FRANKEL STUNS SIPHONIC

There's no such thing as a sure thing. When 1-9 **Siphonic** (Siphon {Brz}) bobbed at the break and spotted the field eight lengths, trainer Bobby Frankel's second choice **Labamta Babe** (Skywalker) was able to capitalize on a perfect stalking trip to stun the winter-book Derby favorite. As Siphonic reached contention with a sweeping move on the far turn, Labamta Babe seized the lead when they reached the stretch and kicked away impressively from the prohibitive favorite while in receipt of eight pounds. "From [the quarter pole], he absolutely sprinted for the wire," said winning jockey Kent Desormeaux. "I wish today was Kentucky Derby day." A debut winner for a \$30,000 tag at Ellis in August, Labamta Babe was purchased privately following a runner-up finish in a Keeneland allowance Oct. 6. In his first start for Frankel, the dark bay colt was third in the GIII Hollywood Prevue S. Nov. 17, then ran fourth in Siphonic's GI Hollywood Futurity romp Dec. 15. Jockey Jerry Bailey was philosophical about Siphonic's run. "I thought it was a tremendous race, actually," he said. "To give away that much ground, and then to have to go around them on the turn too, he ran very well. If you're going to have one race [before the Kentucky Derby] with bad luck, this was it."

Making his first start in the colors of John Oxley, **Booklet** (Notebook) posted a front-running victory over favored **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan) in the GIII Holy Bull S. at Gulfstream yesterday afternoon. With regular rider Eibar Coa aboard, Booklet set the pace while racing well off the rail. He drifted out turning for home, forcing Harlan's Holiday to go wide, but had enough left in the tank to get the win. "He looks like a good purchase," said winning trainer John T. Ward Jr. "I think he will be able to go farther." The bay colt had captured his first two outings before running third in the GII Saratoga Special Aug. 15. He bounced back to take the Dover S. at Delaware Sept. 22 and made his final start for trainer Steve Klesaris in the Florida Stallion S. at Calder Oct. 13, where he wired the field in a 4 1/4-length victory. The GI Fountain of Youth S. Feb. 16 looks like the next stop for Booklet. **Speedy Leon** (Sir Leon) broke down on the far turn, unseating jockey Roger Velez. Velez was not seriously injured, but Speedy Leon sustained a fractured left shoulder and was euthanized.

HIALEAH HOPING FOR 2003 DATES Hialeah Park has filed a proposal with the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering seeking a Feb. 1-May 15 meeting next year, *The Blood-Horse* reported. Hialeah Chairman John Brunetti described the proposal as "a fair plan of splitting the winter season into two equal portions in terms of time and profitability," but said he would be willing to take the "other half" of the "winter" dates: Oct. 15-Jan. 31. When bill which provided for the exclusivity of racing dates in Florida was allowed to expire, Calder and Gulfstream split up the 2002 calendar and Hialeah was left without a live race meet this year. The stable area has been closed this winter, and the stall shortage in southern Florida has led some horsemen to send at least some of their string to Fair Grounds. Brunetti hopes that the Florida legislature, which begins its annual session Jan. 22, will consider reinstating exclusivity, but is reportedly considering running a live meet in 2003 without that provision.

WEATHER DISRUPTS EAST COAST RACING A winter storm which was predicted to dump up to 10 inches of snow on the East Coast caused cancellations at Charles Town in West Virginia, Laurel Park in Maryland and Philadelphia Park in Pennsylvania yesterday afternoon. Tracks were open for simulcasting, and racing is expected to resume today. Suffering its own weather problems, Sam Houston Race Park in Texas had to call off the last three races of its card Friday night due to fog.

Continuing his progression towards his three-year-old debut, **Repent** (Louis Quatorze) breezed a half in :50 yesterday morning at Gulfstream. Trainer Ken McPeck hasn't yet sketched out a schedule for the multiple graded-stakes winner and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile runner-up. "I was satisfied with his work," said McPeck. "I got him going out five furlongs in 1:00 and change. I'll probably run him sometime in February, I'm just not sure when or where. A lot will depend on how **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan) runs." Harlan's Holiday was second in the GIII Holy Bull S. yesterday at Gulfstream. **Maybry's Boy** (Broad Brush), winner of the GIII Spectacular Bid S. in his most recent start, turned in a :49 half Saturday morning.

Making his first start for trainer Jim Bond, Mongoose took command on the far turn and spoiled the return of Kentucky Derby hero Monarchos. Mongoose had finished third in the GII Turfway Spiral S. last spring for previous trainer Bill Mott and finally snapped an eight-race losing streak with an emphatic 10-length romp at Belmont Oct. 26. The bay colt added an allowance victory at Aqueduct Nov. 16 and was sent off as the second choice to Monarchos. Breaking alertly from the rail, Mongoose stalked the pace from second, made the lead nearing the quarter pole and extended his advantage down the stretch. After breaking poorly, Monarchos was unhurried down the backstretch and made a bit of a move on the far turn, but flattened out in the stretch on his way to a third-place finish in his four-year-old bow.

Evening Attire looked promising as a two-year-old, breaking his maiden at Saratoga in his second start. He was tossed into elite company off the victory, but could do no better than seventh in the GI Hopeful S. and ended the season with a pair of distant runner-up finishes in entry-level allowance races. The gray disappeared for 10 months after his juvenile finale, returning to be third in a Saratoga allowance Aug. 11, but was off the board in his next two attempts and was given little chance when stepped up to the stakes ranks once again for the Oct. 31 GIII Discovery H. Let go at 65-1, he tracked the early pace and drove past Street Cry in the stretch to post the upset. The gelding came back at 10-1 in the Dec. 1 GIII Queens County H. and made it two in a row with a 1 3/4-length tally over Balto Star (Glitterman). The second choice behind Balto Star this time, Evening Attire was last after the opening quarter, moved closer as they traveled down the backstretch and swept to the lead on the far turn. He opened up six lengths at the eighth pole and, despite jumping tire tracks left by the starting gate, had enough left to hold Ground Storm safe. "Once he took the lead, he started looking around a bit and he saw the tire tracks," jockey Shaun Bridgmohan said. "I couldn't believe he jumped them--I was just trying to hold on." But, he added, "He ran huge today." Balto Star set the early pace, but tired in the stretch to be fifth. "I knew he was in trouble at the half-mile pole," jockey Richie Migliore said. "He just didn't feel that good underneath me."
