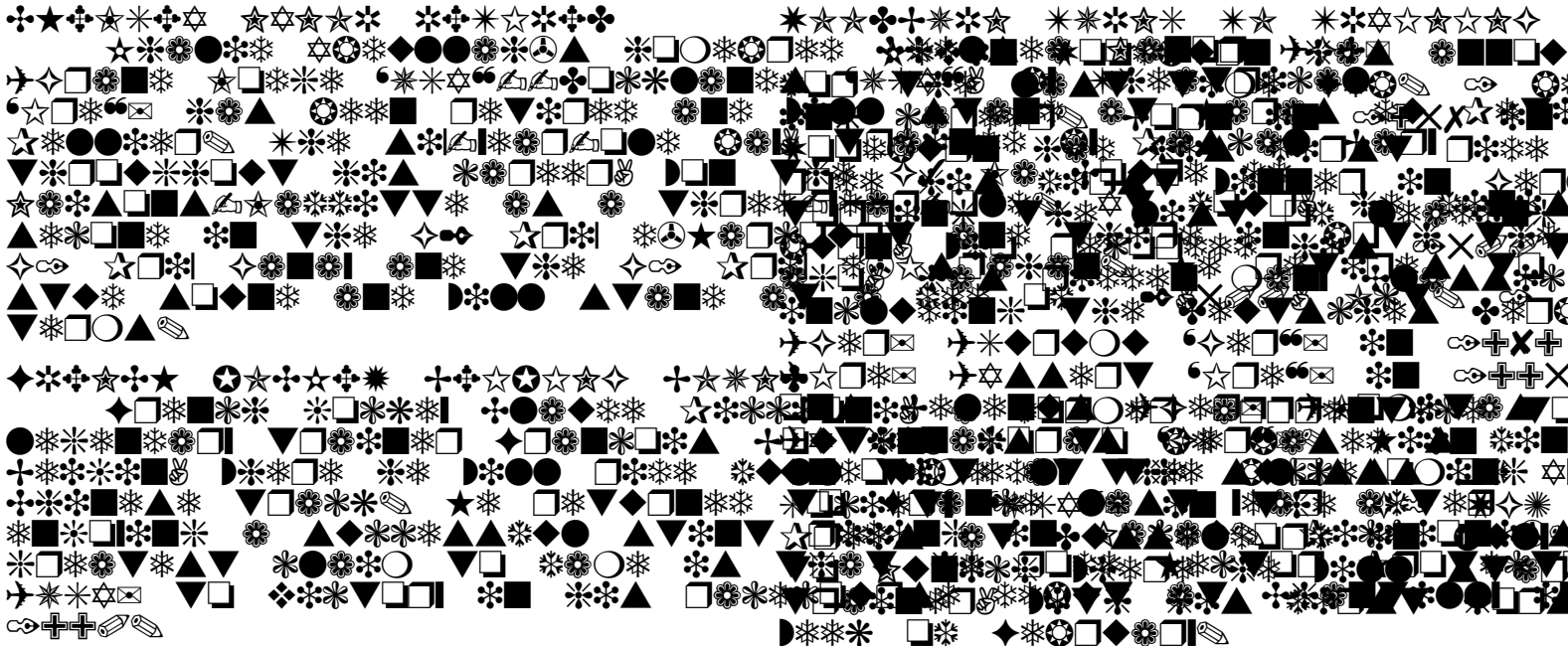

### Wrangler Preps for Paumonok:

**Wrangler (Carson City),** runaway winner of an allowance race at Aqueduct Jan. 1, worked a half mile in a bullet :47 1/5 from the gate over the Belmont training track yesterday morning. He makes his next start in the Paumonok H. at the Big A Jan. 26. "It'll be interesting to see how he's going to run against horses that don't back up that easily," trainer Jimmy Jerkens said. "But the way he ran by horses the other day really makes me think he's a stakes-quality sprinter." The four-year-old has won five of his 12 career starts, including a \$35,000 claiming event at Saratoga last July.

**Governor Freezes Jersey Purse Supplement:**

New Jersey Governor Jim McGreevy, who took office just two days ago, will freeze all discretionary spending in the state in an effort to reduce a budget deficit of more than \$2 billion. Included in the freeze is the \$6 million purse supplement, \$3.9 million of which was earmarked for Thoroughbred racing. Approved by outgoing governor Don DiFrancesco earlier this month, the supplement had already been reduced from the \$18 million allotted to purses last season.

**Historic Estates up for Sale:**

Woodburn Farm, the Midway, Kentucky farm where the legendary Lexington stood, and a portion of the late Paul Mellon's estate in Virginia, are both up for sale, *The Blood-Horse* reports. Woodburn has been owned by the Alexander family since the end of the 18th century. Robert Alexander, who brought Lexington to stand at the stud in 1855, bred four Kentucky Derby winners and 10 Belmont S. winners. The 495-acre estate, which includes a 10,500 square foot mansion, is listed with an asking price of \$7,425,000. About one half of the 4,000-acre Mellon estate, broken up into five separate properties, is also on the market at \$15,000 an acre. Rachel Mellon, the widow of Rokeby Stable's owner, will retain approximately 2,000 acres which surround her home.
